


INTRODUCTION

PRAYERS THAT ROUT DEMONS COMBINES PRAYER AND confession of the Word of God to bring breakthrough against any demonic opposition. Prayer and confession of the Word are two of the most powerful weapons believers have. You will see a great release of God's power when these two are combined.

I began writing these prayers as I studied the Word of God. The Holy Spirit illuminated many scriptures to me that needed to be released through prayer. I began to see clearly the plan of God for believers and how the enemy wanted to stop that plan. The Lord taught me the importance of praying the Word to overcome spiritual resistance to the plan of God for my life.

These prayers have been forged over a period of many years. They have been birthed out of warfare and deliverance. They have come from years of experience in ministering to individuals and nations. The Holy Spirit has helped me understand many scriptures and how to use them in prayer.

Most of the prayers in this book will have scriptural references. We base our prayers on the Word of God. The Word of God will inspire you to pray. The promises of God will motivate you to pray. God has given us many great and precious promises. It is through faith and promises we inherit the promises (Heb. 6:12).

There are many believers who struggle with prayer. Many say they don't know how to pray. Some have become discouraged in prayer. This book will help you learn how to pray with revelation and authority. These prayers are designed to see results. We have received many testimonies of people coming

to another level in their prayer lives by using these prayers. They are written to be simple, yet powerful.

There are many different kinds of prayers in this book. We are told to pray with all kinds of prayers (Eph. 6:8). These prayers will expand your ability to pray. You will pray many different kinds of prayers that you ordinarily would not have prayed. This will help to break the limitations off of your prayer life.

Prayer is one of the ways we release the will of God upon the earth. We must study the Word of God in order to know the will of God. This is why prayer and the Word must be combined. Daniel was able to pray effectively because he knew the Word of God concerning His people (Dan. 9:2–3).

We should pray with understanding (1 Cor. 14:15). Understanding the will of God will help us pray correctly. The Word of God is the will of God. We are not to be unwise, but understanding of what the will of the Lord is (Eph. 5:17). Prayer also helps us walk perfectly and completely in all the will of God (Col. 4:12).

Life and death are in the power of the tongue (Prov. 18:21). Right words are forcible (Job 6:25). The words we speak are spirit and life (John 6:63). We can be snared by the words of our mouth. We need to articulate the thoughts of God by praying and confessing His Word (Isa. 55:8). God's Word released through our tongue will cause His power to manifest in our lives.

Words are used to convey our thoughts. The words of God are the thoughts of God. We are releasing the mind of God when we pray and confess His Word. The thoughts of God are peace and prosperity (Jer. 29:11). They are designed to bring us to an expected end.

Jesus taught us that our faith is released through our words (Mark 11:23). Our faith-filled words can move mountains. There

is nothing impossible to those who believe. Our faith is a key to seeing miracles and breakthrough on a consistent basis. Whatever we ask in prayer, believing, we will receive (Matt. 21:22).

The Word is near us (Rom. 10:8). The Word is in our mouth and heart. This is the Word of faith. The mouth and the heart are connected. We speak from the abundance of the heart. The Word of God in our heart will come through our mouth. Faith in the heart will be released through our mouth. God watches over His Word to perform it (Jer. 1:12).

We are encouraged to call upon the Lord. He has promised to show us great and mighty things (Jer. 33:3). The Lord delights in our prayers. He delights in answering our prayers. Before we call, He will answer (Isa. 65:24). The Lord's ears are open unto the prayers of the righteous (1 Pet. 3:12). The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much (James 5:16). We are told to pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17).

Our God hears prayer. All flesh should come to Him in prayer (Ps. 65:2). This book is designed for believers in any nation. All believers have similar challenges. All believers must overcome these challenges. God is no respecter of persons. He is near to all who call upon Him (Ps. 145:19). The Lord will hear your supplication and will receive your prayer (Ps. 6:9).

Calling upon the Lord will bring salvation and deliverance from your enemies (Ps. 18:3). This has always been a key to deliverance. You can pray yourself out of any adverse situation. The Lord is your helper. God will not turn away your prayer (Ps. 66:20). God will not despise your prayer (Ps. 102:17). The prayer of the upright is God's delight (Prov. 15:8).

We have been given the keys of the kingdom (Matt. 16:19). This gives us the authority to bind and loose. To bind means to restrict, stop, hinder, fetter, check, hold back, arrest, or put a stop to. To loose means to untie, unbind, unlock, liberate,

release, forgive, or free. Keys represent the authority to lock (bind) or unlock (loose). Prayer and confession are two of the ways we use this authority. We can bind the works of darkness, which include: sickness, disease, hurt, witchcraft, poverty, death, destruction, confusion, defeat, and discouragement. We can loose ourselves and others from the works of darkness. This will result in greater liberty and prosperity.

Binding and loosing will help us in the area of deliverance. We can loose ourselves from many things by using our authority. We can loose others by praying these prayers. Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil. He came that we might have life in abundance.

Believers must know and operate in authority. Jesus gave His disciples power and authority over all devils (Matt. 10:1). We are seated with Christ in heavenly places far above all principality and power (Eph. 1:20; 2:6). Believers can use this authority through prayer and confession. We have authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions (Luke 10:19). Jesus promised that nothing would hurt us. Many believers suffer unnecessarily because they fail to exercise their authority.

These prayers are for believers who have a hatred for the works of darkness (Ps. 139:21). Do you hate every false way (Ps. 119:104)? Do you want to see changes in your city, region, and nation? You are a king, and you have the power to change geographic regions (Eccles. 8:4). The fear of the Lord is to hate evil (Prov. 8:13).

The prayers in this book are designed to demolish strongholds. God's Word is like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces (Jer. 23:29). We need powerful prayers to demolish these strongholds. These prayers are for those who want to see breakthroughs in their personal lives as well as in their cities, regions, and nations. There have been many prayer books written over the years, but I believe this prayer book is unique in its simplicity and revelation.

Satan has been defeated through the cross. Principalities and powers have been spoiled (Col. 2:15). We are enforcing this victory through our prayers. We are executing the judgments written. This honor is given to all His saints. The saints have possessed the kingdom (Dan. 7:18). This means we have authority with the King to advance the reign of Christ over the nations.

