PART II — ORDERS OF THE GREAT WORK

From the Hermetic traditions of Egypt came the wonderful symbolism of alchemy. Under chemical signs and diagrams, the secret lores of human regeneration were preserved through those difficult centuries we call the Middle Ages. Included in this essay are the stories of Paracelsus—Roger Bacon—Raymond Lully, that universal genius—Nicholas Flamel, the humble notary who found the Philosophers' Stone—a meeting of Dervish immortals—Basil Valentine— and many others who sought the Universal Medicine and the Elixir of Eternal Youth. PART III — ORDERS OF UNIVERSAL REFORMATION

With the dawn of the modern world came the effort to bring the Secret Tradition to the attention of thoughtful persons in various walks of life. The Rosicrucians issued their great Proclamations, and the search for the Secret Master of the Rosy Cross began. Such names as Michael Maier, Robert Fludd, Jakob Boehme, and John Heydon came into prominence. Francis Bacon and rare Ben Jonson created their nursery of Humanism at Gray's Inn. More's Utopia, Campanella's The City of the Sun, and later such works as Bacon's New Atlantis, Defoe's Robinson Crusoe, and similar writings concealed deep truths under pleasant tales. The great motion of Reformation prepared the way for modern progress.

PART IV — MASONIC ORDERS OF FRATERNITY

From the old Guilds and secret foundations in antiquity, from the Roman Collegia and the Comacine Masters came the doctrines which, in the early 18th century, flowed together to form modern Freemasonry. The essay covers the transition period of Guild Societies, the English Miracle Plays, and the effect of the Protestant Reformation and the part played by Martin Luther. The foundation of the Royal Society—the revival of Rosicrucianism—the story of Louis Claude de Saint-Martin, the unknown philosopher Emanuel Swedenborg — Voltaire — Cagliostro—St.-Germain—and the Order of the Illuminati are examined. Mozart's Masonic opera, *The Magic Flute*—The Egyptian Rites of Masonry—Eliphas Levi, the French Transcendentalist, and the dramatic incidents of the French Revolution form a remarkable pattern well worth examination.
