Mind Control in the Christian Churches!

Why are Christians So Easily Deceived?

The vast majority of all the Christians in the world worship on Sunday because, they say, “Jesus was resurrected on Sunday.”

Even the Seventh-day Adventists who worship on the correct day, the Saturday Sabbath, the day ordained and made Holy by God as a memorial of His creation (Gen 2:1-3), still believe Jesus was resurrected on Sunday.

But they are wrong!

“Give us a Sign”

When asked for a “sign” by the Pharisees and other Israelites, that He was the Messiah, He answered and said unto them:

“But He answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall **no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonah**: For as Jonah was **three days and three nights** in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be **three days and three nights** in the heart of the earth.” Matt 12:39,40

Jesus said He would be in the “**heart of the earth**” **3 days and 3 nights**. Most Christians think the phrase “heart of the earth” means “grave” but that cannot be true.

If Jesus was crucified on Friday – which He was – then WHERE are the “3 nights” between Friday and Sunday?

Indeed, there are PARTS of 3 days between Friday and Sunday – but there are only TWO NIGHTS! There is No Way that anyone can conjure up THREE nights between Friday and Sunday. There are only TWO nights: Friday night and Saturday night – no matter how you look at it!

So, Jesus could **not** have been Crucified on Friday and resurrected on Sunday. If He was, then Jesus Christ LIED! But Jesus does NOT Lie!

What are the options to this dilemma?

Was Jesus crucified on Thursday?

Was Jesus really resurrected on Monday?

Does the phrase “heart of the earth” really mean “grave”?

When Jesus spoke of the 3 days and 3 nights, which day did He claim to be the beginning day of the 3?

Or is there some other explanation?

And why is no one thinking or questioning?

Mind Control

Why do pastors, theologians, and Christians in general, NEVER question this? It's very straight forward! Why can't any Christian count to 3?

Because they're under Mind Control. They go to church every week. They are surrounded by people who believe exactly as they do. They are surrounded by people who also never question the doctrines they are told to believe.

They sing the same songs every week. They have the same order of service every week. In many churches, the congregation speaks the same words together – a “responsive reading” - which is not much different from self hypnosis.

Going to church stifles independent Bible study. Going to church suppresses independent thinking. They have eyes, but they cannot see. They have ears, but they cannot hear and understand. They have a mind, but they cease to use it because those who are in positions of authority tell them what to believe, and they willingly follow along.

They are Mind Controlled! And this proves it!

All Christians have heard – and believed – for years the passage of Matt 12:39,40, that Jesus said He would be in the “heart of the earth for 3 days and 3 nights,” yet the Christian world NEVER questions His Words.

No one ever asks, “Where is the Third Night?”

It appears to bother no one, even though the truthfulness of Jesus Christ, Himself, is a stake!

Everyone accepts the explanation of a Friday crucifixion and Sunday resurrection, but it cannot be – if Jesus is telling the truth!

Cognitive Dissonance in the Christian Church

It appears that the Organized Christian churches specialize in **Cognitive Dissonance** which is defined In psychology as the mental stress or discomfort experienced by an **individual who holds two or more contradictory beliefs, ideas, or values at the same time.**

1. Christians believe Jesus when He said He would be in the “heart of the earth” 3 days and 3 nights, yet they also believe that He was crucified on Friday and resurrected on Sunday – during which span of time there are only TWO nights! So, what is the explanation, and why do Christians not ask these questions?
2. Christians believe “God is love” yet Christians also believe that God is going to torture at least some of His children in Hellfire for eternity. Somehow Christians have the ability to view burning someone in Hellfire as a “loving” act. Yet, if a neighbor burned up his children for misbehaving, that Christian would never refer to that event as a “loving act.” So what is the explanation, and why do Christians not ask these questions?
3. Christians believe that God is omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent. They believe He knows everything, including the end from the beginning. Yet Christians believe that “Lucifer” was created perfect, and then fell, and apparently surprised and disappointed God. Christians do NOT believe that was God’s “Plan.” But if it was NOT God’s Plan, then God made a mistake – and a “mistake” is the actual meaning of the word “sin.” So that makes God a sinner! But God is not a sinner! So what is the explanation, and why do Christians not ask these questions?
4. Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus on Easter, a pagan holiday named after the pagan god, Ishtar, with bunnies and eggs: fertility symbols. Ishtar was the fertility god of the heathen. What does that have to do with Jesus’ resurrection, and why don’t Christians question that?
5. The Bible says, “Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God.” (Col 1:15)

Jesus said, "I and the Father are one." Jesus said, "If you've seen Me, you've seen the Father." And Jesus says, "Love your enemies; do GOOD to those who hate you."

Then why doesn't that work for God? Why is He going to torture His enemies in Hellfire forever?

This is Cognitive Dissonance at it Best (or Worst)

In every Christian church in the world, members sit in the pews, constantly participating in Cognitive Dissonance: believing two completely opposing doctrines at the same time. Why?

