Please fill out this blank with directions how to send the goods, whether by freight, express, parcel post or mail, also giving postoffice address (the street and number, if any), county and state. Never omit to use the prefix Mrs. or Miss.

Every order sent us is accepted with the understanding that if the goods we send you are not found satisfactory on arrival; they may be immediately returned to us (unless specially made or engraved to order) and we will refund the money on receipt without argument or delay.

Should you have occasion to send us goods, write your name and address plainly on the outside of the package. Let letter of advice with explanation follow separately, so that we can give the matter our prompt attention immediately upon receipt.

We cannot exchange or refund the money on articles which have been engraved

or specially made to order.

When customer does not have an account with us remittances should accompany the order by postal money order, personal check, bank draft drawn on Chicago, New York, or St. Louis exchange or express money order. United States postage stamps, when in perfect condition, will be accepted as cash.

Make all checks, drafts or money orders payable to C. D. Peacock, Inc.

We will ship C. O. D. by express any article priced at over \$3.00, and amount may be paid at express office after goods are examined and found satisfactory. We also ship goods C. O. D. by parcel post, but such goods cannot be examined before accepting same as the postal regulations do not permit this. If goods so sent are not entirely satisfactory, return at once at our expense and money will be promptly refunded. When articles desired sent C.O.D. are to be engraved or are bulky a remittance of 25 per cent or one-fourth the amount should accompany the order as evidence of good faith, and such amount will be deducted from bill.

We are always glad to open accounts with those furnishing satisfactory references, such as your banker, where you have a checking account, or mercantile

houses where you have a charge account.

The prices in this catalogue are net cash and bills on open charge accounts are due in 30 days without discount. We do not sell our merchandise on the installment plan or monthly payments.

On watches, diamond jewelry, wedding rings, medals and loving cups we will

engrave free of charge any customary lettering.

On solid silverware, plated ware, spoons, gold and silver novelties, umbrellas and canes, priced at \$1.00 or over, we will engrave three initials or monogram free of charge.

We prepay mail, express and freight charges anywhere on all merchandise excepting Trunks. These are shipped express collect or freight collect as the pur-chaser desires. We also guarantee without charge the safe delivery of all orders to our customers.

When goods are to be sent by express or freight and there is no express or freight office in your town, state the nearest express or freight office to which you wish us to ship the goods.

On very large or very heavy articles that cannot be sent by parcel post, we reserve the right to ship same to your nearest express or freight office

If away from home when ordering goods, please state permanent address. We allow full value of old gold and old silver in exchange for other goods. all old jewelry (solid gold or silver—not plated) to us and we will notify you by return mail of its value. Be sure to put your name and address on the wrapper and send letter separately or in package.

Watches and jewelry to be repaired may be sent at our expense. Be sure to place name and address plainly written either on the outside or inside of pack-

age, and notify us by letter or postal at the time the goods are sent.

Mail orders are filled the day received — there is no delay. We carry in stock in our store every item listed in this catalogue with the exception of those few items which are made specially to order. Thus we are enabled to fill mail orders