David was a king who understood the place of prayer in victory. He had many victories over his enemies. He saw mighty deliverance through prayer. He prayed for the defeat of his enemies and God answered him. We will have the same results over our spiritual enemies. We are not wrestling against flesh and blood. We must overcome principalities and powers with the armor of God. We must take the sword of the Spirit and pray with all prayer (Eph. 6:12-18).

The prayers of David ended with Psalm 72:20. He ended them by praying that the whole earth would be filled with God's glory. This is the end of prayer. We believe that the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Hab. 2:14). This is our goal. We will continue to pray toward the fulfillment of this promise. We will see the growth of God's kingdom and the destruction of the powers of darkness through our prayers. Revival and glory are increasing. Our prayers are like gasoline to the fire.

SECTION 1

PŁUGGING IN+O +he POWER SOURCE

Our source of power is the Holy Spirit and the Word of God. We build ourselves up in faith when we confess the Word of God. We experience greater confidence when we understand the Word and walk in revelation. Prayer plugs us into the power source. Prayer connects us to God and allows His power to flow to us in any situation.

Salvation is the basis for warfare. The new birth is a necessity. A believer also needs the infilling of the Holy Spirit. Are you born again? Do you know beyond a doubt that you are saved? Believers must live holy lives that are submitted to the Holy Spirit. We are commanded to walk in the Spirit. This will assure us of continual victory and breakthroughs for others. We can revenge disobedience when our obedience is fulfilled. Jesus cast out devils through the power of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 12:28). The Holy Spirit was the source of His power and wisdom.

This section of prayers that teach us how to plug into the power source—God's Holy Spirit and God's Word—is not for religious people. These are not religious prayers that begin to work when someone recites them. These prayers are for born-again believers who desire to see the growth of the kingdom of God.

We are told to be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10). We walk and war in His strength. This requires humility and total dependence upon God. We are not confident in our own strength. We cannot allow pride to open the door for destruction.

The Lord is a man of war (Exod. 15:3). He will fight our battles. We depend upon His power and direction. We depend upon His Word and His Spirit. I cannot overemphasize the need for humility. God gives grace to the humble.

The Lord is the strength of my life. This gives me the ability to overcome all fear. I will put my trust in Him. This was the key to David's victories. David was a king who knew how to depend upon the Lord. David won many battles and overcame all of his enemies.

The Lord taught David how to war (Ps. 144:1). He will also teach you how to war. You must depend on Him. The prayers and strategies in this book were learned from years of warring and trusting in God. God taught us how to war using His Word. The Holy Spirit opened our eyes to great truths, and we are still learning.

God was David's power source. He confessed that the Lord was his strength. David was a man of prayer and worship. He enjoyed the Lord's presence. The Lord's presence was David's source of joy and strength. His songs were powerful prophetic weapons against the enemy. There is no substitute for a life of praise and worship. Every believer needs to belong to a church that is strong in praise and worship.

There are many great warriors being trained in the school of the Holy Spirit. They are humble people who had to depend upon God for breakthrough. They had to connect with the Lord, who is the greatest warrior. They learned through experience and sometimes through failure. Like these great warriors for God, if we call upon the Lord, He will show us great and mighty things.

The Word of God is the sword of the Spirit. A sword is used

in war. The Lord will teach you how to use this sword. You will use it against the spiritual enemies of your soul. You will see great victories as you use it correctly. Most of the prayers in this book have a scriptural reference. I would encourage you to look at the verses and meditate on them. The Word of God is our source of wisdom. We operate in God's wisdom to defeat the powers of hell.

Confessing the Word of God is an important part of every believer's spiritual life. Christianity is called *the great confession*. Salvation comes from confessing with the mouth. The mouth is connected to the heart. The Word of God released from your mouth will be planted in your heart. Faith is released from the mouth. The mouth can only release what is in the heart. Faith in the heart that is released through the mouth can move mountains.

God is the source of all our victories and breakthrough. He is the source of our wisdom and strategies. His Word is the source for our understanding of the warfare in which we are involved. Our warfare originates in the heavens. We bind what is already bound in the heavens. We loose what is already loosed in the heavens.

God has illuminated many scriptures to us over the years of being involved in deliverance and warfare. These scriptures have been invaluable in helping us experience breakthrough. The Word of God is a treasure chest of wisdom and knowledge. It contains an abundance of revelation for every believer. Every believer who desires to enjoy liberty and victory must take time to study the Word of God and ask for revelation.

One of my favorite group of prayers in this section are those called "Prayers for Revelation." When I began to pray these prayers, the results were dramatic. I began to see truths in the Word of God that I had never seen. Revelation is the

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key to authority. Peter received the keys of the kingdom after he received the revelation that Jesus was Christ (Matt. 16:16).

God has promised to make us joyful in the house of prayer (Isa. 56:7). God's house is called a *house of prayer* for all nations. I believe we should not only pray but also enjoy prayer. The joy of the Lord is our strength. Prayer should yield an abundance of miracles and rewards. Those who enjoy the results of prayer will enjoy an exciting life.

I stand in the evil day having my loins girded about with truth, and I have the breastplate of righteousness. My feet are shod with the gospel of peace. I take the shield of faith. I am covered with the helmet of salvation, and I use the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God (Eph. 6:14–17).

I am delivered from the power of darkness and translated into the kingdom of God's dear Son (Col. 1:13).

I tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt me (Luke 10:19).

I do not have the spirit of fear but power, love, and a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7).

I am blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ Jesus (Eph. 1:3).

I am healed by the stripes of Jesus (Isa. 53:5).

My hand is upon the neck of my enemies (Gen. 49:8).

You anoint my head with oil; my cup runs over. Goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life (Ps. 23:5–6).

I am anointed to preach, to teach, to heal, and to cast out devils.

I receive abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness, and I reign in life through Christ Jesus (Rom. 5:17).

I have life and that more abundantly (John 10:10).

I walk in the light as He is in the light, and the blood of Jesus cleanses me from all sin (1 John 1:7).

I am the righteousness of God in Christ (2 Cor. 5:21).

I am the head and not the tail (Deut. 28:13).

I shall decree a thing, and it shall be established in my life (Job 22:28).

I have favor with God and with man (Luke 2:52).

Wealth and riches are in my house, and my righteousness endures forever (Ps. 112:3).

I will be satisfied with long life, and God will show me His salvation (Ps. 91:16).

I dwell in the secret place of the Most High, and I abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1).

