



Introductory Note.

helonging to Captain Timins, of Cairo, number about five hundred and eighty specimens. They have for the most part been bought in Cairo itself, but their provenance is mainly the Eastern Delta and Upper Egypt. In forming the collection Captain Timins has always kept in view the historic, as well as the artistic, side of this glyptic art. Many specimens are the finest examples of glazed steatite known, and from an historical point of view several specimens are unique.

The most ancient objects in the Collection are, of course, the Cylinder-shaped seals. Of these there are four (Plate I, Nos. 1-4), dating from the Prehistoric period down to the Second Dynasty. Of the Fourth Dynasty there is a good example (Plate I, No. 5) of Kha-ef-ra (Khephren, the builder of the second Pyramid at Gizeh); of the Fifth Dynasty there are examples of Nefer-ar-ka-ra (Plate I, No. 6) and Ded-ka-ra (Plate XXI, No. 21); and the Sixth Dynasty is represented by a finely cut specimen of Mery-ra (Plate XXI, No. 15). The series of Twelfth Dynasty cylinder seals includes two (Plate I, Nos. 8, 9) of Amenembat II (one naming an otherwise unknown Princess Neb-en), one of Senusret III (Plate I, No. 10), and two of Amenemhat III (Plate I, Nos. 11, 12). A small cylinder seal of the Thirteenth Dynasty (Plate I,

No. 13) gives the Golden Horus Name—Se-kha-en-Ptah—of a king hitherto unrecorded. Another (Plate I, No. 14) is of Khu-taui-ra, the founder of the Thirteenth Dynasty. Two specimens (Plate II, Nos. 16, 17) may be attributed to the Hyksos Period. Of the Eighteenth Dynasty there are two fine examples of Queen Aahmes-nefret-ari (Plate II, Nos. 18, 19), wife of Aahmas I, the King who expelled the Hyksos invaders; and one of Thotmes III (Plate II, No. 21).

The Button and Stamp-shaped seals are important; they date from the end of the Old Kingdom to the rise of the Middle Kingdom (about B.C. 2500-2000). Three examples are unique. No. 20 (Plate II) is a splendid specimen of cutting in the round, and may be compared with the Cat- and Cow-seals of the Eleventh Dynasty. The Ibex-headed seal (Plate III, No. 28) and the Pyramidal seal (Plate III, No. 27) are also interesting specimens of this little known period. Of the Button-shaped seals Nos. 23 and 24 (Plate II) are important for comparison with No. 20 (Plate II). No. 25 (Plate II) is of rock crystal finely cut. No. 26 (Plate III) is of the Twelfth or Thirteenth Dynasty.

Of the Pyramid-building Kings there are several Scarab-shaped seals (Plate IV, Nos. 29-34), but none of these can be considered contemporary with the Kings whose names they bear. The example of Khufu (No. 29) is certainly of the Eighteenth Dynasty, and the other five may be later still.

Royal scarabs of the Twelfth Dynasty are always rare, but there are five in this Collection, including a beautiful specimen (Plate IV, No. 36) of Amenemhat

III. The examples of Kha-ka-ra (Senusret III) figured in Plate VI (Nos. 89 and 91) date only from the Twenty-fourth Dynasty.

The Thirteenth Dynasty is represented by Khanefer-ra Sebekhetep (Plate IV, Nos. 41, 43 and 44), by Sekhem-se-uaz-taui-ra Sebekhetep (Plate IV, No. 46), Kha-seshes-ra Neferhetep (Plate IV, No. 47) and Queen Ana (Plate IV, No. 48). Sebak(?)-ka-ra (Plate IV, No. 50) is only otherwise known from three cylinder seals, and may belong to this period.

Of the Hyksos Kings there are several very interesting specimens. Six are of Shesha (Plate IV, Nos. 52-56, and Plate XXI, No. 1) and one curious example giving the name Pepŷ, probably an error for Shesha. Khyan, the King whose name has been found on objects from Crete, Babylonia, Palestine and Egypt, is represented by one specimen (Plate IV, No. 57), and there are also examples of Kha-user-ra (Plate IV, No. 58), Maa-ab-ra (Plate V, Nos. 59-68), Se-kha-en-ra (Plate V, Nos. 62 and 63) as well as a splendid specimen of Yabek-her (Plate XXI, No. 7). Of the Hyksos officials there are two examples of the Chancellor Har (Plate V, Nos. 68, 69) and four of the Chancellor Per-em-uah (Plate V, Nos. 64-67).

A unique specimen bearing the name of a Prince Antef (Plate VI, Nos. 87, 88) clearly belongs to the Intermediate period between the end of the Twelfth and the beginning of the Eighteenth Dynasty, and is important as proving that there were Antefs belonging to the Royal family at this time. Nefer-ankh-ra (Plate IV, No. 49, and Plate VI, No. 90) probably also belongs to this period.

