Dear Mr. Hoover;

Perhaps you are now wishing that you had gotten out a little earlier, because a year ago many people still respected the FBI. Today, the criticisms by Mr. Eaton, the shameful attempt to railroad five innocent boys to the electric chair, and the harassment and intimidation of helpless citizens causes most Americans to spit and slam the door in the faces of your agents.

Atlanta was your Waterloo, Mr. Hoover. The AntiDefamation League took you to the oats once too often, and you only got a mouthful of sawdust.

I have wondered how you recruit your agents. Is this the sort of ad that is necessary?: WANTED: Men with spotty employment records, police rejects accepted. Should be dominating, treacherous, like easy money. Prefer man who can be trained as assassin, willing to shoot people in the back. What happened to the Boys Town that Mr. Murchison and Mr. Richardson were going to fix up for you? Many people have asked me about that. I had nothing to do with it falling through. Of course one never knows how far or how fast one's quips may travel.

I am serene in the Love of Jesus Christ, and I can only wonder at the moral chaos which must engulf a man like you, who can, at the behest of forces which you do not care to reveal, order the persecution of five innocents with the aim of electrocuting them for a crime when there is no evidence against them. But I forget. In Soviet Russia evidence is not necessary. I have not heard whether you took your training in Moscow with Mr. Reuther, and you do not have to answer that now. However, I have devoted my life to fighting Communism and Communist secret police, and whether you spend \$100,000 or \$1,000,000 of the taxpayer's money to harass me, I will continue to do so.

To show you that I bear you no hard feelings, I will offer you some advice. You know too much to suit the fellows you have been carrying water for, and your period of usefulness seems to have come to an end, so be careful of any open windows a la Duggan or Forrestal. As you know, secret police chiefs are usually taken care of, not by the people whom they persecute, but by the men they work for. The helpless American citizens whom your men have been hounding will not strike at you, but just as Mr. Roosevelt faltered in his support of Zionism and was found dead in his chair, so your bosses are apt to have a meeting and decide to "retire" you.

Dear Mr. Hoover;

I am asking for a Congressional investigation of the fact that your agents in relays have been following me and watching my apartment for the past eight months, tapping my telephone until I had it disconnected, and harassing my neighbors. This expenditure amounts to well over \$100,000, and was completely unnecessary, as you know that I have always cooperated with you, as witness my numerous letters to you and offers of assistance which have never been answered.

The harassment of your agents was a factor in my being discharged from my post as public relations counsel for the Chicago Motor Club, and for the fact that I have been unable to obtain employment since that time. In October, while your agents were watching me mail the letter, I wrote offering a solution to the bombing of the synagogue in Atlanta, but your agents preferred to take to railroad five innocent boys to the electric chair on the evidence of a perjurer and a lifelong criminal, circumstances and evidence at that, when the strongest circumstantial evidence pointed to those who amassed one million dollars as a result of the bombing.

When I left the Motor Club building last July, my employees informed me that Federal agents were waiting in the lobby to arrest me. Since I have quite a few things I would like to make public through the medium of a grand jury, particularly concerning your personal reasons for this harassment, I have been waiting for these agents ever since. Or is it possible, Mr. Hoover, that they prefer to choose an opportune moment for assassination, rather than have me on trial? I live only a short distance from the spot where eight of your brave men, armed with submachine guns, mowed down Mr. Dillinger from ambush in one of the great sagas of FBI heroism.

Meanwhile, I should like to put a few personal questions to you. Is it true that you are a secret convert to Judaism? Why are light-colored mulatto agents, members of the NAACP, being sent by the FBI into the South to enforce integration, representing themselves as white? Are you unduly concerned over the fact that I know persons who knew you in your early days in Washington? Since I have devoted ten years, sacrificed my career and my fortune, to expose Communist infiltration in the United States, why are you and your agents desperately trying to stop me from continuing those efforts? These are only a few of the matters which I hope to make public in the next few weeks.

The New Man in Our Image

EUSTACE MULLINS

(A speech given, October 14, 1958, before the Student Forum for Dissent, at the University of Illinois, Channing-Murray Foundation, 1209 W. Oregon St., in Urbana.)

EXAMINING the broad stream of humanity which now sweeps over the earth, one asks, "Where did it come from? Where is it going? What are its elements?"

The drive of living organisms for a fulfilled existence takes many forms. The more predatory of these swallows the others at their pleasure.

We see parts of the human stream rushing blindly to suicide, like lemmings leaping into the sea; other parts advancing, like hordes of soldier ants, devouring everything in sight and leaving only devastation behind them; still others existing in torpor, like alligators lying half-hidden in black swamp water.

And in this stream, we see yet another group, one which may be likened to the beaver, as it steadily builds and rebuilds, despite the onslaught of natural enemies and calamities. It is with this group that we are concerned. The advance of science has created a new atmosphere—it is creating a new type of mankind. This new man must be built from the constructive element of humanity. He must not be contaminated by admixtures with the other types which we have described.

The new man needs all the resources of the earth, for he is faced with a tremendous task, the generation of ever-increasing amounts of energy. In the fact of this task, human existence cannot be thought of as a right for anyone. It is a privilege, conditional upon one's contribution to the generation of energy.

At the present time, humanity stands above all other animate beings because of its response to the challenges of existence. And of all human groups, Western man is the most diversified in his response. He has become pre-eminent in the generation of energy—what might indeed be called the creation of energy, now that it is being produced from hitherto unsuspected sources. Western man must be realistic about his position, as other groups, unable to generate energy, sink back into the lassitude of the Devonian Age.

