

what it is


Engineering the Impossible is designed for all members of staff and senior management in organisations large and small. It is a combination of training, group workshops and personal advice sessions.

module I: perceiving the possible


Enables you to see many more alternatives and possibilities for yourself and your organisation. Helps you decide which changes to adopt and kick starts the process of making those changes happen.

module 2: generating possibilities on demand


Reawakens your natural creativity and develops it using pragmatic techniques so that you can generate new ideas and alternatives whenever you need them.

module 3: turning possibilities into reality


Explores practical ways to become more innovative and how to develop this ability in teams and organisations. Explains how to make your ideas become reality.

module 4: making the impossible possible


Looks again at vision and with the experience of the previous modules guides you to establishing new visions for the individual; for groups; and the organisation.
