
#### Dear Reader,

# SETTING THE SCENE Firstband Experience

Since it was mentioned that my experiences inspired me to write this book, I'd like to offer a few of them here to create a background of Crop Circle country – especially for those of you who haven't had the opportunity to experience the Crop Circles firsthand.

There are so many pictures that come to mind at first, incorporating sight, sound, smell, and feelings, that it's hard to know where to start. It is an awesome sight — catching sight of a crop formation in a field as one is driving along a country lane. The average size of these formations is probably 250 ft. in diameter, and many are much larger than that.

I remember the thrill of spotting my first Crop Circle as I was on the road towards Glastonbury. I had taken a route that was very familiar to me. Not actually having intended to go that way, my automatic pilot guided me on. Before I knew it, I was on the A4 towards Avebury, the heart of Crop Circle country. It was a simple circle in the field opposite Silbury Hill, the centre of many cosmic experiences for a lot of us.

Another synchronicity on this same trip, was the occurrence of two Crop Circles in the Midlands where my parents

lived. The two Crop Circles appeared in the same field – one a simple circle, the other a circle with an outer ring – on the farmland that was very familiar to me. I had played in those very fields as a child, and still enjoyed walking the footpath through them when visiting. They had appeared on the very same day that my plane had landed on my journey from San Francisco to London Heathrow!

The third and most profound of all my experiences on this particular journey was the first time I actually set foot inside of a Crop Circle. I was with a larger group of people who had all come from the Crop Circle Symposium in Glastonbury. I remember the excitement and anticipation I felt as we neared the field, and could vaguely spot the outline of the formation in the waving ears of wheat. It was the Roundway formation of 1995, near Devizes in Wiltshire – two separate circles – one small centre circle, and another larger circle, both surrounded by an outer ring that kissed the outer edge of the larger circle. Again, it was a simple formation; one that had actually been laid a couple of weeks prior, and had been quite well visited already.

Were the CircleMakers trying to tell me something about simplicity at the very beginning, as I gazed at my very first Crop Circle from within its midst? Did not this indicate that simplicity, time, and the amount of visitors to a formation are irrelevant to the experiences that one can glean from it?

I'll never forget the feeling I got as I stepped through the

"gateway" from the tramlines into the outer ring, right by the intersection of the larger circle. There was a rush of energy that came up from the Earth through my body; while simultaneously, a cosmic energy entered my crown chakra from above, both seeming to activate the opening and aligning of my chakras concurrently. As they met – right in my heart chakra – I experienced an intense emotion of love, joy, and well being like I have never experienced before – a true heart–opening feeling. It was then that I realized that the energies behind these incredible Crop Circles were very benevolent and highly spiritually evolved.

I call this my "initiation," as it changed my life forever, and has enabled me to connect with this energy almost at will, expand my awareness, and embark on adventures I'd never dreamed of. During all my years of visiting the Crop Circles, I have never had this experience duplicated, although almost two years later, I did have a very similar experience when I was actually visited by the CircleMakers in California when they left me my "personal gift." And at this time, it was interesting to observe my own reactions, which initially were ones of momentary disbelief, and then as if entering some kind of altered state that isolated me from rational thinking (like taking a photo to record it). Since it was in green wild oats, it wasn't long before the spring's warm sunshine would encourage the unharmed bent stalks to stand tall once more. I was completely awestruck, that time! It was another profound message for me, but so per-

sonal and private that I had to process the extremity of it all before I could even talk about it. It all had to do with the changes in my life, that at the time, needed to take place, and that had finally come about to enable me to clear the pathway to move on, and move forward.

#### But, back to England -

The first thing one is aware of in Crop Circle country is the overall pleasant feeling one gets from being there. Visually, the lush green and golden fields, the gentle, rolling hills, and the contented animals grazing in meadows give the feeling of a pastoral peacefulness of days gone by, when life moved at a much slower pace. In fact, we can truly immerse ourselves in this setting as we meander around the country lanes in search of the precious Circles. And we can continue this same feeling; whether it be visiting the formations in the early morning with the dew's crystal droplets shining brightly on standing stalks; or the heavy warmth of the midday sunshine emitting a stillness over the land; or the magic of an evening sunset coloring the skies. Taking time to sit, stand, or tread softly through the fields in silence, one becomes so much more aware of all the wonderful gifts of Nature, and the subtle differences between each moment in time - like the smell of the dampness of dawn compared to the warmth of the wheat under the sun; or indeed, the early summer's aliveness compared to the laid back feeling that occurs later on.

Of course, all of these experiences are very healing to one's whole being, as are most of the feelings one gets from being inside of the formations, themselves. Whether it is from sitting, quietly meditating alone or in a larger group, or sharing experiences with others in the Circles, a sense of contentment comes over you. The Circles are such wonderful meeting places where many a friendship has been struck with a complete stranger, or been rekindled with a friend seldom seen.

In this magical domain, even when one is by one's self, there is the distinct feeling of never being alone. I personally have never found it to be uncomfortable in any way. Maybe my own belief that an Angelic presence is with me at all times has a lot to do with it, as I have called upon their assistance on many occasions to help me find hard to reach formations. I do know, however, that there seems to be a guiding Light behind all this wonderful weirdness. And I hope that those who have not, and maybe do not, get a chance to join those of us fortunate enough to immerse ourselves in these fields of mystery each year, will at least be touched in some way by the messages and photographs presented in this book, that share the mystery and magic The Circles bring to us.






## BEAUTY

#### GRATITUDE





### LETTING GO/RELEASE

Required at both the beginning and the end of our Crop Circle experience, letting go and releasing is a paramount lesson given to us by the CircleMakers.

The first thing we have to let go of, is our preconceived ideas and existing beliefs about the phenomena, as we go deeper into our exploration of the mystery. And the last thing we have to let go of, is our attachment to the Crop Circles, themselves. With the ripening of the crop, and the eventual harvest at the end of the season, the beautiful images disappear; first of all, as the formation is cut, and then completely, as the ground is ploughed for its wintering. Much as we would love to be able to have a constant, living visual image of these precious designs, we have to eventually let go, creating space for a new opening and the next step of the journey.

An extremely important lesson at this time is the importance of releasing the things that don't serve us anymore — whether it be a job, a relationship, an idea, or a concept. 


The CircleMakers certainly seem to respect us and the spaces that they utilize for their artwork.






The CircleMakers manage to put us in a state of trust each year – a trust that they will return with the gifts of their images in the fields once more.

# TRUTH AND INTEGRITY




# UNITY


The wisdom that is gleaned from the Crop Circles is not the kind of understanding that comes from knowledge of the mind, but of a deeper kind – through the heart.

More and more research involving harmonics is also being documented – and on and on.