One hundred thousand years ago, in the Wurm glaciation period of the Quaternary Cycle, a new race, the Cro-Magnon, appeared in Europe. Because he needed the temperate zone as the most appropriate climate in which to develop, he ruthlessly slaughtered his predecessor, Neanderthal man, who disappeared from that region. Thus Western civilization began, for Cro-Magnon was the prototype of Western man.

Throughout history, mankind has progressed in the same manner, by attacking more backward types. Each type rises by kicking the one immediately below it.

The Chinese pagoda symbolizes the fact that one approaches Heaven by stages, rather than in a single leap, as the Gothic cathedral proclaims. Even as Africans hunted the great apes, so the Greeks and the Romans made war upon the primitive types around them.

In the call of race, the selective agency at work has been the power to create energy. Today, the ratio of man to his instruments of power is greater than ever before. Each individual in Western civilization has at his fingertips more power than one hundred kings of the Golden Age of Greece could summon to their aid. Yet this progress has been achieved by the development, and sacrifice, of only a few of our kind. Why should we not feel guilty each time we start an automobile engine or switch on an electric light, if we are failing to do our part in advancing the race?

Now mankind stands on the threshold of the first great forward step in human evolution since the Cro-Magnon exterminated the Neanderthal. It is a step which need not be taken because of the blind instinct for survival, as Cro-Magnon, feeling the cold of the glacier at his back, exterminated the Neanderthal. Rather, this next step in human evolution should be taken as a conscious effort on man's part to improve himself, moved to this action by his knowledge of science, history, and human potentialities.

Sir Arthur Keith, the most important anthropologist of our time, tells us that in the Pleistocene Age, the races of mankind were developing at the same pace. The jaws and teeth receded, and the brain space became enlarged. Thus the Proto-Cro-Magnon, the Proto-Mongol, and the Proto-Negro at this stage were equal, just as the liberals tell us. However, of the three, only Cro-Magnon continued to develop his capabilities. The other groups, instead of progressing, became retrogressive, and ceased to improve their lot. These groups now stand, not only as a barrier to the accelerated progress of Western man, but as a vast threat to his continued existence.

Since each race has developed its own rationale, mankind today is bewildered by appeals from various creeds—the philosophy of service of Western man, the philosophy of slavery of the Asiatic, and the philosophy of inertia of the African.

To develop his own potentialities, Western man must survive on the principle of individual freedom, as well as obtaining sufficient natural resources to carry out his program. Yet many of these resources are in the lands of retrogressive peoples, who, although they have been cultivating this ground without ever knowing these resources were there or what to do with them, still resent Western man's use of them. They raise the cry of exploitation, as though the ruler of the

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Bantu had just been intending to build a steel mill when an English firm came to take out the iron ore.

The urge to freedom is the urge of the group to work out its own evolutionary destiny. The retrogressive types wish freedom just as avidly as does Western man, but for them freedom means the right to exist in barbarism, the liberty to continue the practice of cannibalism, voodoo, and suttee, while Western man wants freedom to advance science and promote the welfare of his race. In order to secure this freedom, Western man must claim the primary right to exist, and all who threaten that right must disappear. His wish to work out his evolutionary destiny today is threatened by the ecological strain of almost two billion of the colored masses.

Homer Lea points out that this is the Age of Convergence of Cultures. Differences of groups which go back to the Dawn of Man must now be settled for all time. We must choose between a world jungle and a world civilization. The only way Western man could aid the retrogressive types to improve themselves, since they have failed to work out their evolutionary destiny, would be to intermarry with them and give them his genes. These genes would, of course, be swallowed up and have virtually no effect in the vast mass of the colored world.

The antagonisms and tensions set up in the overcrowded world of today, in which the convergent cultures impinge upon one another as the burgeoning colored masses restlessly push against the frontiers of Western man, are intolerable. These conditions must be eliminated.

Because race offers the only amelioration of the human condition, the new man need not concern himself with any other consideration. He stands on the threshold of a new age, in which each individual will be able to deliver great contributions to the generation of energy. As Spengler has pointed out, what the individual will not do, that History will do with him. The living organism is capable of assimilating much foreign matter, but after a point of saturation has been reached, it must purify itself or perish. We have now reached that point. The continuing crisis in man's evolution must be relieved; Western man will surpass it or go to his doom.

The imminence, as well as the necessity, of the next step in the evolution of man has caused some uneasiness. We hear much about the rights of the several races, without any regard for the place which each occupies on the evolutionary scale. Nothing can be done for those groups which continue to exist in stagnation. The animal-like existence of the colored world is a mockery of human potentialities. Western man will either terminate that existence or he himself will be swallowed up by it. We are confident that his instinct of survival will direct him to the correct choice.

Future generations will marvel at our hesitancy to

take this step. Everything now belongs to the most advanced group. The recriminations which we hear from the more indecisive elements of Western civilization, as well as their illogical efforts to "protect" the increasing colored masses, will be the subjects of curious studies by scholars during the next century.

Life, that is, thought and action, can be considered only in terms of force and energy. Historical movements are phases of cosmic dynamics, in which persistent and inherited genes work out their timeless patterns through the actions of men. The aim of life, after all, is a deeper experience of life, and Western man has carried that exploration further than has any other man.

The continual demand for a greater generation of energy, as well as the accelerating power placed in the hands of Western man, combine to produce the new type of man which he will become. He is a man who is not ruled by or at the mercy of his immediate physical needs, since those have been taken care of by the store of power which he controls. As M. Koehl has pointed out in his poem, "Credo":

"I worship the Thing that comes beyond Agony."

The new man, too, comes from Beyond Agony. That is, he is not ruled by personal gratification. After all, any ground-ape can gratify his five senses.