No evil will befall me, and no plague shall come near my dwelling (Ps. 91:10).

My children are taught of the Lord, and great is their peace (Isa. 54:13).

I am strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man (Eph. 3:16).

I am rooted and grounded in love (Eph. 3:17).

I bless my natural enemies, and I overcome evil with good (Matt. 5:44).

Give me revelation, and let me be blessed (Matt. 16:17).

I am the seed of Abraham through Jesus Christ, and I receive the blessing of Abraham. Lord, in blessing, bless me, and in multiplying, multiply me as the stars of heaven and as the sand of the seashore.

Let Your showers of blessing be upon my life (Ezek. 34:26).

Turn every curse sent my way into a blessing (Neh. 13:2).

Let Your blessing make me rich (Prov. 10:22).

Let all nations call me blessed (Mal. 3:12).

Let all generations call me blessed (Luke 1:48).

I am a son of the blessed (Mark 14:61).

I live in the kingdom of the blessed (Mark 11:10).

My sins are forgiven, and I am blessed (Rom. 4:7).

Lord, You daily load me with benefits (Ps. 68:19).

I bind and rebuke any ungodly forces operating against me through Arcturus, Pleiades, Mazzaroth, and Orion (Job 38:31–32).

I bind and rebuke all moon deities and demons operating through the moon in the name of Jesus (2 Kings 23:5).

I bind all sun deities and demons operating through the sun in the name of Jesus (2 Kings 23:5).

I bind all deities and demons operating through the stars and planets in the name of Jesus (2 Kings 23:5).

The sun shall not smite me by day nor the moon by night (Ps. 121:6).

The heavens were created to be a blessing to my life.

I receive the rain and blessing from heaven upon my life in the name of Jesus.

I pray for angels to be released to war against any spirit in the heavens assigned to block my prayers from being answered (Dan. 10:12–13).

I bind the prince of the power of the air in the name of Jesus (Eph. 2:2).

I pray for the floodgates of heaven to be opened over my life (Mal. 3:10).

I pray for an open heaven, and I bind any demonic interference from the heavens in the name of Jesus.

Let the evil powers of heaven be shaken in the name of Jesus (Matt. 24:29).

Let the heavens drop dew upon my life (Deut. 33:28).

Bow the heavens and come down, O Lord (Ps. 144:5).

Let the heavens be opened over my life, and let me see visions (Ezek. 1:1).

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Shake the heavens and fill my house with Your glory (Hag. 2:6-7).

Thunder in the heavens against the enemy, O Lord (Ps. 18:13).

Let the heavens drop at the presence of God (Ps. 68:8).

Let the heavens praise Thy wonders, O Lord (Ps. 89:5).

Show Your wonders in the heavens (Joel 2:30).

Ride upon the heavens and release Your voice, O Lord (Ps. 68:33).

Release Your manifold wisdom to the powers in the heavens (Eph. 3:10).

My mouth is enlarged over my enemies (1 Sam. 2:1).

Enlarge my steps so I can receive Your wealth and prosperity (Isa. 60:5–9).

I receive deliverance and enlargement for my life (Esther 4:14).

The Lord shall increase me more and more, me and my children (Ps. 115:14).

Let Your kingdom and government increase in my life (Isa. 9:7). Let me increase in the knowledge of God (Col. 2:19). O Lord, bless me and increase me (Isa. 51:2).

Let me increase exceedingly (Gen. 30:43).

Let me increase with the increase of God (Col. 2:19).

I renounce all false beliefs and philosophies inherited by my ancestors in the name of Jesus.

I break all curses on my finances from any ancestors that cheated or mishandled money in the name of Jesus.

I break all curses of sickness and disease and command all inherited sickness to leave my body in the name of Jesus.

Through Jesus, my family is blessed (Gen. 12:3).

I renounce all pride inherited from my ancestors in the name of Jesus.

I break all oaths, vows, and pacts made with the devil by my ancestors in the name of Jesus.

I break all curses by agents of Satan spoken against my life in secret in the name of Jesus (Ps. 10:7).

I break all written curses that would affect my life in the name of Jesus (2 Chron. 34:24).

I break every time-released curse that would activate in my life as I grow older in the name of Jesus.

I break every curse Balaam hired against my life in the name of Jesus (Neh. 13:2).

Lord, turn every curse spoken against my life into a blessing (Neh. 13:2).

I break all generational rebellion that would cause me to resist the Holy Spirit (Acts 7:51).

I break all curses of death spoken by people in authority in my nation over my nation in the name of Jesus.

I break curses of death spoken against America by people from other nations in the name of Jesus.

DISANNULLING UNGODLY COVENANTS

I break and disannul all ungodly covenants, oaths, and pledges I have made with my lips in the name of Jesus.

SECTION 2

PREPARING +0 ENGAGE +he ENEMY

WHAT MAKES A PERSON SUCCESSFUL IN SPIRITUAL warfare? Some of the qualifications include:

- Endurance (2 Tim. 2:3)—the ability to endure and withstand hardship, adversity, or stress. We are to endure hardness as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.
- *Hatred* (Ps. 139:22)—extreme dislike or antipathy, loathing. In spiritual warfare, we must have a hatred of evil and evil spirits.
- *Knowledge* (2 Cor. 2:11)—we are not to be ignorant of Satan's devices.
- *Persistence* (Ps. 18:37)—the ability to go on resolutely or stubbornly in spite of oppression. We must be persistent in dealing with the enemy.
- Separation (2 Tim. 2:14)—to get or keep apart. No man who wars entangles himself with the affairs of this life

God uses ordinary people to accomplish His purposes. Our ability comes through grace. Every believer is sitting in heavenly places in Christ. Your position in Christ is high above all principality and power. You must see who you are *in Christ*. You can do all things through Christ.

It is important to know your authority and engage the enemy in faith. There is no need to fear. Demons are subject to the authority of the believer. Jesus gives us power to tread on serpents and scorpions (Luke 10:19). He promised that nothing will by any means harm us.

Joshua was told to engage the enemy (Deut. 2:24). You will see great victories through engagement. To *engage* means to bring troops into conflict. There are some believers who fear engagement. They are afraid of backlash. Jesus sent His disciples out to engage the enemy. They were told to heal the sick and cast out devils.

Two important revelations every believer needs are an understanding of *power* and an understanding of *authority*. *Power* is the Greek word *dunamis*. Authority is the Greek word *exousia*. Authority is the legal right to use power. We have been given authority to use the power supplied by the Holy Spirit.

