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

Winning the Royal Malaysian Polo Association National League

TRIUMPH OF TEAMWORK & GOOD FENG SHUI

Feng Shui is the powerful practice of aligning energies to make things work for you, and while it is most commonly used for homes, offices and physical structures, it can also be used in apparel, kit and gear when applied to competitive sports. Feng shui astrology meanwhile can prove significant when putting together teams and managing the compatibilities between team members. JENNIFER TOO shares her journey with TEAM WINDHORSE in their quest for Championship Success in the ROYAL MALAYSIAN POLO ASSOCIATION'S NATIONAL LEAGUE this year.

have been playing tournament polo for about five years now, and in this time have slowly moved up the levels at first playing club polo, graduating to inter-club games, Merdeka League tournaments and now the National League. Polo is a complex sport because it involves not just one player, but four in a team, and there are also the horses to consider as well. One polo match involves eight players on the field at any one time (four a side) and eight horses. In Malaysia and in many countries around the world, a tournament match comprises four chukkas; every rider should ideally change horse for each new chukka so each match requires a minimum of 4X8 = 32 horses. The higher up the levels you go, the more horses you will need, because the game is rough and tough so you can easily need two instead of one horse per chukka.

Many international league matches see one player with two horses per chukka, doubling the horse count to 64 per match!

Winning in any sport requires talent, training and dedication, but in polo, you require the added factors of harmonious teamwork and careful management of the health and fitness of the horses.

A team thus consists not just the four players on *the field but the entire crew of grooms, trainers, farrier and vet.* This year I teamed up with my good friend **Ali Mazlan** to form **TEAM WINDHORSE**. He brought to the team his vast knowledge and

experience playing polo for many years. He manages his family's Polo Club, Tanamera, so he is also extremely knowledgeable about horse care. Plus he welcomed my feng shui inputs, so we complemented one another very well. While gaining victory in any competitive

endeavour stems from how well you perform on show day, our team was not above the adage that you always need a little bit of luck on your side. And so we put careful thought into how indeed we should go about tapping these good luck energies.

Ali left naming the team to me. As our team's debut comes in the Year of the Horse, we called ourselves WINDHORSE, after the magical horse of King Gesar of Ling, the great warrior king of Tibetan legends. King Gesar's horse, also known as Kyang Go Karkar, was his equal partner in all his battles for enlightenment and peace. In feng shui, the Windhorse also represents one's "success factor" - a low Windhorse or *lung ta* means you need to boost it to achieve success, while a high Windhorse heralds a time of good fortune and achievement. In more generalized terms, the Windhorse represents basic goodness and an increasing positive life force in our world. To me this was important, because I have played on



many different teams in the past, and above victory and winning I have always found that the best part of being in a team is the **comradeship** that stems from the positive rapport between teammates.

O u r astrological

animal signs, coincidentally or otherwise, fit together textbookperfect. Our team consisted of allies and secret friends, with Dragons (Chris Yeo, Marco Focaccia and Saladin Mazlan) and Snake (me) forming the House of Magic, Ox (Sally Ann Tan) and Snake forming an alliance of intelligence and intellect, and Dog (Ali Mazlan) our secret weapon, calming the fiery energies of the year by complementing the Tiger-Horse appearance in the 2014 Paht Chee chart. We solidified our alliance by building our team crest around this idea - with all five of our animal signs surrounding the Victory Banner. For our team motto, we chose "Happiness in Polo" rather than success. I have found that if you have to choose between the two, happiness is far more important than success; and besides, success usually follows on from happiness rather than the other way around. Wise advice from my mum, which I took and which worked incredibly

well indeed.

Since I am the go-to feng shui person in my sport, the most common question I get asked before the start of each season is *"so what's the lucky colour for the coming year?"* I share this information freely and this year told whoever bothered to ask *"Blue and* Yellow." The 2014 Paht Chee chart which lays out the foundation for the year - is exceedingly unbalanced, and the two missing elements are Water and Earth. Our own team followed this advice, making these our team colours.

Our gear sponsors **TEAM PG** found us some bright sunshine yellow and royal blue shirts for our Home and Away shirts, and we added on our "Happiness Crest" to all our gear. We really got into the spirit of the team and kitted out our horses with blue and yellow saddle pads, bandages, boots and browbands. If we won, we wanted to look good doing it; and if we didn't, well then we needed the consolation of being the best-looking team.

Winning even a single tournament in polo is not easy. Winning the whole league harder still. It is a competitive and gruelling sport, and any number of things can go wrong. Team Windhorse weren't without our obstacles. We started the year playing the MERDEKA LEAGUE (at 3 goal level), looking not so much to win but also to use as a warmup to the National League (8 goal level) immediately following. Marco > Focaccia, our anchorman, injured his shoulder in our second match, leaving us no pro for the closing match. Saladin Mazlan, who was to join our team only for the National League, stepped in to cover for Marco, and we finished in 5th place out of 9.

We had a short break before the Nationals were due to start, when we had Marco desperately ultrasounding his shoulder so he could at least attempt to start in the Nationals. He managed to start, but we lost our first National League match; it was a hard-fought match which resulted in a draw, followed by an extra chukka, still a draw, and then a penalty shootout the next day to conclude.

We had another short break due to the incredible weather, which prevented play because first the drought made the ground too hard, then the haze made the air too unhealthy, and finally the thunderstorms flooded the fields making them unplayable. When we could finally restart, we had put in more practice as a team and Marco's shoulder had more time to heal. Some background; Team Windhorse was not necessarily a favourite going in. We were made up of two amateurs and two pros with a limited number of horses, which had to last us through the whole season (i.e. they had to stay injury-free). And we had to come up against teams with more and faster horses, which were pretty much set up like mini organizations in themselves: but this made it all the more challenging, and once we started winning, all the more satisfying.

We lost one more match, then like magic we "clicked" and didn't lose any more matches after that.

A turning point actually was when we lost one of our blue shirts. One of our players misplaced his blue jersey, so we had to swap to **playing exclusively in our yellow set** – something we should have done from the start. This year, while both Blue and Yellow represent the missing elements of Water and Earth, it is Earth i.e. yellow that is the better enhancing agent, as it keeps the raging Fire element of the year under control. Wearing yellow made us slow down our game, allowing us to put more



strategy behind our moves, and gave us the impetus we needed to beat some very competitive teams.

We started to read each other better and better, winning by a greater margin each time we played. Our seven consecutive wins gave us the **National League Finals** win as well as the **Championship** for the entire 2014 League – **the Big Prize** – what we were setting out to win! **Saladin Mazlan** won the Most Valuable Player prize, while **Ali Mazlan's horse Coluna** won Best Playing Pony.

It was a sweet victory and one that felt better than any I've ever had. Polo is the ultimate team sport because it is a four-player game; if you can play intelligent, structured polo with a proper strategy, you can overcome other deficiencies through sheer willpower and harmonious teamwork. The level of the tournament was 8 goals, and we made up our 8 goals with two 3 goalers, one 2 goaler and one 0 goaler. So rather than investing in one superstar higher goal player, we combined a team of players where everyone had to do a job. Our path to success was almost chess-like in the amount of planning and strategizing that went in. And correspondingly, the joy of winning came not with watching one person shine and going along for the ride, but with each team member contributing a distinct and important role.

Our National League season was a great experiment in applying feng shui principles to an organized sporting team. Feng shui has also been successfully used for the big professional Football Clubs where there is so much at stake with each win or loss.

In our team's playing experience however, while the colours, player combinations, team name, team logo and playing schedules all contributed to our success, what has been truly marvelous about the results of our feng shui was the harmony and happiness that we generated together, not just when we lifted the big cup but all through the season, through the ups as well as the downs; our good feng shui and perfect matching astrology gave us the tenacity and the resolve to keep holding on to the next victory, and the next and the next.

They say polo is the Game of Kings, and it really is, and not just because kings play polo. Yes it has that cache and is a well-known favourite pastime of Royal families the world over - in Malaysia, HRH Prince Abdullah Shah, Crown Prince of Pahang heads our organization the Royal Malaysian Polo Association and the Pahang Royal family is hugely supportive of the sport - but it is the Game of Kings because it is a sport consisting of players who demonstrate great nobility; with the speed of galloping horses, the ferocity of the turns, the wielding of potentially deadly cane mallets, it is essential the game is played with rules and respect for each other. And Malaysian polo is certainly proving to world-class in its standards - both in the quality of play as well as in the integrity of our players. We have in the recent past hosted a World Cup Zone Qualifier in Malaysia, with plans to bid for the World Cup **Finals** proper in the future.

Team Windhorse makes its next League appearance in the continuation of the Merdeka League on 15th August 2014 at the Royal Pahang Polo Club. This tournament will be particularly special as it will be held in conjunction with the celebration of HRH Sultan of Pahang's 40th Anniversary of his Coronation.

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Behind the Power of

TIBETAN AMULETS

Powerful Protection against 8 kinds of Black Magic Medallion.

What gives such PROTECTIVE POTENCY to the *MAGIC WHEELS* we refer to as Amulets, Charms, Talismans? We feel safer when we wear these spiritual symbols, whether overtly or covertly, with the conviction they imbue our auras with powerful protection against evil spirits, wicked forces and cosmic bad luck. But really, how do these amulets work, and why are there so many different kinds of amulets?

elief in these sacred circles occupy an ambiguous position between magic and spirituality. Some think of amulets as magic, while others believe they are spiritual expressions of manifested energy. LILLIAN TOO has used and worked with AMULETS for many years. She has experienced their potency first-hand, seen how veteran Masters make and consecrate them, and witnessed how they have helped victims of black magic come out of love spells cast by unscrupulous people. They can dissolve the malevolent effects of inadvertent demon clashes, and protect victims of accidents and burglaries from physical harm.

In this issue, she explains what lies behind the power of amulets and how anyone can use *special incantations* and *rituals* to make their private amulets even more potent.

The use of charms is deeply rooted in the fabric of many Asian (and Western) cultures. But there are few cultures as intensely steeped in the practice of wearing amulets as the Land of Snows, Tibet. Originally sealed off from the world, the ancient people of Tibet lived surrounded by icy high mountains and deep valleys. They were once a Shamanistic race for whom wearing amulets to protect themselves against the spirit forces of the high mountains was an essential part of survival. Belief in supernatural protection has thus always been part of their daily lives, and even when Tibet became completely Buddhist, their belief in amulets did not dissipate. Indeed, dependence on personal sacred objects became even more popular.

Indeed, every Tibetan lady, whether rich or poor, titled or humble, wears against her breast a tiny amulet box usually set in precious metal - gold or silver - inside which are sacred pendants, consecrated coral or turquoise, special prayers written on rice paper, as well as different symbols representing protection against spirit harm. Tibetan men meanwhile usually wore amulets sewn inside leather pouches, tied around their arms or stuffed inside hidden shirt pockets.

From Tibet originated many kinds of amulets. The good news is that the country's Buddhist lineages have ensured ancient texts explaining the different categories of malevolent spirits have been well preserved. There are valuable text compilations on the different spirits that cause different ailments, bringing different kinds of suffering to mankind. There are also distinctive ways to subdue and suppress their malevolent intentions. It was from these texts that amulets were made.

I have English translations of some of these texts, and because I am familiar with the various categories of spirits, designing amulets to dispel illness or severe misfortune has become a fascinating and meaningful part of my cosmic feng shui work. It has been a great help that I am fortunate enough to have *learnt the spiritual rituals* related **>**

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to performing the SADHANAS, DHARANIS and PUJAS that call on different categories of the mighty PROTECTORS.

These Protectors are powerful beings and are usually part of the entourage of different Cosmic Buddhas that make up the vast pantheon of the Merit Fields. These protectors include the Lords of the Air, the Waters, the Skies, the Goddesses of Long Life and of the Earth, and the Lords of Horses. Each protector has different powers or is head of a different group of spirits.

To understand the power of amulets, it is important to appreciate that around every pocket of space, there are varying groups of *local deities*. These deities each have distinct demonic powers, which bring damage of different kinds. They trigger epidemics such as dengue or SARS, and can cause a whole range of illnesses. They can instigate barbaric acts to take place, and can cause burglaries, violence and even death to occur.

The Tibetans have classified a vast variety of local deities, demons and personified forces of nature that bring negativities into one's life. It is these wandering spirits that must be subdued, or at least appeased, to prevent them from harming the human residents who reside alongside them in their space.

