Dear Friend and Subscriber:

After eighteen years of continuous publication under the name HORIZON, circumstances have arisen which have caused us to make a change in our journal. These circumstances are set forth in an agreement which we have recently signed. The pertinent paragraph of this agreement we quote herewith in its original form:

"A number of our subscribers have written to us pointing out that American Heritage Publishing Co., Inc., through its subsidiary, American Horizon, Inc., will issue, in the Fall, a journal named HORIZON, which is also the name of our journal. Feeling that this confusion would be unfortunate, we have come to a formal legal understanding with them under which we have received \$11,000 and relinquished the title HORIZON. It is our feeling that this was the best and most practical solution to the complications involved. The full amount received by us will be deposited in our publication fund."

As the result of due and careful consideration, I have decided that a new publication will hereafter appear under the name PRS JOURNAL. The use of these initials seems especially appropriate, inasmuch as they stand for The Philosophical Research Society, Inc., and therefore identify the magazine directly with our organization. By a happy circumstance, the letters PRS are also the initials of the three words *Philosophy*, *Religion*, and *Science*, representing the basic divisions of human knowledge which we seek to integrate in a comprehensive program of enlightened education.

Your subscription will not be affected by these changes. The format, policy, and scope of our new publication will remain the same.

Through the years, many letters have come to the Society from subscribers telling of the pleasure and benefit they have derived from our magazine. These kindly words have come to my attention, and I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for your support and encouragement.