The Eighteenth Dynasty is represented by scarabs

of Amenophis I (Plate VI, No. 93) and his mother, Queen Nefret-ari (Plate VI, No. 96). Of Thotmes I there are five specimens (Plate VI, Nos. 99-103), including a very fine one (No. 100) showing the King as a falcon seizing his enemies. A unique example of Hatshapsût and Thotmes III (Plate VI, No. 104) bears also the cartouch of Mena (the earliest known instance of the name of the Founder of Monarchy so Maat-ka-ra Hatshepsût, the famous Queen of the Temple of Dêr el Bahari is represented by seven specimens (Plate VI, Nos. 105-113). names of two other Princesses of the Early Eighteenth Dynasty are also found in this Collection—Bakt-amen (Plate V, No. 108) and Meryt-nub (Plate IX, No. 2). There are over fifty examples of scarab-shaped seals and plaques of Thotmes III, including three which give his nomen (Plate VII, Nos. 117, 125; Plate VIII, No. 16). Of Amenophis II there are three specimens (Plate IX, Nos. 8, 11, 12); of Thotmes IV, one (Plate IX, No. 9); of Amenophis III, seven (Plate IX, Nos. 10, 13, 15, 20, 25, 26, 27); and of Amenophis III, with Queen Thŷi, one (Plate IX, No. 16). A good example of the celebrated "Lionhunt" scarab, recording the number of lions killed by Amenophis III from the first to the tenth year of his reign is also preserved in this Collection (Plate XXI). Amenophis the third's son (Akh-en-aten), is represented by a small gold scarab (Plate IX, No. 14), by rings of silver (Plate IX, No. 23), of bronze (Plate IX, No. 21), and of blue glazed faience (Plate IX, No. 19); the latter is the finest specimen of its kind that I have seen. The faience bezel of Se-menkhka-ra Zeser-kheperu (Plate IX, No. 24) is well

preserved, and consequently important as giving a clear reading of the name of this heretic son-in-law of Akh-en-aten. Of the Nineteenth Dynasty there are two specimens of Hor-em-heb (Plate X, Nos. 1 and 2); one of Rameses I (Plate X, No. 3); one of Setŷ I (Plate X, No. 4); more than a dozen of Rameses II (Plate X, No. 5; Plate XI, Nos. 1–11, 13, 17, 19, 20); three of Setŷ II, Merenptah (Plate X, Nos. 7, 18; Plate XI, No. 14); and two of Siptah (Plate X, Nos. 11 and 12).

Of the Twentieth Dynasty, there are three examples of Rameses III (Plate X, No. 6; Plate XI, Nos. 12 and 15), one of which (Plate XI, No. 12) is a splendid specimen of glyptic art and glazing, the back, in low relief, representing the King slaying a lion with human-head portraying a bearded Syrian.

The Twenty-first Dynasty is represented by a single specimen of Men-kheper-ra's Queen, Ast-em-kheb (Plate XXI, No. 20), an exceedingly rare scarab, only one other being known of this Queen.

Of the Twenty-second Dynasty there are two specimens of Sheshank I (Plate X, No. 14; Plate XXI, No. 5), and two others (Plate X, Nos. 15 and 24), which are probably of the same date.

Of the later Kings there are two of Nekau (Plate X, Nos. 21 and 22) and three of Psamtek I (Plate X, Nos. 19 and 23; Plate XXI, No. 11), one of which is cut in hæmatite.

The series of Scarab-shaped seals of officials of the 12th to 18th Dynasties is important. The specimens figured in Plate XXI, No. 10, belongs to the early Twelfth Dynasty, and is one of the earliest private scarabs known; it is cut in a hard yellow stone.

No. 77 of Plate V is interesting as giving the De hetep Seten formula to Min, Lord of Ekhmîm. Another names a Chancellor, Neb-re-seh (Plate V, No. 75), who is known from four other specimens in various collections; four name women (Plate V, No. 70; Plate VI, Nos. 83-85); three are of Chief Stewards (Plate V, Nos. 74, 76; Plate XXI, No. 8), one of a Steward (Plate XXI, No. 3), and one of a Steward of the accounts of cattle (Plate V, No 71). Others name a wakîl of the Chancellor (Plate V, No. 79), a Superintendent of the Goldworkers (Plate V, No. 80), a poulterer (Plate XXI, No. 4).

Of the Eighteenth Dynasty there is a scarab of a scribe (Plate VI, No. 95), and one of "A Fan-bearer on the right of the King" (Plate XXI, No. 14). The specimen figured on Plate XXI, No. 13, is of a High Priest of Thoth, of the Twenty-sixth Dynasty, and one of the latest private scarabs known. No. 27 (Plate X) is of a Priest of Amen of the same period.

The remaining Scarab-shaped seals may be divided into various groups. Some of them name Deities (Plate XV, 5, 10, &c); others bear Royal titles (e.g., Plate X, 32, &c). Many give Good Wishes, such as "A Happy New Year" (Plate XXI, 1 and 2), "A Present from Karnak" (Plate XII, 5 and 6); "If Khonsu is behind, fear not" (Plate XII); "Khonsu as protection" (Plate XIII, 1), and similar legends. In many the hieroglyphic signs are symmetrically arranged, and have no apparent meaning (Plate XIX). A considerable number bear figures of Deities (Plate XVI), of Men (Plate XIV, 1, 7), and of Animals (Plate XIV, 2, &c.), or of Reptiles (Plate

XIV, 28). Some of the animals figured are beautifully delineated, especially the lion in Plate XIV, 2; the desert hare in No. 15 and the gazelle in No. 17.

At least seventy specimens in this Collection bear simple decorative devices (Plate XVII and XVIII), and the scroll-patterns on many of them are very beautiful (note especially Plate XV, 25, and XVII, 31-34 and 39), showing wonderful accuracy of touch on the part of the ancient lapidaries. As examples of the Scarab-cutter's art it would be difficult to match in any public or private collection the specimen figured on Plate XX, 22, the back of which is decorated by a sphinx cut in relief with a lotus and papyrus flower issuing from its back. The example of Rameses described above shows also surprising skill on the part of the lapidary, and the quality, colour, and laying on of the glaze of Nos. 7 and 19 of Plate IX is unsurpassed, if not unequalled, by any other ancient scarab that I have seen.

In the descriptions of the Plates I have confined myself to giving a brief description of the base of each specimen, together with notes of the material, colour of the glaze and approximate date. All the drawings of the specimens I have made myself, and they are reproduced full-size.