And it is usually the PROTECTORS who are the ones needed to appease these spirits. These Protectors help those of us who invoke them, either through reciting their mantras or wearing their amulets. Note that there are different names for the different types of spirits, and these spirits have a hierarchy of importance and rank. Many bring illnesses, some bring accidents, and many more simply bring aggravations that include natural disasters such as floods, fires and earthquakes. They also cause major reversals of fortunes within families, creating hostilities to burst forth among family members and friends.

SPOOKY SPIRIT PETS

In many of the countries of Asia including Malaysia, Indonesia and Thailand - lower level spirits are actually reared by humans, who make their living as sorcerers. And these latter often use their adopted spirits to carry out their nefarious activities. When you wear amulets that include incantations to some powerful Protector, you can easily overcome the naughty tricks of these reared spirits, who often cause misfortune that is more aggravating than harmful. But when you are NOT protected, it is easy for you to fall prey to these naughty spirits!

There are also harmful spirits that live within us, that can cause our minds to get disturbed. These are usually seen as the origins to mental disturbances, and supposedly spirit possessions. In any year, when your *Spirit Essence* is low, you can succumb to the negativities caused by your own "inner demons".

The challenge in preparing some of these amulets has been trying to find modern equivalents of various plants, animal parts and herbs, often referred to as *special substances*, which need to be incorporated into the preparation rituals.

Many of the amulet manuals that have re-emerged out of Tibet are based on texts discovered by great Nyingmapa Treasure Finders (Tibetans call them *Tertons*). The Bon and *Nyingma* monasteries especially continue to use them to make woodblock-printed amulets that are consecrated and folded to be worn next to the body as protection, or pasted onto the walls of homes to protect its residents.

The texts advise that making amulets from precious metals are superior. If written on paper, amulets should be carried inside leather or snake-skin pouches; but golden, silver or copper comprise the best material for making or keeping amulets.

Amulets are usually drawn onto circular pieces of metal. The circular shape distracts all spirits, as this is the *shape of the moon* in all its full moon glory. The circular shape also reflects the brilliant *power of the Sun*, and indeed any symbol that shows this brilliance is said to contain incredible power to attract all good! Around the amulet, there will always be some powerful mantra, usually written in old Tibetan script or in Sanskrit.

These special mantras are believed to have been given to mankind via treasure texts that emerged when the time was right, by the great **Guru Rinpoche** or **Padmasambhava**, who is generally credited with bringing Buddhism to Tibet from India. He is also said to have had extraordinary magical powers which he used to subdue countless worldly Gods and Demons, converting them into Oathbound Protectors! Already powerful as demons, they have become even more so as Protectors, held under oath to Guru Rinpoche.

Many amulets contain potent magic wheels with *supernatural symbols, syllables and line drawings of anti-demonic tools*, which subdue evil forces. It is not possible to offer a detailed explanation of all demons that can be overcome by amulets. But in terms of their impact on human life and the bad experiences that result, they can usually be well-defined. Thus amulets are often categorized according to what kind of misfortune they protect against.

It is important for me to point out that the amulets I have learnt to make comprise only a very small part of the whole spectrum of Tibetan amulets, which is quite vast indeed, considering there are so many classes of spirits that have to be addressed and appeased. Indeed, there is so much in the cosmic world that has not yet been fully revealed to mankind. There is still an enormous body of knowledge in the magical traditions of Tibet.

Even amongst the Buddhists, there are four main traditions; and one can break these down into even more traditions when one takes note of the dialect, village and regional differences of emphasis. So amongst the Tibetans, there are many different ways of designing amulets. They can be simple pieces of paper inscribed with spells wrapped in yellow or fivecoloured cloth, or they can be more elaborate drawings inscribed with special mantras. Usually, once you start using amulets, you will eventually have quite a collection, as I have; and in time, you might even want to emulate the Tibetans and carry all your amulets in a special box or pouch.

WHAT GIVES AMULETS THEIR POWER AND POTENCY?

As far as Tibetan amulets go, their efficacy arises from the mantras inscribed on them. It is also believed that amulets worn for a long time by highly-realized Lamas are incredibly powerful. I myself possess a very special amulet given to me by my amazing Guru, HH CHODEN RINPOCHE. It is encased in an amulet box made of silver that is about 3 inches long and one inch in diameter. HH Choden Rinpoche carried this amulet his whole life, including his years in Tibet, so inside must have been some incredibly powerful amulets, and I have benefited enormously from having this amulet in my possession!

FOUR BASIC TYPES OF AMULETS

There are four types of amulets that address the Four Rites of ritual activities. The way the amulets are constructed are generally the same, but their purposes differ.

The first is the **PACIFYING RITE** and these amulets are worn to pacify Spirit Forces, Local Spirits, Local Gods and Demons that bring obstacles that cause illness, aggravations and setbacks to occur in one's life.

The second is the **INCREASING RITE** and these are used to magnify one's prosperity, increase wealth and knowledge, and generally bring greater abundance of all the things that make one's life fuller and one's enjoyment more meaningful. The third is the **SUBDUING RITE** and these are for subduing Spirit Forces and Demons that represent a higher level of spirits.

The fourth is the **DESTROYING RITE** and these are to employ the most wrathful potency to control and even to destroy dangerous demons and evil enemies.

Amulets are generally worn to attract happiness and abundance and to eliminate evil of various kinds manifesting in various ways. It is always good to remember that it is the PROTECTORS and ultimately the power of the BUDDHAS who are being called on to assist in making one's worldly life more pleasant and less dangerous. Hence each time one places the amulet against one's body, it is excellent to think that one is taking refuge under the Buddhas and the three jewels by reciting the Refuge Prayer. This simple ritual is more powerful than many people realize.


THE KALACHAKRA MANDALA MIRROR

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ENHANCING THE LUCK OF THE DATRIARCH

In celebration of Father's Day, we bring you a detailed case study on how this powerful CEO's life turned around after changing the feng shui of his home!

bout 10 years ago while I was living in New Zealand, my husband Patrick and I were invited to dinner by one of NZ's "power couples". This famous couple led high-profile, public lives in New Zealand, being CEO and Partner of top NZ firms, and both were directors in several public and private boards.

On the night of the dinner, Patrick and I arrived in awe of their four-storey mansion, situated on the hillside of the most exclusive neighbourhood in town! Dinner was lovely and inevitably our conversation moved from politics and art and eventually to the purpose of why they invited us!

Andrea* had read my aunt's Complete Illustrated Guide to Feng Shui, which Patrick and I gave her as a gift at a corporate dinner 4 years ago! She had been yearning to give their very dated four-storey villa mansion a badly needed upgrade, and wanted some advice to ensure it would harmonize well with good feng shui principles! She was very excited and keen to get started, so we met on the very next day to go through her house plans!

Here's what she had in mind:

a) Mark and Andrea have four grown children and two of them were about to get married! Their spouses were moving in with them and to cater to their growing family, she needed a larger kitchen, a bigger dining area and more entertainment space to accommodate larger family gatherings. She was determined to tear down their very tired "countrystyle" kitchen and replace it with a modern "open plan" granite kitchen equipped with a breakfast bar!

b) Mark and Andrea loved holding private parties as they were committee members of some of the most prestigious clubs in New Zealand! Andrea wanted her new layout to incorporate good feng shui as well as accommodate groups of 16-30 people comfortably, while showcasing her stunning harbour views, something her old layout did not do very well!

c) Mark and Andrea had always dreamt of a landscaped waterfall and pond for their garden but knew from reading my aunt's book that it had to be carefully placed or could lead to a serious reversal of fortune. She wanted some advice on whether it would be OK to place it in front of her entrance.

KITCHEN IN THE NORTHWEST


After taking directions and reviewing her plans, the first big problem we identified was that her existing Kitchen occupied quite a substantial part of her Northwest corner. If she went ahead to increase the size of her kitchen here, this would result in the kitchen occupying the entire NW sector of her home!

Under the Later Heaven Arrangement of the Pakua, the Northwest corner represents the location of the PATRIARCH. It is also the location that represents Heaven and Mentors – the sector of the home that brought the luck of helpful patrons and divine help! When a kitchen is situated in the NW, it generates the element of FIRE. The I-Ching clearly warns that fire in the Northwest creates the formation known as "Fire at Heaven's Gate" – one of four major signs of danger!

I was rather surprised that Mark had done so well in his career despite having a kitchen here in the NW, so I asked her how Mark was doing in terms of health.

I explained to her that the Kitchen in the NW usually results in danger for the man of the house. When the NW is missing or afflicted it is usually the cause of all husband-related woes! A missing NW corner typically results in the husband never being home, or difficulty for single women of the house to find stable relationships. An afflicted Northwest corner (locked away as a store room or occupied by a bathroom or kitchen) can lead to husbands not being able to hold a stable job, husbands getting into trouble (e.g. gambling, alcoholism, etc) or husbands suffering from serious ailments.

When I explained that by enlarging the size of her kitchen in the Northwest, it would create health problems and career setbacks for her husband, Andrea started to tear up. She revealed to me that Mark was in actual fact already very ill. This was of course a secret – something that neither the public nor the board of directors knew about – but Mark had been secretly getting private medical treatment in the US for the past 4



years to deal with a rare disease that affected his lungs and chest area. The Lungs or Chest area is also the organ associated with an afflicted Northwest!

Not only was his health a constant struggle, Mark was also under tremendous stress, facing serious problems in his professional life. At that time, Mark was the CEO of a prominent government-funded organisation and the object of a hostile coup engineered by several members of the Board! Because of his strong personal friendship with the Prime Minister (who appointed Mark for the role), the Board had offered him the choice of taking voluntary retirement to save face, or to engage in a very public battle played out for all to see!

Andrea confided in us and explained that this was a recurring

pattern in Mark's professional life since living in this house. In almost every role he was appointed to, Mark would face strong opposition from subordinates or board members. In his earlier career days, Mark was almost never home; always posted overseas, but never on permanent roles. The family lived in constant fear that his contracts would dry up any minute and the true breadwinner of the home was actually Andrea, who at that time held the role of Senior Partner in NZ's top law firm and President of several other charitable foundations!

NEW LAYOUT for PERIOD OF 8

Persuading Andrea to move her kitchen elsewhere was not difficult after I had explained the consequences of the present location of the kitchen! She had already set aside enough money to replace the old plumbing and wiring, so changing the location of her kitchen was an easy decision. She had also planned to install an elevator in the house to "futureproof" it for old age and wanted to know where to put it! In addition to this, she had ordered two large crystal chandeliers and commissioned sculptures of Roman Gods from Italy and wanted to know where to place them!


Upgrading to Period of 8

Her house was situated on the side of a hill with the back of the house facing beautiful harbour views! So this was her house's facing direction and the Flying Star chart relevant to her house was the East 2 chart. At the time, her house was still a Period of 7 house, and so it was perfect timing to give it a facelift and convert it into a Period of 8 house! To do this, Andrea and Mark agreed to have all their carpets replaced, floors sanded and a brand new shiny zinc roof installed for the renovation!

Here are all the key changes suggested for Mark and Andrea's house:

1 Move Kitchen away from the NW

The first thing we had to do was decide where to place her new kitchen, as we didn't want it to stay in the NW corner. There were two convenient choices – either the South or the Southwest. The South was a good choice because it was a Fire location, but because it had very auspicious water and mountain flying stars (6/1), we felt it would be a waste to place



her kitchen in the South.

The Southwest was also an acceptable choice. In moving the kitchen to the Southwest, we were able to use the Fire energy generated by the kitchen to strengthen the Southwest Earth location, and this benefits Andrea - the Matriarch - as well as weaken the 4/3 stars, which can bring quarrels and problems with the authorities if not weakened. An open plan kitchen with a huge stone granite breakfast bar (Earth energy) was designed for this location, being very careful not to place the sink or stove in the NW or SW corners. As long as the stove or sink was not placed in the SW or NW corners of the kitchen, it did not adversely affect the Patriarch or Matriarch's luck.

2 Separate Entrance for East Group Individuals

The second thing we did was to create separate entrances for the East Group occupants of the home. Half the family were East Group and the other half was West Group. While this home was already excellent for both East and West Group individuals because it was sitting West and facing East, it was still a good idea to give both East and West Group occupants the chance to enter their home through an entrance that were in sync with their KUA numbers.

The main entrance of the home faced WEST, which was suitable for Mark and all their daughters, but not for Andrea and her sons. So a second entrance was created next to the breakfast bar in the Southwest location to allow East group people to enter the home. This South-facing door was perfect for Andrea as it was her *Sheng Chi direction* as well as her animal sign direction (Andrea was born in the year of the Horse).

3 Creating an OPEN-PLAN Layout

The house was redesigned with an openplan layout (without too many walls) to allow the good flying stars to dominate these areas. The added advantage here is that the stunning views of the harbour could be seen from the Dining and Living areas!