Because they are under Mind Control in church, and in every aspect of their life, and they can no longer think for themselves. They have been brainwashed.

The News: mind control through "cognitive dissonance"

"When professionals broadcast one absurdity after another, they begin to see the effects are actually strengthening their own position of authority. It's a revelation. It's also a continuation of the tradition of the Trickster archetype. For example, with just a few minor adjustments, Brian Williams can be seen as the sly Reynard the Fox..." (The Underground, Jon Rappoport)

From the viewpoint of elite television news, controlling the minds of its audience depends on what's politely called "cognitive dissonance":

As the anchor recites a news story, the viewer sees an obvious hole through which he could drive a truck.

The story makes no sense, yet it's being presented as bland fact. The trusted anchor clearly has no problem with it.

What's the viewer to do? He experiences a contradiction, a "dissonance."

For example, this year's flu vaccine. The US government has admitted the vaccine is geared to a flu virus that isn't circulating in the population. Therefore,

even by conventional standards, the vaccine is useless. But the kicker is, the CDC says people should take the vaccine anyway.

The anchor relays all this information—and never seriously questions the situation, never torpedoes the government for recommending the vaccine. The average viewer feels a tug, a pulse of discomfort, a push-pull. The vaccine story is idiocy (side one), but the trusted anchor accepts it (side two).
Dissonance.

The top chiefs of news—and top propaganda operatives—anticipate cognitive dissonance. In a real sense, they want it to happen. They make it happen. Over and over.

Why?

Because it throws the viewer into a tailspin. And in that mental state, in his effort to resolve the contradiction, he will normally choose to...give in. Surrender. Believe in the anchor. It's the easier path.

The viewer will even doubt his own perception. "I see no good reason for Building 7 to collapse, but the news doesn't bring that up, so...it must be me."

This is the power of the news. It presents absurdities and then moves right along, as if nothing has happened.

For the viewer, it's the equivalent of: "Don't you see that pile-up of smashed cars on the freeway, and the smoke? No? Oh well, it must be me. I guess I was wrong. There isn't any pile-up."

The introduction of contradiction, dissonance, and absurdity parading as ordinary reality is an intentional feature of brainwashing.

On the nightly news, the anchor reports that US government debt has risen by another three trillion dollars. He then cuts to a statement from a Federal Reserve spokesman: the new debt level isn't a problem; in fact, it's sound monetary policy; it strengthens the economy.

The viewer, caught up in this absurdity, tries to make sense of it, then gives up and passively accepts it. Brainwashing!

Smoothly transitioning from this story, the anchor relays information from the CDC: vaccination rates must achieve 90% in the population, in order to protect people from dangerous viruses. The viewer thinks, "Well, my daughter is already vaccinated, so if she comes into contact with a child who isn't vaccinated, why

would that be a problem for her? Why does 90% of the population have to be vaccinated to keep her safe? She's already vaccinated."

The viewer wrestles with this absurdity for a moment, then gives in and accepts what the CDC and the anchor are saying. More passivity. More brainwashing. The anchor moves right along to the next story: "The US is experiencing one of the coldest winters in history, further evidence of the effects of global warming, according to scientists at the United Nations."

The viewer shakes his head, tries to deal with this dissonance, surrenders, and accepts what he is hearing. Deeper passivity is the result. Deeper brainwashing. On and on it goes, day after day, month after month, year after year, on the news.

Contradiction, absurdity, dissonance; acceptance, surrender, passivity.

The same general formula is used in interrogations and formal mind control. It adds up to disorientation of the target.

Most disoriented people opt for the lowest- common-denominator solution: give in; accept the power of the person of authority.

When it comes to the news, that person is the anchor, the narrator, the presenter of reality.

He sows the ground with seeds of dissonance. That is how he gains compliance from the viewer.

If the news anchor experiences moments of conscience and self-doubt, he can tell himself he is doing the work of a journalist: he's presenting information obtained from reliable sources. If these sources are spouting contradictions and absurdities, so be it. "Nothing better is available."

Among the many supporters of conventional news is the education system. Most teachers never learn logic, and they don't teach it. The result? Their students never gain the ability or the courage to reject the news and its dissonances. What little these students gain from 12 or 16 years of schooling they eventually sacrifice on the altar of consensus reality—as broadcast every night on the screen before them.

In the face of absurdities that never add up or make sense, they surrender their minds.

If you gain enough distance from the news and watch it every night and pick it apart and see every dissonance, you realize the news is utterly Surreal. However, it is sold as utterly Normal. That is its trump card—the ability to sell itself as the ultimate in Normalcy.

That is its greatest achievement: overcoming its deepest contradiction.

Mind Control is Everywhere – even in – and especially in - the Churches!

