





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Details of Gothic Architecture.

LORMAN.

PLATE.

1. BELL TURRET FROM BURNBY CHURCH, YORKSHIRE.

Situated on the west gable. The crosses have been restored in the plate.

2. WINDOW FROM DITTO DITTO.

Originally divided by a transom, which is now broken away, but indications of it remain on each side. The lower portion was probably fitted with a small door, through which offerings were put when presented to the altar. These are sometimes called "Lychnocopic," or "offertory" windows. It is situated on the south of the chancel, next the naves

- 3. DOORWAY FROM ETTON CHURCH, YORKSHIRE.
- 4. NAVE PIERS AND ARCHES, WALSOKEN CHURCH, NORFOLK.

It should be noticed that the octagonal piers are placed differently on the south side of the nave to what they are on the north. On the south side they stand angularly; on the north, square, in the usual manner.

An elegant gable cross from this church is given in the "Gothic Ornaments," Vol. II., Plate s.

8. DOORWAY, WIGGENHALL, ST. MARY THE VIRGIN, NORFOLK.

The three-quarter hollows of the arch mouldings indicate this to be a late example of the style. It, perhaps, should be called Early Decorated.

9. NAVE PIERS, AND ARCHES, AND CLERESTORY, WEST WALTON CHURCH, NORFOLK.

The painting shown upon the plate will be found given in detail in the "Gothic Ornaments," Vol. I., Plates 58, 62, 63; also foliage from the chancel, &c. Plates 59, 60, 61.

- 10. PLANS OF PIERS, ETC., FROM SAME.
- 11. MOULDINGS, DITTO.
- 12. DETAILS OF PIERS, DITTO.
- 13. EXTERIOR OF CLERESTORY FROM DITTO.

The lower portion of the clerestory is blocked up by the present aisle roof.

14. SOUTH PORCH, WEST WALTON CHURCH, NORFOLK.

In this plate the gable, the springing of which is remaining, has been restored, and the pinnacles terminated with finials. The form of the present gable, which is of brickwork, is indicated by the dotted lines.

15. PLAN AND DETAILS OF DITTO.

The south aisle has been at some time widened, when the porch appears to have been cut in half, the inner portion taken away, and the south door re-erected in the new wall. The north aisle of the church has been also widened, and the north door re-erected in the new wall.

- 16. SIDE ELEVATION AND SECTION OF DITTO.
- 17. DETAILS OF PINNACLES, ETC., FROM DITTO.

These are very irregular, scarcely two of the sides being of the same width, and the shafts are of different lengths ;—the total height, however, is the same.

- 18. SOUTH DOORWAY FROM WEST WALTON CHURCH, NORFOLK.

- 20. FOLIATED CAPITALS FROM DITTO.
- 21. WINDOW IN SOUTH AISLE, DITTO.
- 22. DETAILS OF SAME.

This window also was taken down and re-erected at the time the aisle was widened. The broad sunk chamfer, embracing the whole internally, is evidently later than the window itself, and the jointing does not range with the other work. Probably this was added at the time the aisle was widened. The alteration would thus appear to have taken place during the 14th century. One of the internal foliated capitals will be found given grds full size, in the "Gothic Ornaments," Vol. I., Plate 61.

23. WINDOW FROM BINHAM PRIORY, NORFOLK.

The transom received the groining of the aisle; the upper portion of the window lighted the triforium. The aisles are now in ruins.

- 24. DOOR FROM DITTO DITTO.
- 25. PIERS AND ARCHES FROM ROLVENDON CHURCH, KENT, AND WAWN CHURCH, YORKSHIRE.

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- NICHE IN NORTH AISLE OF CHANCEL, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY. Situate in an angle formed by an arch across the aisle. The main arch cuts into the upper part.
- 2. DOORWAY TO CHAPEL FROM DITTO. One of the label terminations consists of a hare dressed as a sportsman.
- 3. BUTTRESSES FROM COTTINGHAM CHURCH, YORKSHIRE, AND FRAMPTON CHURCH, LINCOLN-SHIRE.
- 4. PIERS AND ARCHES, NORTH SIDE OF CHANCEL, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY.
- 5. DETAILS OF DITTO DITTO DITTO.
 The arches are about 18 inches narrower at the east end of the chancel than at the west. The one represented is the second from the east. There is some variation also in the mouldings of each arch.
- WINDOW IN CHAPEL FROM ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY. This is an internal window, and at present is without glass.
- 7. SOUTH PORCH FROM BENNINGTON CHURCH, LINCOLNSHIRE. The gable appears to have been kept flat, and as close to the head of the arch as possible, so that the roof should come below the caves of that over the aisle.
- 8. EAST WINDOW OF NORTH AISLE OF CHANCEL, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY. One of the side windows is given in Sharpe's "Decorated Windows."
- 9. DETAILS OF SAME.