As you can see from the new plan, the good numbers (marked in blue) were in the South (631), centre (186) and entrance area (818). The Dining room which was the main location where the family would gather and where parties would be held was situated in the South, and all the walls were removed to allow energy from the good stars to move freely. The centre stars 186 were incredibly auspicious, so we energized this location with one of her crystal chandeliers to keep it bright and open, letting the energy permeate the home.



To ensure that energy did not "run straight out" the sun room when it travelled in from the entrance, we placed her near life-size **sculptures of Roman Gods** facing the entrance to protect her home as well as act as a buffer to slow down the energy.

Andrea had strong affinity with the Roman Gods, and had commissioned beautiful stone and metal statues of **Jupiter (the King of Gods), Minerva** (**God of Wisdom) and Plutus (The Roman God of Wealth)**... so all three were positioned as a trinity formation: Jupiter to greet the door, Plutus to face the dining area and Minerva to face the sun room!

Activating the Double 8 Star and installing a Rock Garden

Andrea and Mark longed for a landscaped natural waterfall garden in front of their entrance. Because their Double 8 star was located in the West sector, this was actually an ideal place for this. The most important aspect of having a water feature here was to ensure that the "Mountain Star" was activated just as well as the Water star, and to do this, the waterfall had to flow from a high wall or high rock. I also advised her to crate rock gardens in the NW (Metal) and SW (Earth) corners of the garden, as these two locations benefit from strong EARTH energy.

5 Enhancing the NORTHWEST for MARK

The Northwest area has been extended and converted into Mark's private "den" where he can read his books and listen to his huge classical and jazz music collection. This was an excellent location for the Patriarch of the house, and the Mountain star here was very

strong for health. But the water star #7 here was a problem and this had to be weakened.

So in the NW corner, we placed a small water feature here to exhaust the #7 star, and a large red coloured crystal to activate the Mountain #9 star. His study desk was also oriented to face West, which was Mark's Sheng Chi direction. We also placed a medium-sized image of Mars, the **Roman Warrior King** to protect the luck of the NW corner for Mark and keep the #7 star under control!

Killing the Deadly Stars

O The negative stars in the Northeast (7/9), East (3/4) and Southeast (2/5)had to be weakened. Andrea had a beautiful limited edition print of Rangitoto Island, personally signed and gifted to her by famous NZ artist Jane Puckey, which would be perfectly displayed in the Northeast corner. Rangitoto Island was a huge volcanic mountain surrounded by water, and this would activate the direct Spirit of the NE. The Water surrounding it kills off the #7 mountain star. For the East, we installed her stunning crystal chandelier to produce strong Fire energy there and suppress the 3 and 4. She also adopted a red colour scheme for her carpets in this area. For the Southeast corner, she installed an antique Chinese cabinet with locks to "imprison" the 2 and 5. Recently, she has even added the Five Element Pagoda and Chinese Wu Lou here to suppress these two stars.

CONCLUSION

It took about a year for Andrea and Mark to complete all the necessary renovations, but it was worth it. Mark left his role with the organization with


a big secret pay-out and went ahead to launch a new career in television endorsing several large brands in New Zealand.

His health improved significantly. He shed a lot of unwanted weight and adopted a more active lifestyle. His lung condition has also improved – with less frequent visits to the U.S for treatment.

Andrea became the Chairman of the law firm she was partner in, and retired several years later to take other high profile roles for charity. The couple now have five very lovely grandchildren and all their children are happily married!

But MARIO **TESTINO** has also photographed many other luminaries of the stage and screen. Today he lives the gilded life, but is much involved in charitable works. KEE HUA CHEE brings us his conversation with the man himself.

International Celebrated Photographer MARIO TESTINO TESTS NEW TERRITORIES

ario Testino is also famous for having taken some spectacular black and white pictures of Princess Diana's five months before her death in 1997 and like many of his other works, these pictures became larger than life mementoes of the beloved Princess.

He too is larger than life with a personality to match. Towering around 6 ft 4 inches, Mario Testino looms over the celebrities he photographs, unless they wear 6-inch stilettos and have had their hair blown and piled up high.


We met in the heart of the artistic quarter of Paris. There was no mistaking the arrival of the de facto Royal Photographer of the British Royal Family – remember he was also granted to do the honours at the wedding of Prince William and Kate Middleton.

Imposing and impressive, Mario Testino has a wonderful sense of humour. Genial, patrician and charming, he always looks like he is about to smile or has just heard some nice joke. He displays a distinct lack of arrogance. I, like many, am impressed by his genuinely nice personality despite hobnobbing with royalty, the real kind as well as pop royalty and other super hot celebrities such as Madonna, Keira Knightley, Janet Jackson, Cameron Diaz, Meg Ryan, Julia Roberts, Kate Moss, Giselle Bunchen, Catherine Zeta-Jones, Elizabeth Hurley, Gwyneth Paltrow and Kim Basinger. He knows


them all and they always have the nicest things to say about him.

When we met, he was eager to talk about his charitable work and confided in me that he had originally wanted to be a priest! Surprise! And of course, the Church's loss is Couture's gain. He told me that as a Save the Children ambassador, he successfully raised RM500,000 by donating a print of Princess Diana to build the **El Salvador Clinic** in his native Peru. He also raised funds for a Moscow cancer clinic for children.

"My brother died from cancer when he was ten years old. I was seventeen then and I felt so helpless, impotent, not able to do anything. One day he complained of an ache in his arm. The doctors said it was nothing serious. But he turned yellow and it turned out the ache had been caused by three tumours."

The loss of his brother had a lasting impact on him, and inspired him 30 years later to come out with the book **"Kids"** which celebrates childhood. Testino donated sales proceeds of the book to the **Sargent Cancer Care for Children**.

He explains, "Doing these charitable things has made me feel I have got some of my priestly instincts back. I know people who have everything and all they do is complain and bicker. That's giving off negative energy. When you do something positive, it not only helps others but makes you feel better too. "I don't seek glory or fame when I help to raise funds for charity. I just do it as I know that it is the right thing to do!"



In 2008, he donated a personal photo session with him at Elton John's celebrated annual **White Tie and Tiara Ball**, which was successfully auctioned for a staggering RM4 million to a Ukrainian tycoon. The money went to AIDS, another cause he strongly champions.

Born in 1954 in Lima, Peru, to Italian, Irish and Spanish parentage, the teenager was set to enter the priesthood but his businessman father brought him to New York as an interpreter. It was a case of 'Camera, Lights, Action'! The energy and lifestyle of the rich and famous seduced him and God's calling was put aside. Of course, now that he is a celebrity in his own right, Mario Testino can do infinitely more good by raising funds and bringing attention to worthy causes. He accepts that this just shows that God moves in mysterious ways.

After studying Economics at University of the Pacific and Catholic University of Lima, he went on to the University of San Diego in California to take up International Relations. In 1976, he moved to London and stayed for seven years in one of the 14 rooms in the abandoned Charing Cross Hospital. It was not exactly a bed of roses. To ensure he stood out, he dyed his hair pink. To keep body and soul together, he worked as a waiter.

That humble job was to open doorways undreamt of. Serving a table of editors from British Vogue, he befriended them. They agreed to see his work, and the rest as they say is history. He was 23 then, and with British Vogue commissioning him for assignments, Testino soon found himself freelancing for this premier magazine. One assignment led to another... and as he tells it, "If you have to work as a waiter, choose a hip and happening restaurant frequented by trendy movers and shakers. You never know who might just walk in one day!"

Amongst many others, he also befriended **Carine Roitfeld**, who would become the powerful Editor of French Vogue. Making all these valuable contacts proved useful, and his phone book was eventually to become his most prized asset.

In 1991 his father died of cancer. Grief-stricken, he consulted a medium recommended by **Christian Lacroix**, who predicted a life-changing event on 15 October. By chance or coincidence, he was asked to **>** Mario Testino with Chief Editor of Vogue US, Anna Wintour.



"That was a turning point," he said.

Instead of the usual formal, elegant sitting, he persuaded Princess Diana to pose in a relaxed, fun and happy manner, a side of British royalty seldom seen in public. They bonded within minutes of meeting and when Princess Diana was sitting prettily on the sofa, Testino asked her to move. He threw himself on the sofa on his stomach and asked if she could so the same. She grinned, "I think this might be more comfortable."

The results were sensational. His photographs of Diana became legendary as they showed the real woman behind the Princess who had become such a beloved icon.

His books 'Any Objections?' and 'Front Row, Back Seat' were released in 1998 and 1999. 'Portraits' was published to celebrate his Exhibition at the National Portrait Gallery in London in 2002. This held the record for a decade for the most number of visitors.

He recalled, "When staying at Charing Cross Hospital, I used to walk past the National Portrait Gallery daily to catch the bus. There

I was 25 years later, with huge banners outside with my name on them! Yes, yes, dreams do come true, even if you have to wait a quarter century."

His collaboration with the British Royal Family continues. He was commissioned to take Prince Harry's 18th and 21st birthday portraits. In 2005, he was honoured with his plaque on Rodeo Drive Walk of Style in Beverly Hills for his contribution to fashion and show business. In 2006, he took commemorative photos of Prince Charles and Camilla, Duchess of Cornwall to celebrate their first wedding anniversary. And of course, the famous photo of Prince William and Kate Middleton hugging during their official engagement was also taken by him.

Of the favoured royal couple, he has this to say, "Prince William could not have found anyone more suitable than Catherine. Their energy and the clear sense they are working together as a team is truly amazing. While she has developed a perfect sense of royal responsibility, the Duchess brings life and a delightful sense of humour into the room as soon as she walks in."

A final question; What is his favourite camera? A Leica?

"Hasselblad," was his quick reply. Though he added hastily, "Of course, I can still take great photos with an Instamatic!"

Phng Li Kim of *`The Paranormal Zone'* talks to various experts about the mystery of this magnificent creature of legend. She looks at the myths surrounding the Dragon and catches up with the inimitable Lillian Too with whom she has an enlightening conversation...

here was a time when chivalrous knights would roam lands far and near, rescuing damsels in distress from the clutches of firebreathing dragons (or so they tell us). These days, however, dragons only seem to appear on the silver screen, either as evil monsters, which the hero strives to slay, or as man's best friend, helping in various ways.

So is the magnificent dragon simply an enduring myth or is there more to the Dragon than many of us realize? We know that many ancient cultures boast many a draconic tale in some guise or other. Think of the *Y Ddraig Goch* ('the red dragon') of Welsh legend, The Welsh the celestial lung of Chinese myths and the *fabular naga* of old Indian texts, and you begin to get an idea of how universal this supposedly mythical creature is, and how deeplyrooted is its existence in our psyche. To the Chinese for sure, the Dragon is something special, as it is not only a feng shui icon, it is also one amongst the 12 animals of the

Chinese Zodiac.

But it is not just in the East. The English too have their Dragon, but theirs is an evil dragon, and Saint George who slays the Dragon is an immortal hero to the West. Then there is the European Dragon contained in village folk stories, although these tend to look like the dinosaur with two webbed wings. The Western Dragon is often viewed as demonic.

The Asian dragon, however, is quite a different creature altogether. To Asians, the Dragon is mythical and represents a great auspiciousness. Here, the Dragon is serpentine in shape, manifesting as the *naga* and *lung* i.e. as the water snake or as the sky-flying Dragon.

In Buddhist legends, Dragons are sometimes referred to as *nagas*, serpent-like creatures with human characteristics that reside in water. Nagas from some areas of south India are revered for bringing fertility and wealth to those who supplicate them. In Hinduism, *nagas* carry the elixir of life and immortality. They are not generally regarded as harmful to humans, although they can be. Nagas are often referred to as being part of the entourage of Enlightened Masters. In China, the Dragon is also referred to as the *lung*, and this creature has a majestically long body with glistening scales, the legs of a bird with different numbers of claws and horns, and which breathes fire. Descriptions of the Chinese Dragon originate from Chinese folklore, and they are regarded with great fondness. The Chinese Dragon is considered a benevolent creature, who is high up the pecking order in the hierarchy of real and mythical creatures.

It has celestial stature and has been associated with the Emperors of China and the Imperial throne since antiquity. Historically, the iconography of the Imperial Dragon is interesting in that only the Imperial dragon is depicted with five claws. According to Feng Shui, the celestial Dragon is the ultimate good luck symbol and it features in all the Chinese divination sciences.