The churches have become highly sophisticated centers of Mind Control. As 501c3 tax-exempt organizations whose head is the State, they are being used by the New World Order to brainwash Christians. They have already begun telling churches what they can and cannot teach. Churches are allowed to promote only what the state promotes. Certainly, God’s view on homosexuality as shown in the Bible, cannot be preached from the pulpit. If it is, that church is highly likely to lose their tax exempt status - - and - - be forced to repay the full amount of the money that was exempted from taxes from the inception of that particular church!

Church Members have been so thoroughly brainwashed, they can’t count to Three!

Counting to 3, regarding the 3 Days and (lack of) 3 Nights, is very direct. It’s not a complicated, esoteric doctrine. It’s just “3 days and 3 nights.” Yet every Christian has been deceived.

Now that we have established that something as simple as counting to 3 can be the subject of cognitive dissonance, a contradiction that has been totally accepted by virtually every Christian in the world – without anyone ever questioning it – let’s solve the dilemma.

1. Jesus stated He would be “as Jonah was in the belly of the whale.” Jonah was alive when he was in the whale’s belly. Therefore, during the 3 days and nights of which Jesus spoke, Jesus would be alive.
2. Jesus said He would be “in the heart of the earth.” Jesus did not say He would be in the “grave” – a word that Jesus obviously knew, and had used many times before. So the words “heart of the earth” are not synonymous with “grave.”
3. Whenever Jesus spoke of His crucifixion, death and resurrection, He always began with His betrayal – NOT His crucifixion. Jesus was first betrayed on Tuesday night BEFORE His actual crucifixion, at the dinner at Simon the Leper’s house, when Mary Magdalene poured the ointment on Jesus’ feet.

Judas Iscariot, who “carried the bag” containing the money for the group of disciples (and had been stealing from it), said that the money for the ointment (a year’s salary) should have been used for the poor. It was that night, the Bible tells us, that Judas went to the priests and the Pharisees and received the 30 pieces of silver.

4. How do we know that dinner was held on Tuesday evening? Because on that same day, Jesus said, “It is 2 days until the Passover.” On what day did Jesus keep the Passover? On Thursday evening (The Lord’s Supper), because He was being crucified on Friday evening.

So we have: Tuesday night, Wednesday night, Thursday night = 3 nights.

We have: Wednesday, Thursday, Friday = 3 days.

There are the 3 Days and 3 Nights that Jesus was referring to – a time during which He was ALIVE (just as Jonah was alive in the belly of the whale) – but Jesus’ doom was set and He was unable to escape His fate (He was surrounded by the “inhabitants of the earth” – the “heart of the earth” – unable to escape), just as Jonah was unable to escape from the belly of the whale for 3 Days and 3 Nights.

Jesus was, indeed, crucified on Friday. He died at 3:00 P.M., and was put in the tomb before sundown. But as soon as the sun went down on Friday night, the Saturday Sabbath began – God’s holy day – a memorial of His creation, Jesus was resurrected from the tomb.

He had only been dead a few hours, but how long does Jesus have to be dead? There’s nothing “magic” about 3 days and 3 nights as far as “being dead” is concerned.

The women came to the tomb on Sabbath (sabbaton) morning, NOT “the first day of the week,” and Jesus was already gone. He had already risen!

The Greek word “Sabbaton” which means Sabbath – the Saturday Sabbath – appears in the New Testament 68 times. Fifty-nine times that word is translated Sabbath (referring to Saturday). But 9 times, it is arbitrarily mistranslated “First Day of the week” – words that NEVER appear in the Bible, whether in the Old or the New Testament. Six of those nine times are regarding the Resurrection of Jesus.

Christians can be, and have been, Easily Brainwashed

This study is primarily to point out the ease with which the members of the Christian church have been deceived, while thinking “they have The Truth!”

When individuals are surrounded by a group of friends whom they trust, who ALL believe as they do, and when individuals are “under the authority” of a Christian Leader whom they admire, and also trust, they can easily be deceived in many ways, and on many doctrines. They trust those in leadership positions, and they rarely question anything because they don’t want to be considered a “trouble maker’ by asking probing questions.

Their mind passively accepts whatever they are told!

That’s why God never wanted Organized Churches.

“You need no man to teach you. . . One is your Teacher, Christ.” (1 John 2:27; Matt 23:8)

God’s presence was in the Sanctuary in the wilderness and in the Temple in Jerusalem, where no person, except the priests, was allowed to enter – under penalty of Death!

When the temple in Jerusalem was destroyed, Jesus said,

“The Most High does not live in houses made with hands.” Acts 7:48

(Now) “Your body is the temple of God’s spirit,” 1 Cor 6:19

The synagogues, set up by the Pharisees – the enemies of Christ - were the “model” for today’s “Christian” churches, where people come in, sit down, and have “man” tell them what to believe about God.

Churches are powerful tools for Cognitive Dissonance and Mind Control!
