The response to our recent Building Fund Letter has been a wonderful personal experience for me. Answers have come in from many parts of the country, pledging support and assuring me of deep and sincere interest in the success of our Society's project. In our last letter we told you that we needed \$50,000 to complete our building program. In response to our appeal, \$33,400 has been given and pledged. As a result of this substantial evidence of confidence and cooperation, we are sufficiently close to our goal that with your help, NOW, we shall accomplish our aim.

It is indeed inspiring to me that this project, which is very close to my heart, is so near to attainment. The moment the amount still needed is made available through pledges, the building contract can be signed. In light of the constructive and encouraging letters we have received, and also because 25% of the new pledges represent renewals by those who have completed previous commitments, we feel certain that many more of our friends will want to take an active part in this program.