THE PARANORMAL ZONE, a popular TV series in Malaysia which explores unexplained phenomena, is airing a very special presentation that examines the legend of the Dragon right here in Malaysia. In a double episode on Dragons, *Phng Li Kim*, the sparkling and dynamic host of The Paranormal Zone, explores this challenging subject and discusses the Dragon of mythical lore and ancient legend.

Li Kim shares that "When I first received the manuscript on Dragons,



I was reluctant to follow through with its investigation. But something within me urged me to continue, and after some thought, I decided to trust my inner voice."

Her research included meetings with **Antares**, an author, musician and cosmic mythologist, **Mr Tapa**, a survivor and witness of the Pos Dipang mudslide tragedy in 1996 and whose father was a shaman of the Orang Asli or indigenous people, and **Russell Chen**, a young story-teller and Dragon researcher.



It was only natural that Li Kim was drawn to discuss this exciting and mysterious topic with international bestselling author and feng shui expert, Lillian Too. After all, Lillian has had over 35 years of research in the intriguing subject of Dragons, having published a book on Dragons herself called The Chinese Dragon in 1987. Lillian agreed to be featured in The Paranormal Zone's episode on Dragons, and was more than happy to share her knowledge with Li Kim.

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What sparked Lillian's interest to appear on the show was when she was shown an aerial map of *Bukit Tabur*, also known as *Bukit Hangus*, by Wendy Loh, the researcher/ scriptwriter of The Paranormal Zone. *Bukit Tabur is a hill located in Taman Melawati, Malaysia*. At the peak of Bukit Tabur, a three-to fourhour steep climb, a hiker is rewarded with a *view of a lake, which looks remarkably like a Dragon!*

Lillian exclaimed, "You can see the two horns of the Dragon, the beautiful face of the Dragon, and even its claws; it has got five claws, and it is actually a river system. Wow I think that's amazing."

In her interview with Li Kim, Lillian shared that she definitely believes in Dragons and in the energy of the Dragons. She says, "It's all about energy. If I believe that this image is lucky, and I put it here, and I believe it will bring me good fortune, it will. Why? Because the mind is so incredibly powerful. If you don't believe in it, the Dragon does nothing for you! But because I believe it, I wear a Dragon ring, a Dragon watch, and have lots of Dragons all over my house. It has truly become my secret friend! And it has brought me a great deal of good fortune!"

Not only does Lillian discuss Dragons in this interview, she also shares interesting insights with Li Kim about how the Dragon is part of the 'landscape' of Malaysia, which is why Malaysia's feng shui is so amazingly auspicious. Lillian tells us that Malaysia is literally a land of milk and honey, and that there are many Dragons here. She cautions however that if we are not careful when we build and excavate our land, we can inadvertently 'injure' a Dragon by cutting into 'Dragon Lines', which would bring forth catastrophes such as landslides.

When asked by Li Kim if she has seen a Dragon, Lillian gives a happy laugh and exclaims, "I see Dragons all the time, and of course people might think I'm crazy. Where's the Dragon? It's there! But they can't see it."

Which is why it is apt to quote Li Kim at this point: as she always says at the end of each episode, "What we see may not be real, what is real we may not see."

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LOOKING FOR SARAWAK'S WHITE RAJAHS

studied the White Rajahs when I was a schoolgirl in a convent school in Malaysia's Borneo state of Sarawak. They are very much part of Sarawak's modern history of course and especially Sir James Brooke who was styled the first Rajah. Their story is stuff straight out of a Victorian adventure novel or a Hollywood swashbuckling movie, and when you read about their exploits, it sounds like a movie script straight out of Mutiny of the Bounty-meets-Pirates of the Caribbean, except their story is very real. The Brooke Dynasty ruled Sarawak for over a hundred years from 1841 through to1946.


The Brookes from Britain left behind indelible legacies in the many

wonderful heritage buildings that still stand in Kuching, notably the castellated Astana, once the official residence of Rajah Charles Brooke and his son and successor Vyner Brooke, and now the official home of the governor

of Sarawak. By the **Astana** is **Fort Margherita**, built on a hill as defence against river invasions from rebels at the time. It is designated to be a museum dedicated to the White Rajahs, which will be curated by the Brooke Heritage Trust and scheduled to open in September 2014.

THE WHITE RAJAHS

The Brooke family hailed from Somerset, next to Devon, but James



Brooke's forebears spent most of their lives in the service of the **East India Company (1612 – 1874) in India**. This British company was formed to engage in trade with the East Indies, which covered countries in South and Southeast Asia, with shares owned by wealthy merchants and aristocrats.

James Brooke was born in India and educated in England. Like most young men of his social class then, ►

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
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he joined the army, but following his military career, he was later so inspired by the naval adventurers of the British East India Company, notably **Stamford Raffles**, founder of Singapore, that he used the substantial inheritance his father had left him to purchase a 142-ton topsail schooner called *The Royalist*, equipped with canons and other weaponry. It became in effect a private war ship and was accorded the same rights as the Royal Navy.

James Brooke arrived in Sarawak on the *Royalist* in 1838 and was soon enlisted by the then **Sultan** (of Brunei) to quell rebellion from the indigenous people and to fight against piracy. Brooke and his wellarmed ship easily suppressed the uprising and in gratitude, *the Sultan* granted him the title of Rajah to the fiefdom of Sarawak on 18th August 1842. James Brooke's adventures read like Indiana Jones episodes, but he brought peace and order to Sarawak. He was succeeded by his nephew **Charles Brooke**, who in turn was followed by his son **Vyner Brooke**. The latter is credited with introducing political reform in Sarawak.

The Brookes were not conquerors of Sarawak in the traditional sense. They saw themselves as Protectors, keeping the State's indigenous wealth safe from western capitalist exploitation.

In the words of Rajah James Brooke, "Sarawak belongs to the Malays, the Sea Dayaks (Ibans), the Land Dayaks (Bidayuhs), the Kayans and other tribes, not to us. It is for them that we labour, not ourselves." Following the Japanese occupation from 1941 till 1945, Vyner Brooke ceded Sarawak to the British Crown Colony in 1946. Sarawak became a colony of Britain until it joined Malaysia in 1963.

FROM SARAWAK TO SHEEPSTOR

Fast forward forty years, I now live in England and I discover that the three White Rajahs of Sarawak are buried in a small village called Sheepstor in a remote part of Devon in Dartmoor. James Brooke settled in this village after his retirement in Sarawak and forged a close relationship with the local community. He helped to raise funds to restore the parish church and made known his wish to be buried in the churchyard. He died in 1868 and was buried there, thus starting a tradition of each subsequent ruling



Brooke family being interred there. I decide to pay my respects to these rajahs who had fascinated me in my schooldays.

On a bleak day, I find myself in a lonely churchyard in the grounds of St Leonard's Church in Sheepstor. The wind is howling through the trees, the leaves rustling on the ground. The churchyard seems to come alive eerily as I look for the four tombstones I am looking for. There, before me, protected by a wrought iron fence in a corner of the graveyard are the resting places of the three rajahs - Sir James Brooke, Sir Charles Brooke, Sir Vyner Brooke and his brother Bertram Brooke, lying in silent sentinel far away from their glorious past. You can't find a place more different from Sarawak than this lonely corner of Devon.

At last, I feel the **white rajahs** actually did exist. They are not just characters from a history book. Outside the iron fence are graves of the other Brooke family members, including Sir Anthony Brooke, the nephew of Vyner Brooke, the last rajah of Sarawak. Sir Anthony was the last *Raja Muda* or heir apparent to the Brooke rule, and he died in 2011 Plymouth owes its prosperity to its auspicious position at the energy sweet spot nestled between the River Plym to the East and the River Tamar to the West. at the age of 98. I met his grandson Jason Brooke last year in London. It was like meeting royalty; the Brookes are considered royal by us people of Sarawak. The tombs of the Rajahs are important enough to be listed as Grade II monuments by the English Heritage.

St. Leonard's church dates back to the 15th century in this tiny village of Sheepstor. I enter the church through a solid wooden door and it is like entering a surreal world, with a typically English village church *but a world of adventure from the wilds of Borneo on the inside.* Plaques charting the lives of the Brooke family in Sarawak are mounted on the wall. I see a big bronze bust of Sir James Brooke in a corner placed on top of a faded pua kumbu, a ceremonial tapestry commonly woven by the women of the Iban tribe in Sarawak. These tapestries are like spiritual artworks, with designs that come to the weavers in dreams, often of stylised people and animals. There are other pieces of *pua kumbus* around the church, gifts from the people of Sarawak.

In the southern part of the church is the **Sarawak Window**, a memorial stained glass window dedicated to the people of Sarawak and to the British who were killed during the Japanese occupation. It depicts the insignia of the Brookes and also the flora and fauna of Sarawak. There are pitcher plants, an Atlas moth and the Rajah Brooke birdwing butterfly named after James Brooke worked into the window panes.

On the same wall is the Brookes' coat of arms bearing the Sarawak flag ►


with the family motto "*Dum Spiro Spero*" in Latin meaning, "*While I breathe, I hope.*" I feel a sense of nostalgia observing these touching objects from my home country and the dedication of this small community to the Brooke family.

PLYMOUTH - IT ALL STARTED HERE

James Brooke set sail on the Royalist from Devonport in Plymouth in 1838. I feel compelled to visit this famous naval city on the south coast of Devon. It was a trading post since the Roman Empire. In 1620, the early settlers who were known as Pilgrim Fathers sailed from Plymouth for the New World (the Americas) aboard the ship Mayflower.

Today, Plymouth is a thriving port with ferry links to Spain and France, and is the largest operational naval base in Western Europe. Its streets of old cobbled stones run along historic buildings and there are numerous old pubs and inns that once housed sailors and traders.

Plymouth owes its prosperity to its auspicious position at the energy sweet spot nestled between the River Plym to the East and the River Tamar to the West. Both rivers flow into the Plymouth Sound, which is protected from the sea by the Plymouth Breakwater, a stone wall, 1,560m



long. The breakwater harnesses the energy from the water and contributes to the city's prosperity.

The Royal Citadel, an imposing fortress built in 1666 to defend against naval attack, dominates the city. Further down the promenade is an open space of lawns with naval monuments and a prominent statue of Sir Francis Drake (1540-1596), famous sea captain of the Elizabethan era. He was the second person to circumnavigate the world after Magellan, the Portuguese explorer. This vast expanse of open space overlooking the sea has the "bright hall" effect conveying yang energy to the city.

My search for the White Rajahs is complete as I leave Plymouth, the port where James Brooke first set sail on his propitious journey to Sarawak. The legacy of the Brookes is a romantic, spell-binding saga, and I hear there are plans for a Hollywood movie in the pipeline. I wonder if there is a role for a middle-aged Sarawakian lady living in England... well, it is a wrap for me on the quest of the White Rajahs. ■

ITSIN YOUR YOUR HANDS THE BODY'S MICROCOSM MAPPED OUT ON THE PALM By HONEY LIM

A favourite weekend ritual is my regular visit to my Foot Reflexologist. I feel a big difference in my wellbeing if I go too long without a reflex. The quality of my sleep suffers, my clarity of thinking goes haywire, and my energy levels drop. He tells me it is because as we age, blood circulation in the body gets sluggish. Lack of exercise and the build up of toxins causes the body to go out of sync. Regular reflexology sessions will fix these ills. Blood circulation improves. Toxins get eliminated!


o what if you hit a busy period and cannot make time for a reflex session? Here's what he advised. One way to keep blood circulation humming along healthily is to give yourself a "HAND REFLEX". Pressing the hands and ears can be as effective as a foot reflex. This is because there are also hundreds of reflexology points buried deep within the palm and at the back of the hands and earlobes. And if you know how to massage these points, you can really give your body a wonderful boost.

The entire microcosm of the body can be found on the hands, feet and earlobes. Massaging the points under the feet on your own can be challenging as it is difficult to apply deep pressure on the points there; in any case, foot reflexology works best when the legs are stretched out.


But reflex points on the hands can be accessed very easily, and all reflex points on the feet can also be found on the hands. Even if you didn't know anything about reflexology and began by pressing various points on your hands using your thumb, you'll start to discover certain spots that feel very tender when deep pressure is applied! Sometimes you can feel grainy, sandlike deposits moving under the flesh and this is a sign that energy flow and blood circulation to these organs may be blocked. These are areas that you should massage until they dissolve, and in doing so, should help remove blockages of energy and blood-flow to these organs. Pressing reflex points causes the muscles to relax, blood vessels to open, thereby increasing circulation. This in turn increases the amount of available oxygen and nutrients that get to cells in that part of the body.