And yet, the new man's society will not be a cold, mechanical one, as some might suppose. The aesthetic of a group inevitably grows out of its organic life, and the society of the new man will be one with a heightened appreciation of the fine arts, as described by Piet Mondrian, in his work, "Le Neo-Plasticisme", published in 1932:

In the vital reality of the abstract, the new man has gone beyond the sensation of joy, ravishment, pain, and horror. Constantly moved by beauty, these sensations have been purified and deepened. The new man has achieved a deeper vision of sentient reality. Things are beautiful or ugly only in time and space. The vision of the new man has liberated itself from these two principles and is united in a single beauty.

It was this credo which gave rise to the most important advance in modern painting, before it was obscured by the charlatanism of Picasso. How much more impressive is Mondrian's description of the new man, with his heightened appreciation of beauty, as compared with the sordid activities of the high priest of liberalism, Dr. Albert Schweitzer, who prefers picking scabs off of black bottoms in Africa to playing Bach in the cathedrals of Europe! This compulsion to wallow in the muck, this cult of ugliness, this urge to retrogression and racial suicide, is the result of an Eastern emotionalism which has poisoned much of Western thought. However, it has no effect on the new man.

The task of the new man is not to preserve or to increase life but to call it. He has little cause to fear the gods, for he can cast a greater bolt than the legendary

Thor; he can exterminate larger hosts than the vengeful Jehovah. The traditional role of religion, the amelioration of the human condition, is swept away by its inability to ameliorate that condition, while, race, which can and will change the shape of mankind, becomes the dominant force in the world. The higher morality, that is, the intent to solve man's problems on earth instead of leaving them to heaven, will rule the actions of men.

Before taking any physical action, one should ask, "What is the physical result to be attained by taking this action?" The physical result of Western man's elimination of retrogressive types will be: first, the mechanical physics of his genes will attain freedom in which to develop themselves according to their inexorable pattern; second, he removes the threat of his own extinction at the hands of the prolific colored masses.

What if this step is not taken? Cannot Western man continue to develop his physical sciences and leave the colored masses to welter in their misery? The modern world cannot tolerate this condition. It cannot go on, half Ape and half Man.

In the history of mankind, many gods have died. Now, at long last, the God of the Apes passes away, and in his place arises the God of Man.

The museum types of mankind still in existence will join their stuffed predecessors in the rooms of the fossils. So long as they exist, mankind is still living in the Age of the Great Apes. The Age of Man beckons to us. Those types which have failed in the call of race must and will disappear. We will write a new chapter in the saga of our species, for history is always written by the slayers, never by the slain.

Sir Arthur Keith points out that all human types developed during long periods of isolation from other types. The mass migrations supposed by earlier anthropologists never took place; the so-called nomads actually moved within clearly prescribed limits.

Today, the improvement of communications makes it impossible for the various human groups to avoid intermingling on a social level. The principle of segregation breeds only more misery and increases racial antagonisms. The world capitals of today are like a series of country villages of yesterday. The caste system of India, a desperate attempt of the white blood to preserve itself there, has been unsuccessful. Nowhere can the white man preserve himself from contamination by the colored masses. There is no place to hide.

Civilization is aggression. Lesser types have to be forced to abandon their animal-like existence. In his novel, "The Princess Casamassima", Henry James says of his hero in Venice, "The fabric of civilization as we know it is inextricably bound up with injustice; the monuments of art and living and taste have been reared upon coercive power."

Yet Western man today is living in a state of schizophrenia. His healthy predatory instincts are repressed as he toils to bring the benefits of his higher civilization to the colored masses. Endlessly he labors to provide flush toilets for the Zulus and automobiles for the Watusi. As his leaders mouth the platitude that all life is of equal value, Western man's skill is harnessed to build huge apartment dwellings for Negroes, which deteriorate into slums within a period of weeks.

His gifts of medicine provide new impetus for the teeming colored masses, who formerly depended upon the selective processes of contaminated water and disease carrying insects to keep their numbers within their means of support. Our leaders tell us that we are working to save life. But life cannot be saved, it can only be prolonged, and for what end?

When a Negro rapes a white woman, he is only expressing the futility of his existence. This aggression is a dumb appeal for his extermination. Twenty thousand years of squatting in misery in Africa, as well as a few centuries of secondary status in Western civilization, have come to an end. The world commands, and we obey.

T. S. Eliot supposed that the world would end, not with a bang, but with a whimper. This would be the case if Western man allowed himself to sink in apathy before the steady but ruthless expansion of the colored peoples. The physics of his genes would soon disappear into the shambling brute existence of the retrogressive types.

However, Western man is under pressures which will not allow him to surrender in this fashion. He has been forged into an instrument which will be used. The surrealist artist Francis Picabia said, "The internal and the external are like a form of torture." This is true for the new man. The demands which his god, Life, makes upon him are so terrible that his existence is like a scream echoing through timeless space.

Recent studies of cells show that pressure changes them, and that such pressures have brought about many of the important advances in organisms. It is now thought that growing sensitivity to water pressure may have urged some forms of life to crawl onto the land, predicting the human organism. Pressure increases the gel state of protoplasm, and in this state it has the power of contraction. This contractility enables the cell to change shape and move.

Western man today is under great pressure, not only to accelerate his advance but also to protect his gains from retrogressive types. More than mere survival is at stake here. All that man has won in his ages-old struggle with his environment now hangs in the balance.

The period of man's existence is but the space of a breath in the life history of the earth. Consequently, we cannot say that we have arrived at a permanent plateau of development, but it is clear that we can

retrogress at any time. We have perceived the challenge flung down to us. We must make the most determined effort to improve the race throughout the entire world. A pioneering crusade to clear the continents of vast areas of decaying life will create the atmosphere in which we can continue to grow.