Authority and power must be used. You use them by faith. This is not based on feeling but on faith. It is based on the Word of God. Faith comes by hearing the Word of God. It is important for believers to attend churches that teach on power and authority. It is important to read and study on these subjects. Revelation in these areas will give confidence to pray these prayers.

We have been given the legal right to use the name of Jesus. The name of Jesus is above every name. Authority in the name of Jesus is recognized by the spirit realm. We cast out demons in that name. We bind the works of darkness in that name. We teach and preach in that name.

We receive power through the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8). God is able to do exceeding abundantly according to the power that operates in us. Jesus cast out demons through the power of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 12:28). We combine the power of the Holy Spirit with the authority of the name of Jesus to rout the enemy. We do not engage the enemy in our own power and authority. We engage the enemy through the power of the Holy Spirit and in the authority of the name of Jesus.

Demons recognize power and authority. They recognize believers who operate in power and authority. The more you exercise power and authority, the more you will develop in these areas. It is important to start. The prayers in this book will help you get started.

It is also important to make sure your sins are forgiven when engaging the enemy. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). Do not engage the enemy with unconfessed sin in your life. There is power in the blood of Jesus. His blood cleanses us from all sin. Give no place to the devil. You must operate in righteousness.

We are made righteous through faith. We are the righteousness of God in Christ (2 Cor. 5:21). Many believers suffer from feelings of inferiority and low self-esteem because they do not understand righteousness. Righteousness gives us confidence. Righteousness gives us boldness. Righteousness is the scepter of the kingdom (Heb. 1:8). The righteous are as bold as a lion (Prov. 28:1).

God covers our heads in the day of battle (Ps. 140:7). A covering is protection. Covering is based on subjection to God, His Word, and the Holy Spirit. Humility and submission are important characteristics of believers who engage in spiritual warfare. These prayers are not for people who are rebellious. It is important to be submitted to proper biblical authority. This includes being submitted to godly leaders who watch for your soul.

I cover myself, my family, and my possessions with the blood of Jesus.

Let the fire of God surround and protect my life from all destruction.

SECTION 3

CONFRONTING +he ENEMY'S TACTICS

We can overcome all the schemes of the devil. The devil is a schemer. A *scheme* is a plan, design, or program of action. The Bible talks about the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11). A *wile* is a trick or a trap. A *trap* is a snare.

Warfare involves tactics and strategies. The greatest generals are great tacticians and strategists. You cannot win without a strategy. Don't allow the enemy to strategize against you. Overcome and destroy his strategies through prayer.

Traps and snares are hidden. People fall into traps unknowingly. We are delivered from the snare of the fowler. A *fowler* is a hunter. Satan is the hunter of souls. We can release ourselves and others through prayer.

The main tactic of the enemy is deception. He is a liar and the father of lies. The Word of God exposes the tactics of the enemy. God is light, and His Word is light. The light exposes the enemy and tears away the darkness.

Multitudes of people are deceived by the enemy. There are hosts of lying and deceiving spirits that work under the authority of Satan. These spirits include delusion, deception, lying, seducing, blinding, error, and guile. Our praying can strip the power of these deceiving spirits and cause the eyes of people to be opened.

David prayed against the enemy conspiracies of the wicked. The Psalms are filled with references to the plans of his enemies to overthrow him. His prayers were the key in destroying these plans and bringing him deliverance. David prayed for his enemies to be scattered, confused, exposed, and destroyed.

David's struggles were with natural enemies. Behind these natural enemies were spiritual ones that were opposed to the Davidic kingdom. Jesus was to come from this line and sit upon this throne. David was fighting something beyond the natural. Through the Holy Spirit he was contending with the powers of darkness that were set against the arrival of the kingdom of God.

These powers were also manifested through Herod, who attempted to kill the coming Messiah. Herod was driven by spirits of fear and murder. He was used by Satan to attempt to abort the coming kingdom. However, the Holy Spirit had already been loosed through the prayers of David, and David's throne was secure.

Many of these warfare prayers are taken from the psalms of David. Jesus is the Son of David. He sits on the throne of David. David's prophetic prayers were weapons against the enemy's attempt to stop the promised seed. David's victories in prayer opened the way for his throne to continue. The throne of wickedness was unable to overcome the throne of righteousness.

God taught David. He became the warrior king. His victories caused his kingdom to be established. His victory over the house of Saul came after a long war (2 Sam. 3:1). Don't become discouraged in prayer. Continue to pray. You will become stronger, and the enemy will become weaker.

David consumed his enemies (Ps. 18:37–40). He did not turn until they were destroyed. We must see our spiritual enemies completely destroyed. We must pursue the enemy. To pursue means to follow in order to overtake or capture. It means to chase with hostile intent. We cannot be passive when it comes to warfare.

David's victories prepared the way for Solomon. Solomon enjoyed peace and prosperity. Solomon's name means "peace." Peace is the Hebrew word shalom. Shalom means "peace, prosperity, favor, health, and well-being." Your victories over the enemy will release shalom. You will experience greater levels of peace and prosperity.

QUENCHING THE FIRE OF THE ENEMY

I quench with the shield of faith every fiery dart the enemy sends my way (Eph. 6:16).

I quench every fiery dart of jealousy, envy, anger, bitterness, and rage sent against my life in the name of Jesus.

I quench every firebrand sent against my life by the enemy in the name of Jesus (Isa. 7:4).

I bind and rebuke all spirits of jealousy directed against my life in the name of Jesus.

I quench every fire the enemy would throw into my sanctuary in the name of Jesus (Ps. 74:7).

I bind and cast out every fiery serpent sent against my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 30:6).

I quench every burning lamp that comes from the leviathan's mouth (Job 41:19).

I will not be burned by the fire of the enemy (Isa. 43:2).

SECTION 4

DESTROYING +he ENEMY'S FORCES

ESUS CAME TO DESTROY THE WORKS OF THE DEVIL (1 John 3:8). The works of the devil are carried out by his forces. Satan's kingdom consists of principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness of this world, and spiritual wickedness in high places. There are different kinds of demons and different levels of wickedness. We can destroy the wicked early (Ps. 101:8). We can destroy them that hate us (Ps. 18:40).