IMPROVE DIGESTION, LIVER & KIDNEY HEALTH WITH THE ROTATING BALL TECHNIQUE

A common problem people suffer from is poor digestive health. If you are having a gassy stomach, feel bloated or experience constipation, then pressing reflex points that relate to the digestive areas can be really helpful.



A simple technique is the "Chinese Ball" technique - which entails rolling a smooth but hard wooden ball in a clockwise direction between the two palms, pressing firmly as you do so. These wooden balls can be purchased in Chinese shops that sell massage equipment, but if you cannot get them, a golf ball will do. The key is to use a very hard ball and roll it firmly between the palms. If this is your first time, you will likely feel some pain at certain points of your palm and this is normal; you might even feel a crunchy, grainy texture as the ball rolls over parts of the palm - this is a sign of mineral build-up breaking down as you massage it! Try to roll the ball over your entire palm paying




attention to the sides and the fleshy bits just below your phalanges and also the area under the thumb.

This simple technique tackles a variety of reflex points that give relief to the stomach, abdomen, liver, kidneys, lungs, chest, digestive track and intestines. Roll the ball for about one minute or more, and at the end, you should be able to feel a vibrant tingling sensation on both your palms. If you don't feel any tingling, it means you haven't applied enough pressure! Your hands should feel very hot and appear very pink, a sign that you have managed to activate the right points, and that a strong flow of blood is circulating on your palm!

SECRET TO A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP

The reflexology points that relate to healthy sleep, mental alertness and balanced hormonal functions are points that map to the pituitary gland, head and brain. If you have insomnia and hormone relatedimbalances, then massaging the point that relates to your pituitary gland



can do wonders for you!


The pituitary gland is a small part of the brain that controls the secretion of nine major hormones that influence growth, healing, youthfulness, sexual development, metabolism, female menstrual cycle, mineral and sugar content of the blood, fluid retention and energy levels. These hormones are responsible for maintaining the health of our cell structures and can prevent excessive fat accumulation.

On the feet, the pituitary gland reflex point is on the whorl of the big toe. On the hands, the same point is mapped to the centre of the swirl of the thumbprint. The best way to massage this area is to apply an even and deep rotary (circular) pressure on the thumb using the knuckle of the index finger on the other hand (see photo). Because the pituitary gland is very sensitive and easily thrown off-balance, the points that link to the gland are often very tender and sensitive.

If this is your first time massaging it, you will feel a sharp, pinching sensation. This is a good sign, as it means you have hit the right spot! Gently massage with deep and even pressure for 30 seconds to 1 minute, and then repeat on the other thumb. Regular massaging of this area will reduce the tenderness of this point and will, over time, improve the quality of your sleep.

MENTAL ALERTNESS AND SINUSES

Meanwhile, sinus reflex points are mapped very close-by, so when you apply the same technique to the finger tips, you will be massaging both points. Again, you are likely to ►




feel a pinching sensation when you first massage these points. The more tender it feels, the greater the need to stimulate that point. With regular stimulation, the pinching sensation is replaced with a dull but comforting sensation!


If you are prone to nasal congestion due to allergies, sensitive sinuses or you are experiencing a cold, these are excellent points to massage. They will aid your recovery. Another region closely related to congestion are the ear, nose and throat areas, which are located on the phalanges of the fingers. To stimulate these points, massage by placing the phalanges of one hand between the thumb and index finger on the other hand, and then work your way outwards (from the base of the fingers towards the tips). Both upper and lower sides of the phalanges should be massaged to ensure that all necessary points are covered.



The reproductive organs for both men and women are located at the base where the wrist meets the hand. This applies to both the front and back of the hands. For women, the uterus and ovaries are located here and it wraps around the wrist like a bracelet. Massaging these areas can improve the menstrual cycle and relieve symptoms of menopause in older women. For men, the same areas are mapped to the prostate and testes. Regular massage of these points should improve sexual libido for both men and women. Refer to the chart above and use your thumb to apply rotary pressure in these areas. If tender, continue pressing gently and more often. These points should not be massaged if you are menstruating or pregnant.



MOTION SICKNESS, NAUSEA AND HEADACHES



If you suffer from motion sickness when travelling by car or boat, this special point is worth a mention. In Chinese acupressure, this point is referred to as L14, and the easiest way to find it is to lay the hand flat on the table, then close the thumb towards the index finger. You should see a bulge appearing at the end of the crease between your thumb and index finger. The highest point of the bulge is where L14 is located. Using the thumb of your other hand, press firmly on L14 for about 20 seconds. There is no need to massage it; just applying consistent pressure will do the trick!

Another location that works wonders for nausea and motion sickness is the pericardium (marked



as point PC6) in the acupressure chart. This is a tender spot located about three fingers from the joint of your wrist. Use your thumb to apply steady pressure on this point for about 60 seconds. These two pressure points can relieve the feeling of nausea and can help cure headaches as well.

BACK AND SHOULDER PAIN

If you suffer from back and shoulder muscle pain, the best points to stimulate are areas related to the spine and shoulders. Reflex points that map to the spinal column are located on the outer side of the hand



just beneath the thumb, and continue till where the hand meets the wrist. Start pressing the points from the wrist and work your way towards the base of the thumb's fingernail. Regular massages on this part of the hand are great for relieving back pain.

To relieve shoulder pain, massage the fleshy part just under the pinky fingers.

REMEMBER TO DRINK PLENTY OF WATER

The best time to have a self-reflex session is at the end of the day several hours before bed time! Avoid doing it on a full stomach, and while stimulating the pressure points, remember that while getting relief from pain, you are also giving your body a cleansing and detoxifying treatment. But efficient

> elimination of toxins can only happen when the body is wellhydrated! So you need to drink plenty of water! Experts recommend at least three glasses of water within three hours following a reflexology session.



The Health Amulet Keychain features the Golden Wu Lou for deflecting illness vibes, and the Medicine Buddha to promote healing and wellness. In 2014, it is highly recommended for those born in Rooster and Rabbit years, and those whose bedrooms or offices are located in the East or West to carry this amulet throughout the year. Animal signs with low health luck ratings can also benefit from carrying this amulet.

Cucumbers add tang and crunch and flavour and goodness to any dish. They are easy to buy and go with just about every kind of cuisine. But did you know that the cool cucumber is also a source of great B vitamins? So they are an amazing pick-me-up when you need a quick boost of energy. They are also a super pest repellant, they clear the look of glass in seconds, and they tighten your skin so fast they are better than any expensive cream if you wish to smooth out tiredness and wrinkles in a jiffy. Here are ten fabulous ways to use a few slices of cucumber!



SOURCE OF B VITAMINS

Fresh cucumbers are such a great source of the vitamins and elements needed to enjoy good daily health. They also give us plenty of energy. Just consider - a single cucumber contains Vitamin B1, B2, B3, B5, B6, Folic Acid, Vitamin C, Calcium, Iron, Magnesium, Phosphorus, Potassium and Zinc. If you want to skip lunch and are looking for a really great substitute, consider having a couple of slices of cucumbers. They will give you the kind of pick-me-up that will last several hours!



2EXCELLENT FOR CLEARING GLASS

If you swim and your goggles keep getting fogged up, rub a freshly-cut cucumber slice onto the glass, and like magic it will eliminate the fog instantly. You can also use cucumber slices to get rid of fogged-up steam that sticks to bathroom mirrors. The cucumber also leaves behind a very pleasant, spa-like fragrance.

3GET RID OF GARDEN

When gardening, it can be really tough getting rid of the aphids and snails that mess about with newly-blooming buds. But simply placing a few slices of cucumber in

a small pie tin can keep your garden free of pests for a whole month. The chemicals in cucumbers react with the aluminium to emit a special scent undetectable to humans, but which all garden pests dislike intensely; so they stay well away!



4 FOR REMOVING UNWANTED FAT LUMPS AND BUMPS

When you want to look good urgently and need a quick way to disguise your cellulite before wearing your bikini, try rubbing a slice of cucumber along your problem area for a few minutes. The chemicals in the cucumber will instantly cause your skin to tighten, firming up the outer layer and reducing the visibility of fatty lumps and bumps. You can do the same to eliminate wrinkles temporarily for some important evening occasion when you have to look fresh and beautiful.



5 GET RID OF A HANGOVER OR A HEADACHE Just back from a party and have had too much to drink? You can

If you have an important meeting or job interview and your shoes are looking grubby, rub some freshlycut cucumber slices over your leather shoes and let the cucumber chemicals give your shoes an instant shine that not only looks great but also repels water.





TO FIX A SQUEAKY

Take a cucumber slice and rub it along a squeaky hinge that is driving you wild with irritation. You will be surprised how quickly cucumber does its job. In an instant, the problematic squeak vanishes!

BAS A BREATH FRESHENER

Run out of fresh mints and disgusted with your breath? Take a slice of cucumber and press it to the roof of your mouth with your tongue for 30 seconds. This will completely eliminate your bad breath. The chemicals in the cucumber will kill off the bacteria in your mouth responsible for causing bad breath.



9 POWERFUL ANTI-DEPRESSANT AND DE-STRESSING AGENT

If you are feeling stressed out and don't have time for a massage, reflex or facial, try this. Cut up an entire cucumber, place it in a boiling pot of water and wait for the steam to emerge. The nutrients from the cucumber will react with the boiling water to release a wonderful fragrant steam that acts like a powerful anti-depressant. The steam will soothe you with its fabulous aroma and is great for relaxing overworked and hassled mothers. Also super for students suffering from exam nerves.

1 OAS A CLEANING AGENT FOR YOUR SINKS

If you want an easy way to clean your faucets, sinks and kitchen equipment, use a slice of cucumber to rub onto the surface you want to clean. Like magic, watch it remove years of tarnish and bring back the shine. Not only does the cucumber give you a good clean, it also does not leave streaks and will neither hurt your fingers nor spoil your nailpolish as you clean. ■

DISASTER MAKES BIG NEWS IN HONG KONG

Famous Hong Kong Feng Shui Master Zheng Guoqiang was buried alive seconds after announcing he had found the perfect spot for the grave of recently deceased wealthy Hong Kong businessman!

he scenario resembled a badly written, B-grade horror movie as narrated by the sole survivor of a landslide that buried 7 people. Five died on the spot including the renowned feng shui master. One died in hospital. So what do we make of this? I described this true tale of woe to Lillian and her response is enlightening indeed... makes me understand her brand of feng shui a lot better! But here is what happened... After carefully scouting the hillside cemetery grounds in mainland China for the most suitable, potent and beneficial burial site for the deceased **De Meng**, feng shui master Zheng Guoqiang from Hong Kong finally announced he had found the perfect spot with perfect feng shui. He spoke with a flourish, stretching his arms out wide, and even as the words

left his mouth, the earth rumbled and a huge mudslide slid behind him, bringing down tons of earth, rock and vegetation, burying the entire group of seven who were with him on that hill!

The seven included a Taoist priest with surname Wu, two family members, three executives from the cemetery showing the available spots and the feng shui master.

Cheng Kwok-kuen or Zheng Guoqiang counted many celebrities as his clients, and Hong Kong's newspaper *Sing Tao Daily* reported that he often came to mainland China to undertake feng shui consultations.

In land-scarce Hong Kong, building large mausoleums are officially frowned upon unless you are in the same league as Li Ka-Shing. So the family of De Meng, 75, commissioned Zheng Guoqiang, 55 to visit the cemetery at Zhaoqing just across the border in By KEE HUA CHEE



Guangdong province where land is more easily available.

Zheng checked the available plots of land armed with feng shui

compass having collated the horoscopes of the deceased and immediate family. It was reported he used the Zuan Kong feng shui method for yin dwellings, graveyard sites that would bring auspicious luck for the descendents.

But as Lillian often tells her students, one needs to be careful practising this branch of Zuan Kong feng shui as it can be very dangerous if you do not have the necessary protectors! Feng shui masters are not immune to the dangers of yin feng shui!

After several hours of braving the rain and wind (the two most vital elements of feng shui, which means wind and water), he assembled the group at the fatal spot and announced it had 'perfect vibrations for housing the deceased's body'.

Then, like in a horror movie, after he spoke, the earth vibrated, trembled and shook, sending down the massive, deadly mudslide.

Hong Kong's feng shui savvy public was incredulous. Many queried if Zheng Quoqiang should have seen it coming if he claimed to be such an expert on feng shui. Even his colleague, the much younger **Lee Chengze**, went on television to express his shock. "Master Zheng should not have visited the cemetery, as during that period, the weather was treacherous and violent, and 15 people had already been killed. That day was wet, windy and raining, and one should have avoided visiting cemeteries altogether."