- 10. NICHE FROM CHANCEL, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY.
- LOWER PORTION AND PLAN OF SAME. The small pinnacles between the canopies are all broken away. They were probably connected with the parts behind by small flying buttresses.
- 12. FONT FROM BRADFIELD CHURCH, NORFOLK.
- 13. WINDOW IN CHANCEL, FROM FRAMPTON CHURCH, LINCOLNSHIRE.
- 14. EASTERN SIDE OF ALTAR SCREEN, BEVERLEY MINSTER.
- 15. TRACERY AND GROINING FROM DITTO.
- 16. DITTO AND DETAILS FROM DITTO.
- 17. БІТТО БІТТО.

One of the niches, several of the bosses, the buttresses, canopies, and ether portions are given, at large in the "Gothic Ornaments," Vol. II., Plates 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 43, 47.

- 18. ONE COMPARTMENT OF NAVE, AUSTREY CHURCH, WARWICKSHIRE.
- 19. CLERESTORY AND AISLE WINDOWS FROM DITTO.
- 20. BUTTRESSES FROM DITTO.
- 21. WINDOW FROM COTTINGHAM CHURCH, YORKSHIRE. The west window of this church is given by Sharpe, in his Work on "Decorated Windows."

33.	DOORWAY IN SOUTH PORCH, RYE CHURCH, SUSSEX. Although the external door is now blocked up, this appears to have been a porch, with vestry attached. The whole is vaulted with stone groining. It has lately been restored, and is about to be again used as a vestry.	
34.	WINDOWS FROM BERKSWELL CHURCH, WARWICKSHIRE. These are early in the style.	
35.	COUPLED WINDOWS FROM KENILWORTH CHURCH.	
36.	AISLE WINDOWS, WINCHELSEA, SUSSEX.	
37.	DETAILS OF DITTO DITTO. The arrangement of the inner arch with the small side arches is peculiar. A similar arrange- ment is carried out with the other windows of the church.	
38.	CROSSES AND PIERCED PARAPET FROM DITTO.	
	The precise contour of the cornice below the parapet could not be conveniently ascertained being so completely covered up with ivy.

6. NAVE PIERS AND ARCHES, ST. MARY'S CHURCH, BEVERLEY.

The three label terminations on the north side, west end of nave, hold the following inscription :-

"CROELAD AAD DDS MDIfe MADE

THES TO UNITORS AND ADALLIE."

Those on the side next the aisle run thus :--

"ORATE PRO ARIMABUE FORE: CROSLAD MERCATORE: ET FORADE FXORE: EFFE."

7. CLERESTORY WINDOWS FROM DITTO.

8. ONE COMPARTMENT OF NAVE, AND LABEL TERMINATIONS FROM DITTO.

- 9. PULPIT FROM WESTMINSTER ABBEY.
- 10. CHIMNEY SHAFT FROM SOUTHWELL MINSTER, NOTTS.
- 11. SEATING FROM WIGGENHALL, ST. GERMAN'S, NORFOLK.
- 12. DITTO DITTO.

In the nave the bench ends have niches containing the Apostles, and above these arc figures, which appear to represent the seven deadly sins; those remaining are adultery, drunkenness, avarice, murder, and suicide the one represented). They are all sitting in the jaws of monsters from the mouths of which issue flames. On the opposite side Angels stand pointing towards them. The bench ends in the aisles are plainer, with figures carved upon them —as mermaid, lion, cock-atrice, sitting men, carpenter with nails, &c.

- 13. SEATING, NORTH SIDE OF NAVE, WIGGENHALL, ST. MARY THE VIRGIN, NORFOLK.
- 14. DITTO DITTO.

This seating remains as anciently arranged; on the north side of the nave for men, the south for women. The men's seating is raised considerably above the paving of the aisles, and the bench ends large and massive. The seating for women is kept lower than that for the men, and the beach ends smaller and plainer. In the nave each has a figure of the Blessed Virgin in a niche, with the letters F.B. carved above, which are also occasionally introduced in the open backs. In the aisles the bench ends are without niches. Views of this church are given in Brandon's "Parish Churches."