Satan is rendered helpless when his forces are destroyed. We have authority to bind the strongman and strip him of his armor. Israel was sent into Canaan to destroy different nations, which are pictures of kingdoms that possessed the land. Each kingdom represented a different type of stronghold God wanted His people to destroy.

Demons are also represented by different creatures. The diversity in the animal kingdom is a picture of the diversity in the kingdom of darkness. The Bible talks about serpents, scorpions, lions, jackals, bulls, foxes, owls, sea serpents, flies, and dogs. These represent different kinds of evil spirits that operate to destroy mankind. They are invisible to the natural eye. They are just as real, however, as natural creatures.

We must always remember that there are more with us than against us. The forces of light are far superior to the forces of darkness. Jesus is the Lord of the armies. The armies of heaven are fighting with the armies of earth. Releasing the angelic armies of heaven is an important strategy in warfare.

We can destroy and rout the forces of darkness in the heavens, the earth, the sea, and under the earth. These forces can operate through people, governments, economic systems, educational systems, and different structures set up by men. These forces can operate from different locations and in different territories.

The idols that men worship are made in the image of men, four-footed beasts, birds, and creeping things. Behind these idols are demons. These are evil spirits that manifest in the natural through idols. These gods (idols) were also male and female. The nations worshiped gods and goddesses. Jezebel is an example of a female principality.

The Bible uses strong words that pertain to warfare including:

I command Jezebel to be thrown down and eaten by the hounds of heaven.

I rebuke all spirits of false teaching, false prophecy, idolatry, and perversion connected with Jezebel (Rev. 2:20).

I loose tribulation against the kingdom of Jezebel (Rev. 2:22).

I cut off the assignment of Jezebel against the ministers of God (1 Kings 19:2).

I cut off and break the powers of every word released by Jezebel against my life.

I cut off Jezebel's table and reject all food from it (1 Kings 18:19).

I cut off and loose myself from all curses of Jezebel and spirits of Jezebel operating in my bloodline.

I cut off the assignment of Jezebel and her daughters to corrupt the church.

I rebuke and cut off the spirit of Athaliah that attempts to destroy the royal seed (2 Kings 11:1).

I come against the spirit of Herodias and cut off the assignment to kill the prophets (Mark 6:22–24).

I rebuke and cut off the spirit of whoredoms (Hos. 4:12).

I rebuke and cut off Jezebel and her witchcrafts in the name of Jesus (2 Kings 9:22).

I rebuke and cut off the harlot and mistress of witchcrafts and break her power over my life and family (Nah. 3:4).

I cut off witchcrafts out of the hands (Mic. 5:12).

I overcome Jezebel and receive power over the nations (Rev. 2:26).

DEALING WITH SPIRITS OF THE DESERT

I speak to every desert in my life or ministry in the name of Jesus.

I bind and cast out any desert spirit sent against my life.

I bind and cast out every spirit of the desert owl, the desert fox, the desert dragon, the desert hyena, and the desert vulture in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:11–15).

I bind and cast out every scorpion spirit of fear and torment in the name of Jesus (Deut. 8:15).

I bind and rebuke the screech owl in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:14).

I bind and cast out every jackal in the name of Jesus (Ezek. 13:15).

I will not dwell in the wilderness but in a fruitful land (Isa. 35:1).

My desert shall blossom as a rose and bring forth abundant fruit (Isa. 35:1).

Release water in my dry places and streams in the desert (Isa. 35:6). Let rivers flow into my desert places (Isa. 43:20). I rebuke the beasts of the desert, every doleful creature, every satyr, and every dragon from operating in my life (Isa. 13:21–22).

Let your voice shake every wilderness place in my life (Ps. 29:8).

Let fatness drop upon my wilderness places (Ps. 65:11–12).

Let the spirits of the wilderness bow and lick the dust (Ps. 72:9).

I rebuke every pelican and owl of the wilderness (Ps. 102:6).

Turn the wilderness into a pool of water and the dry ground into water springs (Ps. 107:35).

Open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys, and make my wilderness places a pool of water and my dry places springs of water (Isa. 41:18).

Plant in my wilderness places the cedar, the shittah tree, the myrtle tree, the oil tree, the fir tree, the pine tree, and the box tree together (Isa. 41:19).

I renounce all rebellion that would open my life to desert spirits (Ps. 68:6).

I break every curse of trusting in man that would open my life to desert spirits (Jer. 17:5–6).

I prophesy to every dry bone in my life and command it to live (Ezek. 37:1–4).

My land shall not be termed desolate, but I am called Hephzi-bah, and my land Beulah (Isa. 62:4).

Make all my wilderness places like Eden, and my desert places like the garden of the Lord (Ps. 51:3).

Let every desolation in my life or bloodline be raised up in the name of Jesus (Isa. 61:4).

Revive me, and repair every desolation in my life (Ezra 9:9).

PRAYERS AGAINST DEMONIC HORSEMEN

Let the horse and rider be thrown into the sea (Exod. 15:1).

Break in pieces the horse and his rider. Break in pieces the chariot and his rider (Jer. 51:21).

I release the sword of the Lord upon the horses and chariots (Jer. 50:37).

I cut off the horses and destroy the chariots in the name of Jesus (Mic. 5:10).

Overthrow the chariots and those that ride them. Bring down the horses and their riders (Hag. 2:22).

Confound the riders on horses (Zech. 10:5).

Let the horses' heels be bitten, and let the riders fall backward (Gen. 49:17).

Let the chariot, the horse, the army, and the power lie down together and not be able to rise (Isa. 43:17).

Let the chariot and the horse be cast into a deep sleep at Your rebuke, O Lord (Ps. 76:6).

Make the horses afraid as the grasshopper (Job 39:19–20).

Let the chariots and horsemen be burned with Your fire (Nah. 2:13).

Smite the horses with astonishment and the riders with madness and blindness, O Lord (Zech. 12:4).

I bind and rebuke every black horse that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Rev. 6:5).

I bind and rebuke every red horse that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Rev. 6:4).

I bind and rebuke every pale horse that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Rev. 6:8).

Take away the strength of the demonic horsemen in the name of Jesus (Job 39:19).

Let the horses be cut by Your power, O Lord (2 Sam. 8:4).

I am Your goodly horse in the day of battle (Zech. 10:3).

PRAYERS AGAINST SPIRITS OF THE VALLEY

I bind and cast out all spirits that would attempt to keep me in a low place in the name of Jesus.