Ten people from the Guangdong province had already

died, so Zheng was seen to have been challenging the fates and courting death, as massive storms had wreaked havoc on 7 provinces and 71 districts.

But Lillian Too has another explanation for the deaths. Lillian explained that the feng shui master had probably not obtained the necessary permission from the Protectors of the cemetery, and to presume that a foreign deceased would be welcome onto the mainland cemetery was presumptuous. She suggested that the deaths were not only due to a major imbalance of yin and yang, as "cemeteries are yin places", but that they are always also protected by Cosmic Guardians. Feng shui practitioners must be schooled in Taoist meditations and rituals to appease these guardians. Not doing so and announcing so loudly to the winds is definitely asking for trouble.

Lillian Too thus believes that the local worldly Gods, Deities and Protector Spirits who had not been properly appeased or had their permission been sought had expressed their displeasure! "It could be that the protector spirits were simply 'defending' their territory, so to speak, by preventing rank outsiders from Hong Kong from 'annexing' their turf. By creating a landslide, they had instantly removed what they saw as an irritant on their soil. Very tragic, but tomb location is a very complex practice, and only those who are truly well-versed with decades of experience should undertake such assignments." As you never know if the site you choose was actually meant for your client or yourself!

YIN FENG SHUL

In ancient China, Yin House Feng Shui for the dead is generally considered as important as Yang House Feng Shui for the living!

Also known as Graveyard Feng Shui, Yin Feng Shui, Burial Feng Shui or Tombstone Feng Shui, Yin House Feng Shui was one of the guiding forces in ancient Chinese metaphysics, where it was believed that burying their

dead in an auspicious location in alignment with their birth date is what will ensure good fortune for the descendants.

To capture the Dragon's Chi, the site should not be overly exposed to the elements. Done correctly, yin feng shui results in multiple manifestations of good fortune, including wealth, health, educational success and social status.

Should the burial site be carelessly chosen so that it is constantly exposed to strong winds or scorching sunshine, is regularly flooded by rainwater with no proper channels or is devoid of sunlight, descendants are sure to suffer various forms of bad luck. When trees with big roots penetrate into the coffin, it brings a disastrous consequence to the children and grandchildren of the deceased. This explains the importance of *Cheng Beng* when the graves of ancestors are cleaned and when local spirit protectors are appeased with offerings.

The tomb of the father of **Zhu Yuan Zhang**, founder of the Ming Dynasty, is often touted as a good example of excellent feng shui, as it created the luck for Zhu to defeat the Mongols and establish the Ming Dynasty, which lasted through fifteen Ming emperors, although this fact caused the Emperor to ban the practice of feng shui throughout his reign. In the Ming Dynasty, Lillian explains that feng shui was forced underground as the Emperor had decreed that if indeed feng shui was so powerful, the practice had to be banned completely, lest it be used to cause the fall of the Dynasty.



Chinese historians have also gone in search of the ancestral graves of luminaries such as **Sun Yat Sen**, **Chiang Kai Shek** and **Mao Zedong** with a view to examining the gravesite attributes that might have provided satisfactory explanations for their big political success.

Mao Zedong's father had been a wealthy farmer, but his grandfather was said to be the one responsible for Mao's rise. The grandfather had personally selected his burial site but had not been buried inside the grave for seven years, to accommodate an auspicious date that would set into motion the incredibly powerful forces that would propel his grandson to become a latter day "emperor"!

Yin Feng Shui is a complex process and it is unlikely that there are many practitioners who are truly qualified to practise. For sure, young practitioners with insufficient appreciation of the protector rituals and prayers should not meddle in this kind of feng shui. ■

USEFUL NOTES ON YIN FENG SHUI The 6 preliminary rules for choosing an auspicious burial site:

The location orientation should not clash with the astrological details of the deceased and all direct male descendents.

2 The head of the deceased needs to point to an auspicious direction. This is vital to the continued good fortune of the family name and line.

3 All prayer rituals and ceremonies must be conducted at auspicious times and dates. In fact, the selection of dates is a vital part of the burial ritual.

4 The entrance direction of water also known as the *water mouth* must be precisely positioned; this as well as the flow of rain water away must be designed to prevent flooding of any kind. The ground must never be allowed to get soggy. Feng shui masters well-schooled in Yin Feng Shui usually create a *cosmic parallel* drain (not a physical drain but an imaginary one) that maximises an immense flow of good luck directed towards the descendants of the deceased person occupying the site. This is the most important aspect of Yin Feng Shui, as it is the flow of water around the grave that can literally pour forth immeasurable good fortune for the descendants.

5 The most popular feng shui formula for Yin Feng Shui uses the Sarn Yuan Luo Pan incorporating the trigrams and hexagrams of the I Ching. This is a branch of Zuan Kong feng shui, which is part of Flying Star.

6 Finally, the horseshoe, omega, armchair or U-shaped tomb must be maintained, as only this particular shape can hold 'the vital breath within'. This structure keeps the deceased within the protective embrace of Green Dragon and White Tiger, which are extremely powerful forces.

BELIEFS & SUPERSTITIONS

1 The Chinese believe that it is very unlucky to erect any kind of fencing or wall around the tomb. When the tomb is locked in, the situation for the descendants is that they too will get locked in i.e. sent into jail.

2 Do not cement or cover the top portion of the tomb with bricks. Doing so causes family members to suffer from terrible illness. Plant grass on top.

3 Do not plant colourful or flowering plants on top of the tomb. When there are flowering plants growing off the tomb, the female members of the family will find it difficult to find a husband.

It is not a good idea to plant a tree to provide shade for the tomb, as the roots may destroy the coffin. This is certain to lead to financial ruin.

5 The soil on the tomb must never be concave but plumped out, or the family will suffer from breathing difficulties and lung-related illnesses.

6 When the tomb site clashes with feng shui annual afflictions, the burial should not take place until an auspicious date, which can be days, months or even years later!



SARAGERED SARAGERED THE LECACY OF KINC RICHARD BY HELEN ON

here is always a pang of sadness in my heart when I go to Sarastro. It reminds me of **Richard Niazi**, the late owner of **Sarastro Restaurant**. He was an ebullient and flamboyant character full of the zest of life, and he had a heart of gold. His contribution to the attractions of Covent Garden and his generosity to destitute retired actors and the homeless were legendary and gained him the moniker of "King **Richard of Covent Garden**."

Every Christmas, he would hold a Christmas party for this underprivileged sector of society. His untimely death at the age of 67 was a great loss to the community and to the many charities he supported. He was a gourmand extraordinaire and a lover of opera and music. Whisky in one hand and a cigarette in the other, he would regale me with his adventures and life stories when he was a young man. He came to London from northern Cyprus, the Turkish side of the island, when he was seventeen as a stowaway on a ship bound for UK. The only job he could find was as a kitchen boy in a restaurant, which set him on a path to being a restaurateur in his later life.

After years of struggling and working his way up, he acquired a semi-derelict corner property that the Westminster council had been used as a doss-house for the homeless and vagrants in Drury Lane, a once slummy part of London infamous for its prostitutes and gin-soaked outlets in the 18th century. It was



redeveloped in the 19th century and today, it forms the heart of London's theatre land in Covent Garden.

In August 1996, **King Richard** opened his restaurant and as a homage to opera, and he called his restaurant **Sarastro**, named after a character in Mozart's opera 'The Magic Flute'. Surrounded by theatres, he was inspired to create a theatrical theme for the restaurant. The bohemian decadence and exuberant ambience spiced up with a large dose of mischief bears the hallmark of King Richard, who had a wicked sense of humour.





FAREWELL TO THE KING

At his funeral in 2008, King Richard was sent off with a carnival livened up by a Hungarian gypsy band strumming guitars and belting out gypsy songs with gusto followed by a string quartet. Champagne and wine flowed freely for the bevy of mourners of family and friends. Mounted police and the Chelsea Pensioners of retired military personnel escorted his cortege as we said farewell to the King on his final journey to the restaurant in the sky.

It was the mother of all funerals. His memorial service a month later was equally festive with scantilyclad Brazilian samba dancers and musicians celebrating his life. More champagne and wine flowed to toast to the spirit of the King who was probably hosting a party for the angels in heaven as he did on earth. That was the command of King Richard on his deathbed, to be sent off with a celebration of his amazing life. His spirit still lives on in Sarastro and I always feel his presence when I am there.

the showbiz and theatre worlds, are politicians, tourists and the general public. It is a visual feast of opulent and flamboyant décor styled after a classical opera house. Indeed, most of the outlandish and ornate features are props and cast-offs from shows and operas in the theatres around the area.

It is an eclectic mix of gothic, rococo, Byzantine, Aladdin's cave and Arabian Nights all boldly featured like a Salvador Dali surreal artwork in kaleidoscopic vision. The theatrical setting comprises ten wall-mounted opera boxes with intimate booths on the ground level, holding a capacity seating for 250. The room is festooned with drapes of velvet, silk and lacy fabric and artefacts such as ballet shoes (contributions from ballerinas), weird and quirky things of a witch flying on a broom stick, a couple of huge bandaged mummy-like figures endowed with rather large phalluses, a golden Laughing Buddha, paintings and all sorts of bric-a-brac.

True to his mischievous sense of humour, King Richard commissioned artists to paint erotic art in the restrooms, which have won "best toilets in London" awards in the past. They are definitely not for the fainted hearted or prudes! The murals portray quite explicit erotic paintings, more art than pornography (depends on your sensitivity and outlook,) not quite suitable for junior eyes. Children have their own restrooms, which are primly decorated.

But Sarastro is a restaurant for grown-ups. On Sunday and Monday evenings and Sunday afternoons, there is a string quartet and live opera provided by professional singers from international opera houses including the Royal Opera House. Swing and Motown are played on Thursday evenings, currently starring **Colin Roy**, a West End actor and singer, while on Friday nights, the weekend kicks off with Latin rhythms performed by **Grace Rodson**.

A small area is cleared for diners to dance and show off some moves when the music picks up rhythmic tempo. It is a wonderful place for celebrating special occasions such as office Christmas parties, birthdays and anniversaries. Its lively atmosphere lends itself to a festive mood and it has been billed as "**The show after the show**", being a favourite of theatregoers in Covent Garden. If you come to Sarastro and feel miserable, **>**

A TURKISH DELIGHT

The cuisine is Mediterranean and Turkish, helmed by Chef Ali, a Turkish chef de cuisine who used to work at the famous Savoy Hotel in London. He and his four sou chefs conjure up a daily feast of an extensive selection of starters and main courses. showcasing some typical Turkish fare, of which the Lamb Anatolian (my favourite) is the signature dish. It is a generous portion of braised lamb shank cooked to perfection. The mezze starter has a selection of delicious Turkish snacks and the cheese borek, a cheese-filled puff pastry is especially yummy. There are equally delicious menus for vegetarians and kids.

The dessert is pure indulgence, especially Chef Ali's Raki Crème Brulee, infused with Raki, a traditional Turkish aniseed spirit served with 'Medjool Delight' dates. The food may not be haute cuisine, but it is heartily and skillfully prepared. A night out at Sarastro guarantees an evening of joviality and entertainment. As we sit down for a chat in my favourite opera box in the restaurant, Sibel and I reminisce on the good old days during her father's time and laugh at the antics her father used to get up to.

He was always up to mischief of some sort, like a naughty schoolboy, but always with a touch of mirth and humour. Sibel says pensively, "It was daunting at first to inherit this restaurant, but I am beginning to love the business. It is hard work with 24/7 commitments, but at the same time, satisfying when the business works. I have a duty to honour my father's



legacy." Since she has the DNA of King Richard coursing through her veins, there is no doubt this "Princess of Covent Garden" will do her father proud.

FENG SHUI X-FACTOR

Sarastro is one of the most successful restaurants in London. It is packed all the time, especially on weekends and show nights. Aside from clever market positioning with its unique decor and theme, **it enjoys great Feng Shui**. Located at the junction of Drury Lane and Kemble Street, it is situated at the confluence of energy flows that disseminate into the building.

Unlike any other restaurant in the city, Sarastro is surrounded by a lush mini urban street garden with flowers and foliage surrounding the exterior of the property grown in pots and troughs right on the pavement. This is one of King Richard's bequests and plants are such great purveyors of yang energy to the property.