Just as race offers the only escape from the human condition, so the improvement of man is limited by the physical body in which the intelligence is enclosed. The Greeks understood this 2,000 years ago, when they set about improving their bodies simultaneously with their minds. As a healthy mind in a healthy body has little need for witch-doctors, the priesthood returned scholarship to the weakly and the corrupt.

Long ago, it was understood that some day the world must become one, and that mankind must become one. The uneven development of the races today, with their increased proximity, is creating world chaos. Who does not wish to see this problem solved, and world peace come to man? By making the genes of the most advanced group the norm, unrest disappears.

What opposition can the colored masses raise against this solution? None. First of all, they recognize the justice of it. Second, their leaders have been trained in Western schools, and have lost contact with their people, so that there are really no leaders in the colored world. The colored masses will accept the verdict of history without protest, as they have always accepted it.

In this crusade, one well may ask, what will be the attitude of Russia? Russia is still the simple peasant of the nations, unable to find a place for herself in Western civilization. Therefore, she continues to har-

vest the meager but certain crop of agitation among the colored masses. But already the Russian leaders see their danger, as the ecological strain of a billion Asiatics threatens the home port of Communism. With first-hand experience in the impossibility of bringing civilization to the backward peoples, Russia will be glad to join us.

The leadership for this crusade is endemic in the nature of Western man. The predatory instincts of his masses on the plains of the United States, the Russian steppes, and the West European nations await only the word to be unleashed against their historic enemies. Already they rage in their genetic power houses, ready for the task of building the only kind of world in which they can exist.

Because human groups can no longer be isolated from each other during their development, the struggle for supremacy, now inevitable, must be a battle to the death. This means unquestioning obedience to the leaders. After all, the task of a leader is not to shower gifts upon the masses, as the degenerate Romans thought, but rather to improve them by making ever-greater demands of them, and by accelerating the selective agencies which advance them.

We approach our destiny, conscious that it is so perfectly conceived within us as to be humanity's only possible future.

Letters have been received from Eustace Mullins, Jr., dated 2-21-59, 2-22-59 and 2-23-59. These letters allege that Agents have been following Mullins in relays, tapping his telephone, etc., and that the harassment of the Agents was a factor in his being discharged from his position with the Chicago Motor Club. He engages in a tirade against the Director, the Bureau and the investigation of the Atlanta bombing case and states that he is asking for a Congressional investigation because of the Bureau's investigation of him.

Attached to the letter of 2-22-59 is a printed document captioned, "~~The~~ New Man in Our Image," which purports to be a speech given by Eustace Mullins, Jr. on 10-14-58 before the Student Forum for Dissent, at the University of Illinois, Channing-Murray Foundation, Urbana, Illinois. The theme of the speech is that the Western white man, if he were to intermingle with other races, would be lost in the blood stream of the Negro and Mongol races. The alternative proposed by Mullins is a crusade apparently to eliminate the "colored masses." It is stated that the predatory instincts of the Western man await only the word to be unleashed against their enemies.

Mullins, who is alleged to be a homosexual, is a violent anti-Semite and has written a considerable amount of anti-Semitic propaganda. He has previously written and distributed derogatory comments concerning the Bureau and prior correspondence to the Bureau has not been acknowledged. He is currently the subject of a racial matters investigation; however, only normal investigative techniques have been used. His telephone has not been tapped. He was discharged from his position with the Chicago Motor Club on 7-31-58 for alleged anti-Semitic activities. He subsequently filed a damage suit against the Chicago Motor Club for \$250,000. However, the complaint was dismissed by the court which rendered a summary judgment in favor of the Chicago Motor Club.

In view of Mullins' background his letters are not being acknowledged. Copies are being forwarded the Chicago Office for their information.

The next report should set forth all information including that obtained from a review of material presently in your files which indicates that Wilson advocates, condones, or incites to violence for the purpose of denying others their constitutional rights. In view of Wilson's character and background, no acknowledgment is being made of his letters.

In Richmond case 140-405, captioned "R. WALLACE ROSEN, Postmaster, P. O. Department, Staunton, Virginia, SGE", a preliminary investigation was conducted on the basis of an anonymous letter dated January 4, 1956, post-marked Milwaukee, Wisconsin, which identified a Mr. ROSEN, Postmaster, Staunton, Virginia, as attending Communist Party Meetings in Alexandria, Virginia. This letter was signed, "A Repentant Communist."

During this investigation J. S. WHITLOCK, Post Office Inspector, Staunton, Virginia, reported that R. WALLACE ROSEN, Postmaster in Staunton, had during recent months, attempted to obtain information regarding the present address of EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, formerly of Staunton, for the Post Office Inspection Department, and in obtaining this information made MULLINS angry and MULLINS wrote to the Postmaster General and Congressman BURR HARRISON of Virginia, degrading ROSEN for his actions.

WHITLOCK stated that he knew EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, who formerly worked for the Library of Congress in Washington, D. C., and he considered him to be very eccentric. He advised he understood MULLINS is a prolific letter writer who takes great delight in being critical of people and government organizations.

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATIONEducationAt Lexington, Virginia

On January 29, 1959, Mrs. ELIZABETH BELL McCLUNG, Secretary to the Registrar, Washington and Lee University, advised that the University Records reflect that EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, JR., whose date of birth is listed as

March 9, 1923, and whose residence was carried as 331 North Lewis Street, Staunton, Virginia, matriculated at the University on April 8, 1946. He voluntarily withdrew January 29, 1948. Mrs. McCLUNG stated that MULLINS did not received a degree and that his academic grades were below the required C necessary to graduate or continue in this school. She stated because of his early withdrawal at the University, the records failed to reflect any additional information, but advised that no notations of a derogatory nature appeared other than below academic attainment.