I break the chariots of the enemies of the valley in the name of Jesus (Judg. 1:19).

I rebuke and cast out the ravens of the valley in the name of Jesus (Prov. 30:17).

Lord, You are the God of the valleys. Cast out every valley spirit in the name of Jesus (1 Kings 20:28).

Let me be exalted and the spirits of the valley be smitten by Your power (2 Sam. 8:13).

I bind and rebuke every Goliath that would challenge me in the valley (1 Sam. 17:1–4).

Let all the giants of the valley be destroyed (Josh. 15:8).

Fight against the spirits of the valley, and let my enemies be avenged in the valley (Josh. 10:12–14).

Let every Achan in my life be destroyed in the valley (Josh. 7:24–26).

I loose myself from every Delilah spirit operating in the valley (Judg. 16:4).

Let all my valley places be blessed in the name of Jesus (2 Chron. 20:26).

Open a door of hope in all my valleys (Hos. 2:15).

I destroy every Edomite spirit in the valley in the name of Jesus (2 Kings 14:7).

Let water flow into every valley place of my life (Joel 3:18).

Let every valley place in my life be exalted (Luke 3:5).

I smite Amalek and destroy him in the valley (1 Sam. 15:3–5). I smite all the Midianites in the valley (Judg. 6:33–34).

DEALING WITH SPIRIT BIRDS

I bind and rebuke any unclean and hateful bird sent against my life by the enemy in the name of Jesus (Rev. 18:2).

I exercise my dominion over the unclean fowl of the air in the name of Jesus (Ps. 8:8).

Let every spirit bird sent against me be taken in the snare (Eccles. 9:12).

I bind and rebuke every spiritual vulture in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:15).

I bind the operation of the screech owl (night monster) from operating against me in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:14).

I bind and rebuke the cormorant (the vomiting pelican) from operating against my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:11).

I bind and rebuke the bittern from operating against my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:11).

I bind and rebuke any raven sent against my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:11).

I bind and rebuke any demonic eagle and hawk sent against my life, and I command their nests to be destroyed in the name of Jesus (Job 39:26–30).

I pray these unclean birds would be caged in the name of Jesus (Jer. 5:27).

I bind and rebuke any unclean bird that would attempt to nest in my life in the name of Jesus.

Let every wandering bird be cast out of its nest in the name of Jesus (Isa. 16:2).

Let Your presence drive every unclean bird away from my life (Jer. 4:25–26).

Let every fowl of heaven operating against my life be consumed in the name of Jesus (Zeph. 1:3).

Let these birds flee and fly away at Your rebuke (Jer. 9:10).

Let me walk in the path of wisdom that no fowl knows (Job 28:7, 21).

I will not be afraid of the terror by night, and I rebuke every night bird that would attempt to visit me at night (Ps. 91:5).

I am not a companion to owls (Job 30:29).

DELIVERANCE FROM LIONS

I rebuke every lion that would stoop and couch down to attack me in the name of Jesus (Gen. 49:9).

Through the strength of God, I break the jaws of the lion and pluck the spoil out of his mouth (Judg. 14:5).

Deliver me from the paw of the lion (1 Sam. 17:37).

I rebuke the fierce lion that would hunt me (Job 10:16).

Don't let the lion tear my soul (Ps. 7:2).

I rebuke and expose any lion that would wait secretly to catch me (Ps. 10:9).

I rebuke any lurking lions in the name of Jesus (Ps. 17:12).

I tread upon the lion in the name of Jesus (Ps. 91:3).

I walk in holiness, and no lion can dwell in my life (Isa. 35:9).

Deliver me from men who are like lions (1 Chron. 11:22).

Let the lion's whelps be scattered (Job 4:11).

Save me from the lion's mouth (Ps. 22:21).

Break the teeth of the lions (Ps. 58:6).

Deliver my soul from lions (Ps. 57:4).

Deliver me from the power of the lions (Dan. 6:7).

Deliver me out of the mouth of the lion (2 Tim. 4:17).

Let the Lion of the tribe of Judah roar through me against my enemies.

Deliver me from the power of the lion.

DELIVERANCE FROM SERPENTS

Lord, bruise the head of every serpent that would attack my life in the name of Jesus.

Punish the piercing serpent in the name of Jesus.

I bind and rebuke any serpent that would try to deceive me (2 Cor. 11:3).

I release the rod of God to swallow up every serpent that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Exod. 7:12).

Protect me from fiery serpents (Deut. 8:15).

I bind and rebuke every serpent that would try to twist or coil around my life in the name of Jesus.

I bind and rebuke every python that would try to squeeze out my prayer life in the name of Jesus.

I bind and rebuke every cobra that would come against me in the name of Jesus.

I bind and rebuke every cockatrice that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Isa. 14:29).

I bind and rebuke every flying serpent that would attack my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 27:1).

I bind and rebuke every sea serpent that would attack my life in the name of Jesus (Isa. 27:1).

I have authority to tread upon serpents (Luke 10:19).

I am a believer, and I pick up serpents (Mark 16:18).

Let the fire of God drive out every serpent from my life (Acts 28:3).

I cast out every viper that would operate in my life in the name of Jesus.

DELIVERANCE FROM FLIES

I bind and rebuke Beelzebub, the lord of the flies, in the name of Jesus (Matt. 12:24).

I bind and cast out all flies that would attempt to affect my anointing in the name of Jesus (Eccles. 10:1).

I bind and rebuke any swarm of flies that would come against me in the name of Jesus (Ps. 78:45).

No flies can live in my life in the name of Jesus (Exod. 8:21).

I renounce and loose myself from any spiritual garbage that would attract flies in the name of Jesus.

I rebuke every fly and every bee that would come upon my land in the name of Jesus (Isa. 7:18).

DELIVERANCE FROM ANIMALISTIC SPIRITS

I am delivered from the wild beasts of the desert (Isa. 34:14).

I rebuke the jackals that would attack my life, city, or nation in the name of Jesus.

I rebuke the night wolves that would attack my life, city, or nation in the name of Jesus (Hab. 1:8).

I rebuke every goat spirit of Pan, Faun, and Satyr in the name of Jesus.

I rebuke the wild cats—leopards, lions, jaguars, which represent higher occult powers—that would attack my life, city, or nation in the name of Jesus.