At the entrance, the name Sarastro is spelt out in rows of coins and a few feet from the front door, an indentation on the floor is filled with coins, a wealth-enhancing symbol to the business. MY MOTHER LOOKED BEAUTIFUL IN DEATH

My mother took her last breath just after noon time after a hearty meal. It was a peaceful way to go and I was by her side just two minutes later. She was two months short of her 90th birthday and she chose a Monday to leave us, when every one of her children, her grandchildren and great grandchildren were in town to organize and arrange a beautiful send off and last rights for her. She looked incredibly beautiful on the day she died and because we used the package deal offered by Nirvana – to take away the hassle of arranging things – we were able to observe all the traditions and most importantly to arrange for and do all the PRAYERS we had to do to ensure she had a safe and comfortable journey through the BARDO and on to her next rebirth, although we prayed hard for her to be reborn in the Pure Land of Amitabha Buddha – which is the aspiration of all Buddhists, especially Chinese Mahayana Buddhists.

thought to share this beautiful experience of saying goodbye to my Mum with my readers because it is such a good way to talk about all the important things that must be done to facilitate her journey through Bardo and into the next life. The Chinese, especially those of us who are also practising Buddhists, believe that the *soul consciousness* does not necessarily leave the body immediately upon death; it does so only after the liquid mucus comes out from the mouth or nose... and this can take anything up to a week. High Lamas who are able to meditate in the clear light often stay in their bodies (which thus do not go cold) for as long as a week! This is why we usually prefer not to bury or cremate the body immediately.

We must also make certain that upon death, no one should touch the body until someone who knows how to do so can rub special Kalachakra sand on the crown of the head of the deceased, using butter to make sure the coloured sand sticks. Next is to pull the hair at the crown (rather vigorously). This is to ensure that the soul consciousness leaves the body through the crown, because this is one way to ensure that the soul consciousness does not inadvertently fall into a lower rebirth into the animal, ghost or hell realms. This can happen should anyone inadvertently touch any of the lower orifices of the body. Thus it was really fortunate that I was there with her within minutes of her passing. I also placed the mantra wheel of Namglyama (Buddha of Immortality) directly touching her chest and tied the Heart Sutra scarf around ber neck. This way I was able to ensure that her body, speech and mind (represented by her crown, throat and heart chakras) were safeguarded by the Dharma through her passage through the Bardo.

My mum's soul consciousness left her body that Monday and I immediately sensed her great joyousness at being free at last. I felt a very pure joy emanating from her body as she was young again, no longer suffering from her unmovable limbs



I resisted every effort to burst into tears. I knew I had to let her go and I was determined she should see me as happy as she seemed to be. I did not want even the smallest suggestion of attachment to this life to place obstacles or mar her way through the afterlife. Every member of our family made very sure not to cry in the presence of her deceased body.

I found a picture of her looking happy and healthy and I used this to place in front of the casket. Truly she looked lovely and it brought back such happy memories. I realized then that perhaps old people having Alzheimer's may not be such a bad thing after all. Why? Because I know she did not suffer any pain during the last years of her life. She was bedridden for 8 years. As for her memory, it was completely gone about six years ago... lying on her bed being cared for by a special maid with nursing training, she had occasionally showed signs of recognition; but all she did each day was listen to the chanting of mantras and pujas from various monasteries.

This purifies all her karmic debts and because she could not move much and could not speak and her mind had become forgetful, she surely could no longer incur any more negative karma through her body, her speech or her mind. This realization gave me great comfort. In those years when she stayed bedridden, we had arranged for so many prayers for her, done by all my high lamas who visited me, who stayed at our home and who got to know her quite well. They prayed for her soul consciousness to be purified of all the negative karmic debts we all incur in life...

Our prayers must have been answered because so many auspicious signs manifested for us to feel reassured **>**



that everything we could possibly have done for her actually got done - smoothly and without effort. My precious Guru, the incomparable CHODEN RINPOCHE, called within 30 minutes of her passing and told me He would be doing AMITABHA POWA for her immediately and He did. This is a special prayer, which ensures that her soul consciousness knows exactly how to move towards the bright light and to avoid the dim light, and more importantly, to invoke the dakinis to be by her side helping her along the path to the Pure Land of Sukhavati, which is the Pure Land of Amitabha, Buddha of Infinite Light.

The next day, my very precious and learned friend who is also my very beloved Guru, KHENPO DELEK RINPOCHE flew in from Taiwan in a surprise 1 day visit to do all the essential prayers through the day and night – stopping only to rest and have a light meal. Khenpo's incredible kindness did not stop there for he had earlier arranged for POWA to be done for my Mum by his root guru HH TATLUNG RINPOCHE, the Head of the Nyingma tradition and also HH SAKYA TRINZEN RINPOCHE, the Head of the Sakya Tradition, with whom he is also very close. And then He himself had come. He had brought with him the all-important 100 Deities of the Bardo silk covering, which he immediately placed over her. Then he placed the precious ZUNG DU lineage text above her head as he said prayers for her.

Honestly, this kind of incredible kindness brings a big lump to my throat; you would feel the same too if you know just how precious this is for my mother's soul consciousness. It is the best thing I can do for my mother. Khenpo's visit just blew us all away, made me feel that this is surely a Bodhisattva, someone so pure and genuinely kind, because he had taken the first available flight to come and be with me, with us. His prayers by her side are all the most vital Bardo prayers, which only he could do. Although later he told us what **Purifying prayers and** SUR practices we needed to do for her daily and weekly during the 49 days after her death. Because she had chosen a Monday to leave us, the big prayers every 7 days fall on a Sunday when everyone can come. It was all very auspicious...

We decided to keep the last rites and the funeral low key, so we informed only my closest friends and relatives. We also decided against an Obituary, because I could not think of any of her friends who were still alive... and in the end, it turned out for the best, as we had a very intimate group come for her Wake and my MAFIA join us at the Prayers, which Khenpo presided over. We did a beautiful SUR Fire Offering of food and five coloured cloth to ensure she did not go hungry or feel the cold in her journey through the Bardo, using the opportunity to also offer food to all the Spirits, Dakinis and other worldly beings my Mother's soul consciousness would encounter in her journey to the next life ...

Next day, we performed the last rights and Khenpo Delek flew back to Taiwan. He told us to save part of her ashes to be made into Tsa tsas (miniature Stupas) to take with us on our holy pilgrimages. This would represent the *offering of her body to the Buddhas* and doing this for her, for instance in Bodhgaya where Buddha attained Enlightenment, would be an amazing offering. When we picked her bones the day following the cremation, it was pristine white. We scattered some of it into the sea like for my father 20 years ago. ■

SACRED RELICS DRAW ME BACK TO LDC

Two nights in a row, I dreamt of the sacred relics of Buddhas and Buddhist Masters that were visiting Malaysia last month. The morning in between the dreams, I saw a press write-up about the Exhibition to be held at LOSANG DRAKPA BUDDHIST CENTER, a meditation society I used to visit and help out with previously. I read it as a sign to pay LDC a visit and to benefit from the sacred relics that were on show there for three days.

love the feeling of peace and bliss that engulfs me each time I am in the presence of the **Maitreya Tour** relics. I have seen many of these relics formerly, and I also possess some very precious relics that have made their way to my home altars. Lama Zopa has in the past given me (and my friends) personal viewings of his collection each time I visit him at Aptos, his home in the United States, so I feel a strong connection to these relics. Given a chance to view them again and also to benefit from them once more seemed too precious a chance to pass up.

I brought my daughter and grandson Josh with me and it was wonderful. I loved the energy of LDC all over again, and I have to congratulate those looking after the center for how beautifully they have maintained the place. It is so authentic and I am certain it benefits so many people who want to connect with Dharma. This is a place where anyone can get basic explanations. I always tell people that Buddha sets no conditions to helping others - there are no pre-conditions. Anyone can receive blessings. All that is needed is your own strong request for knowledge.

Visiting the relics Show at LDC, it was like I never left!

These relics are part of the Maitreya Loving Kindness Touring Exhibition that started in 2011 to showcase Lama Zopa Rinpoche's personal relic collection. Since then, the Exhibition has expanded considerably. The collection has grown substantially with additions from other Masters, including relics from other Buddhist Traditions. To date, the relics have visited over 66 countries in six continents, and at least two million people have been blessed from just laying eyes on them and thinking devotional thoughts when near them. Relics look like small crystals and tiny white pearls found amongst cremated bones of great Masters. Relics also emanate as tiny coloured chips of precious agates and other gemstones. Sometimes body parts like hair, teeth and bone fragments of ancient Buddhas and Bodhisattvas

retained from another time and place also make their way into the monasteries and private collections of great Practitioners and Masters. These types of relics are often found inside ancient Stupas or handed down from master to disciple over the centuries. A great many precious relics make up the collection that travels the world as part of the Maitreya Relic tour.

I was especially taken with the relics of the historical Buddha SHAKYAMUNI – these are just too awesome! This time around, I was also over the moon when I saw there were relics of some old Nyingma masters, including relics of **Dilgo Kyentse Rinpoche**, of **HH Penor Rinpoche** and even of **Longchengpa**, one time Abbot of Samye monastery. Most of all, I saw an old letter written by **Yeshe Tsogyal**, the dakini c onfidante most intimately connected to **Guru Rinpoche** and relics of Guru Rinpoche himself.

Î was genuinely glad I listened to my dreams and made the effort to reconnect once more, not just with the relics but also with the Center that played host to them, LDC.

I am truly overjoyed that the place is in good hands, with people



who revere Buddha so sincerely and who are benefiting so many with their devotion. This is a picture of the Tara altar I set up at LDC many years ago. It is even lovelier today after many years of devoted prayers. The main Tara was a gift from Rinpoche; there are several sets of 21 Taras. The backdrop art was by a Katmandu artist; the *tsa tsas* on the wall were from moulds made by the monks of Nalanda Monastery in France.

6AMAZING RENOVATION TIPS

The next time you venture into a renovation project, ask yourself what the purpose of the renovation is, and what you are trying to achieve from it. Set out some guidelines to determine key criteria, so that your project goal is always in focus and your budget not blown out of proportion. Here are six vital key areas to stay aware of before you commence on any project.

What is the PURPOSE of the renovation? Ask yourself before you start any renovation project what you are trying to achieve. Are you renovating in order to be able to rent out the property - which then assumes that the main goal is to maximize your profits? Or are you renovating a home you are currently living in, which could mean you would like to have minimal disruption to your daily life with a small renovation, or a full-blown fit-out exercise which will require you to move out during renovation works?

When renovating for the *purpose of rental*, you need to understand the ultimate goal behind the exercise. In this case, the goal is to maximize profits for as long as possible with minimal maintenance works needed. It is important to take note that regardless of what quality of finishand equipment you place in the home, everything will slowly degrade over time. The key is to introduce items that degrade the slowest, without a high-cost implication.

If renovating for *just for a facelift*, try to reduce the impact of works. Avoid works that involve demolition, internal wiring and plumbing, as these involve higher budgets and also more disruptive works.

If renovating *for one's self*, where the concept of "Anything Goes" comes to mind, you can entertain any number of ideas, but you always need to take a step back now and again to assess the other key criteria to ensure your project can stay on track.





02 What kind of BUDGET do you have?

Always set a budget regardless of what type of renovation you have in mind. If renovating for rental, work backwards by determining the medium and maximum rental rates you can get for the location. Remember that regardless of how much effort and beauty you place into a house, the market forces will ultimately prevail and determine the rental range. So avoid high expenses that may not have a significant impact on the rental, focusing instead on the things that are inexpensive but which gives you greater flexibility on what rental rate makes the exercise profitable.

Start with your material palette. Avoid expensive items such as marble and granite, which may offer an extensive visual appeal but would hamper you when matched against rental income. Look at alternatives such as marble effect ceramic tiles, which can still offer the "marble" look but at a fraction of the cost.

Next, think of the space. Every little bit of square footage can be additional income rate for you. Look at how best to extend the home without smashing the budget. Ideal areas to focus on would be public zones around the house, such as the living and dining rooms, including the dry kitchens. These are the key areas people focus upon when viewing a home for rent, and can sometimes be the decision maker in whether you secure the tenant or not.

Next, look at the landscape and introduce items such as a pond or water feature, and plenty of greenery. The one thing I realize is that the use of a swimming pool can sometimes be overstated. Realistically, we will never be able to build a swimming pool to satisfy our aquatic needs, but we can build a pool to suit our leisurely needs. For example, instead of building a lap pool, which then tends to be long and narrow and visually disjointed, consider the use of a plunge pool, where the pool is designed for people to cool down and congregate.

If you want to be more adventurous, introduce a jacuzzi system or even a mechanical jet for stationary swimming. And always remember to spend on the landscape, as there is no better attraction to a house than a garden that is lush and vibrant.

