This book is recognized as a definitive work in the literature on rebirth. For the new edition, just off the press, Mr. Hall has added a "Postscript" containing timely notes and observations, including further bibliographical references and an important case history reported in 1966.

Entirely compatible with the scientifically acceptable teachings of evolution and causality, rebirth is sustained by the almost irrefutable testimony of Universal Law and natural procedures. We are in a generation of scientific skepticism, but strangely enough, the belief in reincarnation has gained greater recognition from trained minds than any other solution for the riddle of human destiny.

Older cultures that have lived long and faced many political and sociological changes, have been led to the acceptance of reincarnation by the problems of daily existence. Today more than a billion human beings accept as perfectly reasonable and necessary the idea that they will live again in this world.





The thirty-two chapters of this book present a clear and direct development of various aspects of the doctrine of rebirth. Among the subjects discussed are: reincarnation in Oriental systems of thought, Greek philosophy, and among the American Indians; the theory as set forth in the Old and New Testaments and interpreted by the early Christian Fathers; the rebirth of animals, plants, and minerals; the idea of soul-mates, the memory of past lives, and the fate of the suicide.

The work is strongly documented, and there is an extensive bibliography for those who desire to continue their studies of the subject. Cloth bound, 224 pages, two full-page plates, complete digest index.



LECTURES ON ANCIENT PHILOSOPHY

An Introduction to Practical Ideals

by MANLY P. HALL

One of the most comprehensive of Mr. Hall's publications, this volume summarizes the basic thinking upon which his life and work have been established, and covers a wide range of subjects. In the opening chapters, the reader



is introduced to the concept of the universe set forth by the Platonists, Neo-platonists, Gnostics, and Cabalists. The religious philosophy of the ancient Hindus contributes to the over-all theme, and this, in turn, prepares the way for a discussion of Buddhism, especially the law of cause and effect as it applies to the unfolding consciousness of the individual. In the study of cosmogony, the mathematical philosophy of Pythagoras is introduced, and the ideals of the Greek metaphysicians are restated in the terms of Ralph Waldo Emerson. The rise of the esoteric schools of antiquity is discussed, and the rituals of initiation in the sacred institutions of Greece and Egypt are explained in terms of the classical symbolism. The various streams of research and study converge upon the nature of man himself, his place in the world, and the constitution of his spiritual and psychic natures. In this area, Rosicrucian and Masonic ideals are introduced, which lead naturally to the vision of the future as set forth in *The New Atlantis* of Francis Bacon.

In Lectures on Ancient Philosophy, the reader will find the answers to many questions. This is not a book to be read hastily, but to be lived with and studied over a period of years. There are twenty unusual diagrams to assist in the clarification of the text. One of them, dealing with the theory of numbers, is shown here greatly reduced in size. 