Former Residence

At Staunton, Virginia

During investigation conducted in November, 1952, E. G. KYLE, Justice of the Peace for the City of Staunton, advised that EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, JR., has not resided at the home of his father for any length of time since approximately 1947, or since leaving Washington and Lee University. KYLE noted that MULLINS' father's address is 331 North Lewis Street, Staunton. KYLE further advised that MULLINS' brother, E. E. MULLINS, is the manager of a Kroger Grocery Store in Staunton and often discusses the activities of his brother.

According to KYLE, E. E. MULLINS related that his brother, as of October 6, 1952, was in New York City, and had sent his brother a book entitled, "Can the Police Protect Us?", which the brother claimed was written by a Major WILLIAMS. KYLE further advised that E. E. MULLINS related that his brother EUSTACE was starting a new campaign to expose the Communist in this country, however, he did not relate by what means he intended to carry out this work. KYLE further reported that E. E. MULLINSEadvised that his brother's address in New York is 526 East 6th Street, New York 9, New York.

KYLE declared that he has never heard anything that would reflect against the reliability or loyalty of EUSTACE MULLINS. He declared however, that due to the fact that EUSTACE MULLINS has spent very little time in Staunton since 1947, that very few people, if any, know of his activities.

Also during the prior investigation conducted in 1952, Captain R. R. CLINE of the Staunton, Virginia, Police Department advised that EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, JR., does not live in the Staunton area, but has visited with his father and brother on several occasions since attending college. He advised that EUSTACE MULLINS had impressed him as being a very intelligent young man despite the fact that he has apparently become a fanatic in writing about the Communists.

Criminal Record

On January 29, 1959, JOSEPH GOODBAR, Record Clerk, Lexington Police Department, Lexington, Virginia, advised that the records of that department failed to reflect any information identifiable with subject.

On January 30, 1959, a review of the Trial Justice Court Records for Rockbridge County, Lexington, Virginia, failed to reflect any information identifiable with the subject.

On February 3, 1959, Mrs. PEARL DURHAM, Clerk, Richmond Police Department, Richmond, Virginia, advised her files contained no record for the subject.

Credit

On January 30, 1959, Miss JUNE CARTER, Manager, Lexington and Buena Vista Credit Bureau, Lexington, Virginia, advised that a review of her files failed to reflect any information identifiable with subject.

On February 2, 1959, Miss MARGARET TATUM, Receptionist, Credit Bureau of Richmond, advised her files contained no record for the subject.

II. ACTIVITY

Mrs. JOHN R. APPLEWHITE, 950 North Hampton Drive, Silver Spring, Maryland, in September, 1951, made available pamphlets which were in the nature of Anti-Semitic literature. One folder purportedly published by the Aryan League of America, describes this organization as a non-profit educational association which publishes and distributes literature on racial and economic questions. Membership was offered at \$1.00.

The pamphlet stated further that forthcoming works were to include "Judas in the White House", "Who Owns America", and other "Documented Essays on Treason in America". It was indicated that all communications should be addressed to EUSTACE MULLINS, Director, Aryan League of America, 331 North Lewis Street, Staunton, Virginia.

One printed article in this literature was headed "Patriots Prepare Yourselves!", with the sub-heading "Jews Are Betraying Us". This article purportedly originated with the Aryan League of America and the American Policy Association.

On February 6, 1959, Miss EDNA GAY, Clerk, State Corporation Commission, Richmond, Virginia, advised that a review of her records failed to reflect any reference to the Aryan League of America or the American Policy Association.

On February 6, 1959, a review of the index maintained in the Virginia State Library, Richmond, Virginia, failed to reflect any reference to EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, JR., the Aryan League of America or the American Policy Association.

On August 20, 1954, Mr. HARRY L. SMITH, Office of Public Information, Virginia State Highway Department, 1221 East Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia, made available copies of several issues of "Common Sense" which were mailed to him from P. O. Box 807, Union, New Jersey. SMITH advised that he believed that EUSTACE MULLINS was the person responsible for mailing him copies of the publication as he noted that the June 15, 1954, and July 1, 1954, issues of "Common Sense" carried articles by EUSTACE MULLINS.

SMITH continued that he is acquainted with MULLINS having formerly worked for MULLINS' father at Staunton, Virginia. He advised that MULLINS is single, approximately 35 years of age and he has had spotty contacts with him since 1940. He advised that MULLINS was in the U. S. Army Air Corps and after World War II worked for a period of time in Washington, D. C., for the "Times Herald". He recalled that MULLINS went to Mexico to do some articles on Communist activities and that he spent a considerable amount of time in a small place just out of Mexico City.

SMITH continued that MULLINS also did a biography on ERZA POUND, however, he does not believe that this book was ever published.

SMITH recalled that while at Washington, D. C., MULLINS started one or two publications but did not make a go of them and approximately six or eight months ago he received a letter from MULLINS which was written on the stationery of the Petroleum Institute, New York City. He continued that in this last letter MULLINS stated that he has worked for Senator McCARTHY briefly and he commented in referring to McCARTHY that newspapers had succeeded in "making a man out of a shadow."