I rebuke the hyenas that would attack my life, city, or nation in the name of Jesus (Isa. 34:14).

I rebuke and bind every wild dog (represents false religion, witchcraft, and perversion) that would hound my life in the name of Jesus (Ps. 22:16).

I bind and rebuke the bulls (represents strong rebellion) in the name of Jesus (Ps. 22:12).

I command all foxes that would destroy my fruit to leave my life in the name of Jesus.

SECTION 5

EXPERIENCING DELIVERANCE OF RELEASE

Israel experienced many deliverances in its history. The nation of Israel began with a mighty deliverance. David the king received many deliverances. He called upon the Lord for deliverance and was heard (Ps. 34:4). God answers the cries and prayers of His people. God's deliverance is always a sign of His love and mercy. The word *salvation* means deliverance. The Bible is filled with stories of deliverance and salvation.

One of the greatest revelations is the revelation of self-deliverance. We can loose ourselves from any control in darkness (Isa. 52:2). We can exercise power and authority for our own lives. Jesus told us to cast out the beam from our own eye (Luke 6:42). The term *cast out* is the same word used in reference to casting out demons (*ekballo*).

Take spiritual responsibility for your life. Don't depend on everyone else for your spiritual well-being. Confess the Word over your life. Pray strong prayers that rout the enemy. Do not allow self-pity to hold you back. Stir yourself up to prayer. This is a key to an overcoming life.

Those who experienced deliverance either came or were brought to Jesus. Someone had to take the initiative. It all begins with a decision. You cannot allow passivity to rob you of deliverance. You must open your mouth. Your deliverance is as close as your mouth.

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There are many people frustrated with life. People who struggle can become overwhelmed by doubt and failure. Some are battling stress and pressure that often lead to emotional and physical problems. Jesus spent a considerable amount of time ministering to the oppressed. Multitudes came to hear Him in order to be healed and delivered from evil spirits.

Deliverance is the children's bread. Every child of God has a right to enjoy the benefits of deliverance. Deliverance brings freedom and joy. We have seen thousands of believers set free from demons through authoritative prayer. Deliverance is a miracle ministry. You will see multiplied miracles through warfare prayer.

The breakthroughs you will see are supernatural. Healings will multiply. Long-term bondages will be destroyed. Hidden roots will be exposed and eliminated. Inexplicable problems will be solved. Stubborn obstacles will be removed. Cycles of failure will be broken.

Frustration and despair will be eliminated through warfare prayer. Discouragement and disappointment will be overcome. The puzzling problems of life will be taken away. Lasting peace can finally be experienced. The abundant life can be enjoyed.

Failures that cause bitterness are reversed through warfare prayer. Prosperity and success will come. Advancement will be seen in different areas of your life. You will experience success in relationships, finances, ministry, and projects. Deliverance is designed to eliminate the spiritual obstacles that impede progress. Deliverance makes the rough places smooth and the crooked places straight.

You can see the enemy routed from your life. You can live free from the bondages and oppressions of demons. You can experience victory through prayer. Your words and prayers have tremendous power to destroy the works of darkness. Those who experience deliverance and release will see notable changes. Sometimes the change is progressive and sometimes instantaneous. The change, however, will be dramatic. There will be an increase of joy, liberty, peace, and success. This will result in a better spiritual life with an increase of strength and holiness.

Patience is necessary to see breakthrough. God promised Israel that He would drive the enemy out little by little (Deut. 7:22; Exod. 23:29–30). Unless you understand this principle, you will become weary in praying for some people, and you will become discouraged in your own deliverance. The more freedom you will receive, the more you need to grow and possess your land.

You have the authority to bind and loose (Matt. 18:18). Webster's dictionary defines the word *bind* as, "to make secure by tying; to confine, restrain, or restrict *as* if with bonds: to constrain with legal authority: to exert a restraining or compelling effect." It also means to arrest, apprehend, handcuff, lead captive, take charge of, lock up, restrain, check, or put a stop to. Binding is done by legal authority. We have legal authority in the name of Jesus to bind the works of darkness.

The works of darkness encompass sin, iniquity, perversion, sickness, disease, infirmity, death, destruction, curses, witchcraft, sorcery, divination, poverty, lack, strife, lust, pride, rebellion, fear, torment, and confusion. We have legal authority to put a stop to these things in our lives and in the lives of those we minister to.

Loose means to untie, to free from restraint, to detach, to disjoin, divorce, separate, unhitch, get free, get loose, escape, break away, unbind, unchain, unfetter, free, release, unlock, liberate, disconnect, or forgive.

People need to be loosed from curses, evil inheritance,

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familiar spirits, sin, guilt, shame, condemnation, control, domination, manipulation, intimidation, mind control, religious control, sickness, disease, deception, false teaching, sin, habits, worldliness, carnality, demons, tradition, ungodly soul ties, ungodly pledges, ungodly vows, spoken words, hexes, vexes, jinxes, trauma, and cults. We have legal authority in the name of Jesus to loose ourselves and others to whom we minister from these destroying influences.

PRAYERS FOR SELF-DELIVERANCE

I break all generational curses of pride, rebellion, lust, poverty, witchcraft, idolatry, death, destruction, failure, sickness, infirmity, fear, schizophrenia, and rejection in the name of Jesus.

I command all generational and hereditary spirits operating in my life through curses to be bound and cast out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of lust, perversion, adultery, fornication, uncleanness, and immorality to come out of my sexual character in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of hurt, rejection, fear, anger, wrath, sadness, depression, discouragement, grief, bitterness, and unforgiveness to come out of my emotions in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of confusion, forgetfulness, mind control, mental illness, doublemindedness, fantasy, pain, pride, and memory recall to come out of my mind in the name of Jesus.

I break all curses of schizophrenia and command all spirits of doublemindedness, rejection, rebellion, and root of bitterness to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of guilt, shame, and condemnation to come out of my conscience in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of pride, stubbornness, disobedience, rebellion, self-will, selfishness, and arrogance to come out of my will in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of addiction to come out of my appetite in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits of witchcraft, sorcery, divination, and occult to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my head, eyes, mouth, tongue, and throat to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my chest and lungs to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my back and spine to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my stomach, navel, and abdomen to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my heart, spleen, kidneys, liver, and pancreas to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my sexual organs to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my hands, arms, legs, and feet to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all demons operating in my skeletal system, including my bones, joints, knees, and elbows, to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my glands and endocrine system to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my blood and circulatory systems to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits operating in my muscles and muscular system to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all religious spirits of doubt, unbelief, error, heresy, and tradition that came in through religion to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all spirits from my past that are hindering my present and future to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all ancestral spirits that entered through my ancestors to come out in the name of Jesus.

