OUR LATEST PUBLISHING PROJECT—

Our program of mimeographed lecture notes, making available one of Mr. Hall's lectures each month, was introduced in 1959. The early notes have long been completely out of print, and as the demand continues, we have selected ten of the most popular lectures for publication in permanent form.

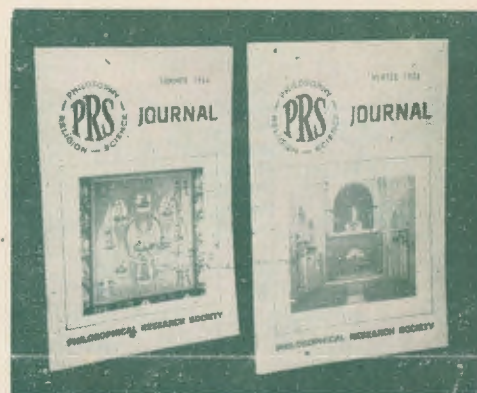

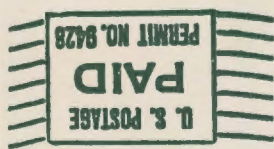
