

THE FIRE STONE .

Living Mercury of Antimony, Red Oil of Vitriol made of Iron, Spirit of Salt and Antimony.

Mercury is in the Regulus; Sulphur is in the Red Colour; Salt is in the Black Earth.

To separate these and join them again and fix them is to Prepare the Stone of Fire.

The Basic Work is the extraction of a tincture from the minera of Antimony BEFORE making glass.

Stone of Fire will tinge 5 parts of Silver, Tin or Lead.

Fixed powders that tinge are Stones.

1st. is Stone of Philosophers.

2nd. Stone (Tincture) of Gold and Silver.

3rd. Tincture of Vitriol.

4th. Tincture of Mars.

5th. Tincture of Jupiter and Saturn.

6th. Tincture of Mercury.

Venus and Mars contain tincture of Gold in themselves when reduced to fixation. Jupiter and Saturn is for the Coagulation of Mercury.

Virtues of All Things, Mineral, Animal and Vegetables are in Stone of Philosophers.

The Oil of Antimony used for the Stone is sweet and casts beams like a ruby in sunlight.

THE STONE.

Make the Sulphur of Antimony; purify & etc. The Sweet Oil.

Mix iiij Salt of Antimony w/ l6 ij extracted oil. (2 lbs. of oil, w/ 4 oz. of Salt).

Circulate one Month-well closed- separate MERCURY in B.M. then distill off pelucid red oil from feces. (many coloured).

Rectify in B/M until $\frac{1}{4}$ can be distilled.

Take result of Running Mercury Process. Take equal parts of this Crystalline substance and the pellucid oil.

It is the oil of the iron Process, the precipitate from Mercury of Antimony Process.

Of Antimony from earlier process, Seal in phial and they will join and become fixed to each other. (Gentle Heat). The phlegm will be consumed and what remains will become Red, dry, fixed and fluid and will give no smoke or fumes. (A Powder). This will take many months.

They will become an Hermaphroditic body.

THE REGULUS THE SON.

2 or 3 grains in white wine, expells evil. The Spirit from the Salt Process is used here as well. (with Red Oil).

This Regulus is the Regulus which contains the Mercury of Antimony mentioned previously. I believe!
