## Samuel Zane Batten

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Samuel Zane Batten (1859–1925) was a Baptist minister.<sup>[1]</sup>

## Biography

He served as a Baptist minister in Morristown, New Jersey, where he preached against alcohol consumption and gambling.<sup>[2]</sup> He was an adamant proponent of democracy for its Christian appeal.<sup>[3]</sup> In 1908, he established the Commission on Social Service of the American Baptist Association.<sup>[4]</sup>

He was a member of the Brotherhood of the Kingdom.<sup>[5]</sup>

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