SMITH related that he did not know who was financing MULLINS in his operations and advised that this was the first time he had ever read any of his publications and he was surprised how rabid and biased the articles were. SMITH pointed out that included among the issues of "Common Sense" was a leaflet concerning "The Federal Reserve Conspiracy" which was written by MULLINS. This leaflet identified MULLINS as EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, born Roanoke,

Virginia, and educated at Washington and Lee. He was further identified as a veteran of the Army Air Force during World War II, "a contributor to many periodicals in the United States, Canada and England on political and economic problems. His articles have traced the devious connections of international banking and the international communist conspiracy". It further identified MULLINS as a former member of the staff of Library of Congress, a research assistant to members of Congress and now economist with the American Petroleum Institute.

"Common Sense" is a bi-monthly newspaper published by the Educational Association of Union, New Jersey.

Under date of December 17, 1954, the Committee on Un-American Activities of the United States House of Representatives published a "Preliminary Report on Neo-Fascists and Hate Groups" in which the growth, objectives and the editor of "Common Sense" are discussed at length. In this report "Common Sense" is described as a "Hate Group" vehicle, publishing some of the most vitriolic hate propaganda ever to come to the attention of the Committee." According to the report, "Common Sense" depicts Communism as "Judaism" and devotes its pages almost exclusively to attacks on the Jews and to a lesser extent, the Negro minority in the Nation. Sympathy for the former Nazi Regime in Germany is also in this propaganda.

On November 21, 1955, HARRY L. SMITH of the Virginia State Highway Department, made available a copy of "Women's Voice", Volume 14, Numbers 2 and 3, dated September and October, 1955, which he had received through the mail. SMITH advised that he believed that EUSTACE MULLINS was the person responsible for mailing him this copy as he noted on Page 1 MULLINS had an article in the publication entitled "Close the Public Schools". Also MULLINS had an article on Page 3 entitled "Behind the Murder of Eisenhower".

"Women's Voice", according to T-1, is the official publication of "We, the Mothers, Mobilize for America, Inc." That organization was originated in 1941, and maintains headquarters at 537 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois. The editor of "Women's Voice", Mrs. LYRE CLARK VAN HYNING, is responsible for the policy and views set forth in that organization.

Articles contained in "Women's Voice" are violently Anti-Eisenhower; Anti-Semitic, Anti-Masonic, Anti-Catholic, and opposed to all foreign elements in the United States.

one RICHARD ANTHONY SHIMKO of espionage and theft of Government property. The case file was opened on SHIMKO and Newark was made office of origin. SHIMKO was interviewed by Newark Agents on 10/13/49 and denied the allegation set forth by MULLINS. He stated he believed EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS was behind the allegation and that MULLINS had stated in a letter he would do anything to get SHIMKO.

Concerning the Institute of Contemporary Arts, it should be noted that an investigation was conducted by WFO in 1950 concerning this Institute when allegations were received that the Institute might have communist leanings (Institute of Contemporary Arts, aka Washington Institute of Contemporary Arts, IS - C, WFO file 100-22090).

Information was received that ROBERT GREEN, teacher and director of the school, spoke over radio station WQQW and made certain remarks about discrimination among the Negro race in the South as compared to non-discrimination in the North. The informant, at the time, was of the opinion that GREEN'S remarks were of such a nature as to indicate that GREEN was a communist or had communist leanings because he advocated nonsegregation and non-discrimination.

Information was also received from an informant of unknown reliability that the School was engaged in communist activities inasmuch as ROBERT GREEN during his lectures had mocked American customs and stated that the United States was settled by a "bunch of thieves." This informant also stated that GREEN taught abnormal sex activities in his classes as well as race fusion. This informant stated that the School, in the past, had taken part in political matters and during controversial issues, particularly in regard to the Mundt-Nixon bill, had its students send letters and telegrams to Congress, protesting that bill.

Confidential informants of known reliability, who were familiar with Communist Party activities, were checked during the investigation and they advised that they had no information indicating Communist Party activities on the part of the subject School or its officers.

DETAILS

I. CONNECTIONS WITH THE NATIONALIST PARTY (NP)
AND THE
NATIONAL RENAISSANCE PARTY (NRP)

NY T-1 advised on December 13, 1954 that a meeting of the United States NP was held on December 3, 1954 at Midston House, New York City. Among the speakers at this meeting was EUSTACE MULLINS who spoke regarding his book on the Federal Reserve system.

WEST HOOKER, 1 Overlook Terrace, Larchmont, New York, voluntarily appeared at the NYO of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) on March 8, 1955 and advised Special Agents JAMES P. MARTIN and EDWARD A. BRANDT that he had organized the US NP in the fall of 1954 as a political party and that he changed the name to the NP a few months later. HOOKER said that he hoped to organize a party powerful enough to act as a force between the two major parties. He said that it was his aim to force the Republican Party to the "right". HOOKER stated that his activities were also directed toward counteracting the propaganda produced by various Jewish organizations.

On April 11, 1955 NY T-1 advised that WEST HOOKER had recently purchased a mimeograph machine to be installed in the basement of his home at 1 Overlook Terrace, Larchmont, New York. NY T-1 said that HOOKER hoped to produce a bulletin for the NP and intended to utilize the writings of EUSTACE MULLINS.

On July 11, 1955 WEST HOOKER, made available one copy of Volume 1, issue #1 of the "Nationalist Party Bulletin". On Page 2 of this publication EUSTACE MULLINS was listed as a member of the National Committee.

On April 11, 1956 NY T-1 advised that among the five members of the Nationalist Youth League (NYL) whom he had heard about was EUSTACE MULLINS. According to NY T-1 EUSTACE MULLINS was a former member of the National Renaissance Party (NRP) and was then residing at 142 West 91st Street in New York City.

On July 2, 1956 NY T-1 advised that EUSTACE MULLINS had recently been doing a considerable amount of typing at the headquarters of the NP at East 83rd Street in New York City.

