## READ ME

The PDF files contained on this disc may differ slightly from the printed issues in trivial ways. Occasionally a font used in earlier issues was no longer available, or a graphic file may have been slightly changed. The text itself is primarily unaltered, aside from a few typo corrections. However, no over-arching attempt has been made to catch all of the typos or errors. Excepting for the most recent issues, advertisements contained in these issues should be considered out-of-date. Some of the companies are no longer in business, and prices may have changed with those companies still in business. A web search might locate more current information on the companies that are of interest to you.

Issues are presented in chronological order. The "DeKorne Years" issues from 1992– 1997 have been included in folder, with the files broken into compilations based on each year of publication. Although the original DeKorne Years issues were not indexed, an index for these years was later produced by an enthusiastic subscriber; it is included as a separate file in the folder. From 1998 through 2008, each issue is presented as a single file, and the winter issue of each year has contains an index for that entire year. Issues are coded "V" for "Vernal Equinox," "S" for "Summer Solstice," "F" for "Autumnal Equinox," and "W" for "Winter Solstice." Following these codes, the last two digits of the year of publication are provided. In 2000, a double-length "Spring/Summer" issue was produced, so there were only three issues that year. In 2004, only the Spring and Summer issues were produced. Similarly in 2005, only the Fall and Winter issues were produced. Publication took a hiatus entirely in 2007, and ended with a full year of issues in 2008.
