

RELEASING THE POWER OF THE SATANIC TALISMAN

The talisman may be used ONCE to obtain a particular day; or day and hour if an Olympic God was created on the back. The ritual day is obtained by the talisman itself, and the hour the ritual is to be performed in is decided by the planet ruling the day, or the hour glyph on the back which is the hour the Olympic God Sigil was created on the back of the talisman.

A talisman must stand for six days and nights before it can be used or disposed of. After six days and nights, no Shining God may be drawn on the back, the talisman is complete.

When used to imbue a magic circle (see *The First Satanic Ritual*) the talisman is placed beneath the Chalice. After this, the talisman must be destroyed to release full potential as soon as possible. No other talisman may be destroyed or used until then except for extreme emergency.

To dispose of the talisman, hold it an arms length from the eyes before a white or very light wall or backdrop. Do not hold it by any corner. Stares unblinkingly at the center for at least one minute during which time a request relating to the day ruled by the talisman should be uttered once allowed, and then repeatedly by mind. The request does not by any means need relation to the original purpose of the talisman; original purposes should in fact be forgotten. After staring fixedly at the center of the TST, recite the appropriate Latin verse once while pointing the middle and index fingers at the center of the talisman.

Burn the talisman directly following. And then collect the ashes and dispose of them according to the below:

IF THE TST IS OF:

THE SUN – THURSDAY IN THE HOUR OF THE SUN

Ashes left on rock, concrete, or stone to the EAST.

MERCURY – SUNDAY OR MONDAY IN THE HOUR OF MERCURY

Ashes scattered or blown in the wind to the EAST.

THE MOON – TUESDAY IN THE HOUR OF THE MOON

Ashes sprinkled in running water or flushed down the toilet in no particular direction; or ashes rinsed from hands in the rain to the WEST.

MARS – SATURDAY IN THE HOUR OF MARS

Ashes left in thurible, hearth/fireplace, balefire, or burning reciprocal to the SOUTH.

VENUS – TUESDAY IN THE HOUR OF VENUS

Ashes buried in soil to the NORTH.

JUPITER – MONDAY IN THE HOUR OF JUPITER

Ashes disposed of in no particular manner or direction.

SATURN – SUNDAY IN THE HOUR OF SATURN

Ashes buried beneath a boulder, stones, or at the foot of a tree in no particular direction or left on concrete to the SOUTH.

After this, make the sign of the horns in the appropriate direction if applicable and say boldly:

“Hail Satan!”

“For The One True Kingdom Mightiest of All

“Blessings For The Kingdom of Satan”

“I Am The End and The Just Beginning”