I command all hidden spirits hiding in any part of my life to come out in the name of Jesus.

PRAYERS FOR PROSPERITY AND FINANCIAL RELEASE

I break all assignments of the enemy against my finances in the name of Jesus.

I break all curses of poverty, lack, debt, and failure in the name of Jesus.

I seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all things are added unto me (Matt. 6:33).

I rebuke and cast out all spirits of the cankerworm, palmerworm, caterpillar, and locust that would eat up my blessings in the name of Jesus (Joel 2:25).

Lord, teach me to profit, and lead me in the way I should go (Isa. 48:17).

You are Jehovah-Jireh, my provider (Gen. 22:14).

You are El Shaddai, the God of more than enough.

Wealth and riches are in my house because I fear You and delight greatly in Your commandments (Ps. 112:1–3).

The blessing of the Lord upon my life makes me rich.

I am blessed coming in and blessed going out.

I am God's servant, and He takes pleasure in my prosperity (Ps. 35:27).

Jesus, You became poor, that through Your poverty I might be rich (2 Cor. 8:9).

I meditate on the Word day and night, and whatever I do prospers (Ps. 1:3).

Let peace be within my walls and prosperity within my palace (Ps. 122:7).

I will prosper through the prophets and prophetic ministry (Ezra 6:14).

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I believe the prophets, and I prosper (2 Chron. 20:20).

I am Your servant, Lord. Prosper me (Neh. 1:11).

The God of heaven will prosper me (Neh. 2:20).

I live in the prosperity of the King (Jer. 23:5).

Through Your favor I will be a prosperous person (Gen. 39:2).

Lord, You have called me, and You will make my way prosperous (Isa. 48:15).

I pray in secret, and You reward me openly (Matt. 6:6).

I fast in secret, and You reward me openly (Matt. 6:18).

You reward me because I diligently seek You (Heb. 11:6).

Lord, release the wealth of the wicked into my hands (Prov. 13:22).

Lord, bring me into a wealthy place (Ps. 66:12).

I give, and it is given to me—good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over (Luke 6:38).

Open the floodgates of heaven over my life, and I receive more than I have enough room to receive (Mal. 3:10).

Let every hole in my bag be closed in the name of Jesus (Hag. 1:6).

Rebuke the devourer for my sake (Mal. 3:11).

All nations will call me blessed, and I will be a delightful land (Mal. 3:12).

My gates are open continually that the forces (wealth) of the nations can come into my life (Isa. 60:11).

I am in league with the stones of the field (Job 5:23).

Let Your showers of blessing come upon my life (Ezek. 34:26).

Let my vats overflow (Joel 2:24).

Let my barns be filled with plenty and my presses burst with new wine (Prov. 3:10).

Command Your blessing upon my storehouse (Deut. 28:8).

Let my barns be full and overflowing. Let my sheep bring forth thousands and ten thousands. Let my oxen be strong to labor (Ps. 144:13–14).

The plowman overtakes the reaper in my life, and the treader of grapes the sower of the seed, and I live in continual harvest (Amos 9:13).

Let my floor be full of wheat and my vats overflow with wine and oil (Joel 2:24).

Deal wondrously with me, and let me eat and be satisfied (Joel 2:26).

Make peace within my border, and fill me with the finest of wheat (Ps. 147:14).

Let me be filled with honey and the finest of wheat (Ps. 81:16).

Lead me into the land flowing with milk and honey (Exod. 3:8).

Bring me into a good land without scarceness and lack (Deut. 8:9).

Make all grace abound toward me that I will have sufficiency in all things and abound to every good work (2 Cor. 9:8).

Anoint my head with oil, and let my cup run over (Ps. 23:5).

Let me have riches and honor in abundance (2 Chron. 18:1).

Let the rock pour me out rivers of oil (Job 29:6).

Let me dip my feet in oil (Deut. 33:24).

Let me see Your heaps in my life (2 Chron. 31:8).

I love wisdom, I inherit substance, and my treasures are filled (Prov. 8:21).

I receive riches and honor, durable riches and righteousness (Prov. 8:18).

Bring honey out of the rock for me (Ps. 81:16).

Let me eat the finest of wheat (Ps. 147:14).

Let my teeth be white with milk (Gen. 49:12).

Wash my steps with butter (Job 29:6).

Let me lay up gold as dust (Job 22:24).

Let me have plenty of silver (Job 28:1).

Let Your river lead me to gold (Gen. 2:11-12).

Let me inherit the land (Ps. 37:29).

I refuse to allow the angel of blessing to depart without blessing me (Gen. 2:6).

Prayers for Healing and Health

I am healed by the stripes of Jesus (Isa. 53:5).

Jesus carried my sickness and infirmities (Matt. 8:17).

I cast out all spirits of infirmity that would attack my body in the name of Jesus.

I break, rebuke, and cast out any spirit of cancer that would attempt to establish itself in my lungs, bones, breast, throat, back, spine, liver, kidneys, pancreas, skin, or stomach in the name of Jesus.

I rebuke and cast out all spirits causing diabetes, high blood pressure, low blood pressure, heart attack, stroke, kidney failure, leukemia, blood disease, breathing problems, arthritis, lupus, Alzheimer's, or insomnia in the name of Jesus.

I speak healing and strength to my bones, muscles, joints, organs, head, eyes, throat, glands, blood, marrow, lungs, kidneys, liver, spleen, spine, pancreas, eyes, bladder, ears, nose, sinuses, mouth, tongue, and feet in the name of Jesus.

I loose myself from all heart attacks rooted in fear, and I command all spirits of fear to leave in Jesus's name (Luke 21:26).

I loose myself from all diabetes rooted in rejection, self-hatred, inheritance, and guilt, and I command these spirits to come out in the name of Jesus.

I loose myself from all cancer rooted in bitterness, unforgiveness, resentment, and slander of the tongue, and I command these spirits to come out in the name of Jesus.

I loose myself from lupus rooted in self-rejection, self-hatred, and guilt, and I cast these spirits out in the name of Jesus.