On Pages 5, 13, 14, and 27 of the "Preliminary Report on Neo-Fascist and Hate Groups" prepared and released by the Committee on Un-American Activities, United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C., dated December 17, 1954, EUSTACE MULLINS is mentioned as an associate of JAMES MADOLE in the NRP and as a staff writer of "Common Sense".

The "New York Daily News", March 6, 1956, contains an article captioned "He Poured Oil on the Arabs; Sues for 50Gs". In this article it was stated that EUSTACE C. MULLINS, 60 East Fourth Street, New York City, who claimed to have been cited "four times in a report of the House Un-American Activities Committee on Neo-Fascist Groups because of his work for the American Petroleum Industries Committee, is suing the Petroleum Committee for \$50,000 for breach of contract, it was disclosed yesterday". According to this article, MULLINS said he was formerly a special investigator for Senator MC CARTHY, a lecturer on Zionist Affairs and that he had prepared more than 100 articles on Zionist Affairs as well as speaking weekly at Yorkville street meetings of JAMES H. MADOLE's "ultra conservative organization, the National Renaissance Party, which later was cited by the House Un-American Activities Committee as Neo-Fascist."

II. MISCELLANEOUS

The May 4, 1955 issue of the "New York World Telegram and Sun", Page 1, Night Edition, contains an article

captioned, "New Bigots Spread Some Old Poison" by JACK STEELE, Scripps - Howard Staff Writer. This article, continued on Page 19, under caption, "Eustace Mullins" reflects the following:

"Mullins is a freelancer of hate, a Virginian in his early 30's, His articles have appeared since 1951 in "Common Sense and other hate sheets.

"In 1952 an article entitled, "Adolf Hitler; An Appreciation" appeared under his byline in the Bulletin of the National Renaissance Party, since branded by the Un-American Activities Committee as Neo-Fascist.

"He was active in the Aryan League of America, and is credited with the authorship of the 'Rabbi Rabinovich' canard - a modern version of the forged anti - Semitic Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion.

"Mullins worked briefly for the Library of Congress as a photographic assistant. He was let out in 1952 after library officials learned of his bias".

On January 20, 1956, NY T-1 made available a letter from EUSTACE MULLINS, 126 Madison Place, Staunton, Virginia, dated January 2, 1956. In this letter MULLINS stated that he had reproduced and sent to Europe some material which had then been given wide circulation. MULLINS said that the material consisted of a recruiting poster which he saw in a negro pool hall in Chicago depicting a negro in a United States Army uniform and a "blue-eyed blond girl lolling her head on his shoulder as she looks rapturously up at him". MULLINS described the text of the material as follows:

"Young Negro Americans! Are you hurt by race prejudice at home? Do white girls ignore your friendly glances? Join the United States Army and request overseas assignments in the homelands of our allies. Your pay will

be at least five times that of the home troops you will be training with. You will find girls not prejudiced against the color of your skin and willing to accompany you. Negro Americans, the white girls of Germany, England, and other nations are eagerly awaiting your healthy smiles! Join the United States Army today!"

MULLINS related that he had sent this material out over a month ago and that it was "raising hob with the governments of England, and Germany". He also recommended that the addressee of this letter send out some of this material.

On January 20, 1956, NY T-1 advised that EUSTACE MULLINS was a former NRP member who had recently been writing articles for "Woman's Voice" an anti - Semitic Chicago newspaper.

The investigative report of SA PAUL A. LOESCHE, Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI) 3rd Naval District, New York, New York, dated February 27, 1957, regarding one THOMAS DAVID HORTON reflects that SA LOESCHE interviewed Mrs. LINA LETT, 5 Minetta Street, New York City, on November 23, 1956. Mrs. LETT advised that HORTON was a partner with JOHN KASPER in the publication of the "Square Dollar Series" which included "Mullins on the Federal Reserve" by EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS.

Mrs. LETT stated that JOHN KASPER was a bi-sexual person who lived with married women but also sought the company of, and lived with, homosexuals, notably, EUSTACE C. MULLINS. Mrs. LETT said that MULLINS had admitted to her on more than one occasion that he was a homosexual. Mrs. LETT advised that MULLINS was generally known to seek the company of, and live with, young boys. She said that she met MULLINS through her former husband, PAUL W. LETT, and that she knew MULLINS to be a close personal friend and associate of JAMES MADOLE, the head of the NRP.

The above mentioned ONI report also reflects that the personnel records of the American Petroleum Institute, New York, New York, contain information indicating that EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS was born on

March 9, 1923 at Roanoke, Virginia, and that he was residing at 60 East Fourth Street, New York City in 1953.

In late 1956 SA LOESCHE^{of ONT} interviewed Mr. JOHN H. BIVINS, Director, American Petroleum Institute, New York, New York. Mr. BIVINS advised that EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS had been employed by the American Petroleum Institute from April 27, 1953 to April 30, 1954. Mr. BIVINS said that MULLINS had been dismissed from this employment because he had been seen by another employee making an anti - Semitic speech in the Yorkville section of New York City.

In June, 1955 SA BRYAN F. JINNETT, Jr., of the Newark Office of the FBI received a letter dated June 22, 1955 from EDWARD A. FLECKENSTEIN, Attorney at Law, 39 King Avenue, Weehawken, New Jersey. In this letter Mr. FLECKENSTEIN advised that EUSTACE C. MULLINS was "one of the very few intelligent rightest extremists in the United States". He described MULLINS as not subversive or dangerous but "merely anti - Semitic".