And finally, avoid the frills and <u>focus on the essentials</u>. Try to avoid unnecessary costs that have little or no impact on the rent, such as the selection of bathroom accessories to lights and cabinetry. Refrain from be exploited by your emotions and impulses, and remember the ultimate goal, which is to maximize profits.

On the other hand, if you are renovating for your own

personal needs, refrainment is thrown out the window. The mindset and criteria guidelines have all changed as it is then important to take note that what we put in we will have to live with. There are however different items to go through first when assigning a budget, as not everyone has a limitless budget. The first item to look into is the *structure* of the home. Always spend on things we never look at, as while these are things we would never see, it is the backbone in a long, everlasting, maintenance-free environment.

For example, ensure the wiring used for the lights and power points are all certified by the leading industry standards. This will prevent shorting later on, or burntout wires which would lead to escalating costs later on. Similarly, the type of pipes and internal connectors all have an adverse effect in the upkeep of the home. Avoid counterfeits and stick to the manufacturer's recommended fixtures, as a dollar saved today will be a hundredfold later on to rectify.

Once you have assigned a budget for your backbone, the remaining balance can then be used for the aesthetics of the house. And the selection of such items will be determined by personal appreciation and use. I would however always think of the shelf-life of your selection, and to remember that what looks nice today may change within a year or even sooner.

03 What is the Shelf-Life of the Various Components?

In a weird way, there is satisfaction is knowing that nothing lasts forever. Once you have accepted this, your expectation of what to buy is reduced, and you can then appreciate and use your things more. For example, do not assume that just because you don't use something that it would never get spoilt; in reality, the less we use an item, the more likely for it to deteriorate over time.

Consider cabinetry works - lack of maintenance would result in a high collection of dust and moisture in the cabinet, causing peeling, odour and discolouration. However, excessive use may cause accelerated wear and tear, so when building cabinetry, it is not only important to preserve the aesthetics but even more important to ensure the mechanisms are designed to ensure a long shelf-life.

Similarly, with the selection of finishes such as sanitary ware and fixtures, a good rule of thumb is to avoid coated items such as chrome, and instead, select stainless steel items. While stainless steel may have a higher initial cost, its maintenance and replacement costs will offer higher benefits in the long run. In addition, consider the brand name items, as not everything is built equally. Not only do branded items offer a wider range of aesthetic selection, their items have gone through more vigorous quality control checks, which would translate into a longer shelf-life.

Also, what should you select when it comes to the mechanical and electrical items of the home? From experience, I find that different products work well at different stages of their product development. Do your own research and ask around about what works well and what doesn't. But having said that, don't expect everything to work without a hitch, as more often than not, you may encounter a situation where the product fails soon after you purchase it. Always remember that in every product line, there will be a small percentage of defects, and sometimes it is luck of the draw if you receive such defects. It is thus important to research the market to select a brand that has the least number of defect cases.

Similarly with lights, should you go for the more expensive, longer-lasting LED's, or stick to conventional PLCE and halogens. While there is a substantial cost implication, which may create an impact on your assigned budget, it is important to understand how you will be using your lighting. People tend to think of lighting in the terms of luminance, but it is better to think of lighting in terms of moods.

While LEDs do offer large benefits in cost savings in terms of shelf-life and energy consumption, the light emitted tends to be 'hard'. For example, the shadows it creates are harder lines and when used to illuminate decorative items, the brilliance of the product is not the same as when using a halogen fixture. Therefore, I find a balance of lighting is essential, but maintaining the PLCE lighting to create a soft ambiance while replacing localized lighting such as wall-washers, tracks and spotlights with LEDs makes sense, as the cost benefits outweigh the benefits of halogen lights.



04 Which is More Important – Time or Cost?

The next criterion to keep in mind is the balance between time and cost. In a perfect world, we would like to have everything done quickly, on time and at a low costs; but in reality, to speed up works would require more resources and hence more costs. So before you begin a project, ask yourself what is more important to you. Would the time saved be spent on much better things or do we have ample time that we don't mind taking time to work on the house? Remember, the balance is a give and take, and should be a decision we maintain all the way to completion.

The worse scenario is to undertake a project with the intention of spending time and running around, only to falter during the midway point. Which by that time the project goes into a situation whereby no one wants to pick it up, and then it stalls, resulting in the project being placed in limbo.

In Project Management, there are only two factors that affect costs, and these are *resources* and *time*. The more quickly we make decisions, the more quickly works can be executed and the faster you can get your home. When there is indecisiveness, time delays can affect the budget adversely, as whether work is being done or not, salaries are still being paid.

Likewise, a lack of resources affects how quickly works are executed. The amount of resources being pumped into a project is determined by the owner's expectation on time and costs. So consideration of this criterion has major implications to how the project is run. On many occasions, a project is started off on the wrong foot with wrong timecost assumptions, resulting in delayed or stalled projects; and the main cause is usually misinterpreted expectations. So be realistic when assigning

05 How Do You Maximize Functionality?

During every phase of the renovation, you will have to go back to the drawing board, whether it is to review the design or to review the costs. What happens next is to dig deep into our bag of techniques on how to achieve our design goals without compromising too much on the aesthetics.

So in a renovation project, look at the key items that would have major cost implications, such as cabinetry works, lighting and soft furnishings. These are items that can be changed with little effect on the overall look, but can change how much you have to pay dramatically, depending on what materials are selected.

For example, when we design cabinets, there are two elements to it. The first is the internal portion (or the functionality element of the cabinet) and the second is the external (or aesthetic finish). Internally, we should not compromise on the mechanism and fixtures, as the cabinets are meant to stand up to daily usage and load impact. Similarly the external finish can be value-engineered based on the cost criteria between PU paints, AC paints and laminate finish, to achieve the budget requirements. The key is to prepare a design where no matter what material is used, it stands out. The focus is thus not on the material but on the overall visual concept.

Other items such as soft furnishings can also have a huge impact on the renovation budget, so keep in mind what is essential and what are frills.

Focus on essential items first. If for rental, consider if



the rental market requires a fully or semi-furnished unit, and identify your target market. More often than not, renters come with a container in tow and may not need your furnishings, which would then become unnecessary added costs, as storage for those items would be required. If for your own personal use, look at the type of furniture in the market, as sometimes it may be cheaper to customize your own furniture than to buy off the shelf.

Even for items such as curtains, weigh the difference between fully imported curtains versus readily available market products, as the cost implication can be substantial. Avoid limited edition items unless surplus quantities can be afforded, as replacement at a later stage may become an issue.

100 How Best to Anticipate for the Future?

And finally, renovate to suit your timeline. We have already highlighted that the most essential aspect of your renovation is to ensure the internal elements of the house are of the utmost quality. The next stage then is to build depending on what your expectations are for the future, and to ensure such works are non-disruptive to the household.

For example, when building for the sake of rental and then personal use, identify which areas you want to renovate first, and which areas would be renovated at a later date. Allow the facilities to be readily available such as wiring works, plumbing, sewerage and drainage. By doing so, any future expansion would be dependent on your needs, and any works would have minimal impact as the core costs have already been captured in the first renovation phase. Without proper planning, any future expansion may result in additional demolition and modification works, resulting in unnecessary costs and a disruptive environment.

Another thing to consider is how you may want to expand the home later, in line with the growth of the family. As we start out in life there are the parents and then young children. But as the family grows, the need for space does also. So the question is how to best expand the house to suit the needs of a growing family. Therefore the next time we start to renovate, think of what the main purpose of the renovation is, as different uses involve different design criteria. Always assign a budget and allow the project to work within the limits of the budget. Never assign a budget with an expectation of something higher, as there is no moment as depressing as the inability to achieve the expectations in your mind.

Keep a realistic approach and maintain a tight timeline with each set task. And finally, keep in view that the ultimate goal is to complete the project. When renovating, ensure to map out the path of what we want to achieve, what we need to achieve it, by when we want to achieve it, and our expectations.

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
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RENOVATING THE NORTHEAST IN 2015

I intend on having an extension to my house built in the Northeast sector in 2015. Does this break any renovation rules?

The renovation rules say to avoid digging or banging in the locations where the Grand Duke Jupiter, Three Killings and Five Yellow are located. In 2015 all three are in locations other than the NE sector; however, a word of caution is necessary here before you go ahead. In 2015 the Tai Sui (Grand Duke Jupiter) is located in SW1 (palace of the Sheep) which is directly opposite the NE. Thus the NE sector is said to be "confronting" the Grand Duke. Many feng shui masters feel very uneasy about allowing renovation in the sector facing the Grand Duke. So here, I suggest that before you begin, you must make strong offerings to the Tai Sui – place

food and incense in the SW corner and ask the Grand Duke for permission to renovate. Place the Piyao in the NE corner at all times while renovating. Display the 2015 Tai Sui Plaque in the SW corner before starting and carry the 2015 Tai Sui amulet at all times throughout the year.

DREAMING OF

I dreamt of a pool of black tadpoles in the water swimming. What does this mean?

Many tadpoles could mean fertility or impending wealth. You could be expecting a child soon or some windfall wealth or business opportunity coming to you. In both cases it is a good sign. You should display some three legged toads in your home to capture the auspiciousness of this dream.

HIT AND RUN ACCIDENT UNRESOLVED

We were involved in a hit-and-run accident 3 years ago but till today the authorities have been unable to track down the person who did it. It feels like our lawyer is stringing us along and for the past year we have not heard any updates from him. What do we do?

A Definitely not! Please do not reuse any feng shui items that are broken or chipped! A broken Wu Lou cannot protect you from illness so it's time to replace it with a new one. I have found that cures have a way of telling us that they need to be changed! Here's your Wu Lou sending you a big signal that it's time to get reinforcements as it can't cope with the illness energies of that sector!

STORING STUFF UNDER MY BED

I am looking to buy a new storage bedframe for my wedding bed to keep more stuff below my mattress. I was told that it is not advisable as it would symbolise "sleeping on top of unwanted problems". Is this true?

Normally this advice pertains to "junk" that is unwanted as you definitely do not want to sleep on top of "junk". It would be OK if what you are placing in inside are not junk. You can store winter clothes, pillows, bed sheets and blankets that's fine. But do not store any type of junk, shoes, old items that no longer have value, photographs, books or anything that is holy or sacred.

DAUGHTER'S PAHT CHEE SHOWS DANGER

I had my daughter's Paht Chee read by a master and he said that she will be facing danger till 2033! Her studies will be affected and I can already see signs of evil people destroying her school and future career. The master also mentioned that men will take advantage of her. She is a Dragon born in Dragon Hour. I thought Dragons were blessed but it seems her luck is nothing but doom. How can I protect her with feng shui cures? Please help!

My dear, please don't let someone worry you like this! If he can tell you these things he should also be able to give you remedies! Even if he is right, all Paht Chee charts can be balanced to minimise these setbacks. Usually when someone has this kind of negative luck, it means an excess of elements or a missing element. As I do not know her self-element, I can't advise you how to balance her chart. However, I can recommend some ways to keep her safe. Firstly, I recommend getting the HUM pendant for her to wear at all times – this will keep her safe from those with bad intentions. Secondly, I suggest inviting the Buddha Manjushri into her life and to chant Manjushri's mantra: OM AH RAPA CHANA DHI as many times as possible. This will help her focus on studies. If she cannot remember the entire mantra, then just chanting DHI DHI DHI DHI ... as many times as possible is also good.

THE BOAR HAS NOT IMPROVED THINGS WITH THE TIGER

Lillian's feng shui book advises me to place a boar in our bedroom to help resolve problems between me, a Metal Tiger Lady and my husband a Wood Rat. We are still arguing a lot... why is that?

Check whether you and your husband are sleeping in a room with the natal #3 flying star? The #3 brings hostility with others and if you are fighting a lot, then this could be the problem. If this is the case you need to change your bedroom colour scheme to RED unless it is in the NW or East this year. The Boar improves relations with the Tiger but it does not improve relations with the Rat. For that you need the Ox as well. So display the Ox and the Tiger in the NE of your bedroom and check if things improve. You should also display the animal that is your secret friend.

SAILING SHIPS HAVE GATHERED DUST

I've had 8 sailing ships near my entrance with incredible success but over the years it has gathered a lot of dust. Can I wash the ships? I don't want to wash the luck away! How do I clean the ships?

Yes you must keep the ships clean otherwise you will start to encounter obstacles that will deplete your wealth or stop the flow of your income! Start by removing all the items you have in the ship. Crystals can be washed and left in the sun to soak up sun vibes. Soak coins in metal cleaning solution to get rid of dirt. If yours is a wooden ship then wipe it down with a damp cloth. BAD OFFICE FENG SHUI



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


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