On November 21, 1955, HARRY L. SMITH, Office of Public Information, Virginia State Highway Department, 1221 East Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia, made available a copy of a publication entitled, "Women's Voice", Volume 14, #s 2 and 3 dated September, and October, at Chicago, Illinois. Mr. SMITH stated that he had received this publication through the mail and that he believed that EUSTACE MULLINS was the person responsible for mailing him this copy. Mr. SMITH did not furnish any basis for this belief.

On Page 1 of this publication there appears an article captioned, "Close the Public Schools" and sub captioned "Stop Delinquency! Free Parents, Teachers, and Children!" by EUSTACE MULLINS. In this article MULLINS alleges that the public school system of the United States has become infested with the influence of Communist trained

teachers and in addition is deteriorating because of intergration. MULLINS states that the most practical solution to this problem is to close the public schools.

The records of the New York City Police Department as checked on February 18, 1959 failed to reflect any record regarding EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS.

The records of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York as furnished by PAULINE DE FIORE to IC ALFRED G. ENNULAT on February 19, 1959, reflected that EUSTACE MULLINS, 60 East Fourth Street, New York City, was employed as an economist by the American Petroleum Institute, 50 West 50th Street, New York City. These records reflected that on September 2, 1955 Macy's Department Store brought a suit against MULLINS for \$100.08. The records reflected that as of October 27, 1955 Macy's reported that the subject owed \$100 and the account would be written off to Profit and Loss.

APPENDIX

NATIONALIST PARTY (also known as Nationalist Youth League)

On November 3, 1958, an informant advised that the Nationalist Party, also known as the Nationalist Youth League, was an anti-Semitic, neo-Fascist organization formed in 1954 in New York City by WEST HOOKER, who is a notorious anti-Semite. The informant further advised that this organization was inactive from 1956 to July, 1958, when LINCOLN ROCKWELL, associated with the National States Rights Party, revived it to use in connection with the activities of the National States Rights Party (NSRP). This informant stated that the NSRP was formed in 1938 and it is composed of past members of the Klu Klux Klan and notorious anti-Semites. In its convention at Louisville, Kentucky, on August 30, 1958, this party indicated that it was a political party dedicated to segregation.

The Klu Klux Klan has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

APPENDIX

NATIONAL RENAISSANCE PARTY (NRP)

A confidential source on April 21, 1958, described the NRP as anti-Semitic, anti-Negro, neo-Fascist organization with activities confined to the New York City area. It was founded in 1949 by JAMES H. MADOLE, who is in complete control of the party. The party's main function is distribution of the "National Renaissance Bulletin" on a monthly basis and distribution of pro-Arab literature obtained from official Arab establishments in New York City.

The Un-American Activities Committee of the United States House of Representative, in a preliminary report dated December 17, 1954, stated "NRP activities and propaganda are clearly subversive and un-American."

Suitable photographs of MULLINS are available in the files of the Chicago Office.

A request for authorization to interview MULLINS is not being made for the following reasons:

1. MULLINS' extremely antagonistic attitude towards the FBI could result in possible embarrassment to the Bureau.
2. MULLINS, a known homosexual, is reported to have had suicidal tendencies in the past and was hospitalized twice during his army service for mental reasons.
3. No information has been developed to indicate MULLINS has been involved in any bombing incidents.

On April 8, 1959, Postal Inspector J. S. BURGER, U.S. Postal Inspector's Office, New Post Office Building, Canal and Van Buren Streets, Chicago, made available to SA SHUPE for examination various writings of EUSTACE MULLINS maintained by that office. All of the writings examined are also in the possession of the FBI and pertinent information therein has been set out previously in report form.

Mr. BURGER advised that the anti-Negro and anti-Semitic writings of MULLINS have been called to the attention of the United States Attorney's Office in Chicago, but that he has been advised by that office that there appears to be no violation of federal law in that regard. Mr. BURGER stated that in that connection he had been advised by the United States Attorney's Office that the freedom of speech amendment to the Constitution has been construed very broadly by the courts.

On April 8, 1959, Mr. WILLIAM G. PINSLEY, Anti-Defamation League, B'nai B'rith, Chicago, advised SA SHUPE that he had no copies of the writings of EUSTACE MULLINS other than those he had previously furnished the Chicago FBI Office. Mr. PINSLEY stated that to his knowledge no writings of MULLINS had been circulated since the fall of 1958.

A review of MULLINS' writings contained in the files of the Chicago Office reflects that all pertinent information in that regard was incorporated into Chicago report of SA SHUPE dated January 19, 1959.

The reprint captioned "The New Man in our Image," as set forth on page two of this report, was furnished the Bureau by EUSTACE MULLINS during February, 1959, along with three personal letters from MULLINS addressed to the Director. Those three personal letters contained highly derogatory information concerning the FBI, its Special Agents and Mr. HOOVER. (Bulet to Chicago dated March 3, 1959)

The KU KLUX KLAN has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

DETAILS: AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

I. BACKGROUND

Residence and Employment

On April 7, 1959, Mrs. OCRIST TEISTER, 2239¹/₂ North Lincoln Avenue, advised SA CARYL E. SHUPE that EUSTACE MULLINS continued to reside at 2239 North Lincoln Avenue and to her knowledge continued to be unemployed.

Miscellaneous Background

On April 6, 1959, a Special Agent of the FBI observed the 1950 black Plymouth sedan which formerly bore 1958 Illinois license number 2953661 which was assigned to E. MULLINS, 2239 North Lincoln Avenue. The 1950 black Plymouth sedan as of April 6, 1959, was parked in the vicinity of 2239 North Lincoln, and bore 1959 Kentucky license number J54-175 with the name "JEFFERSON" appearing thereon.

II. MISCELLANEOUS

Writings

During February, 1959, EUSTACE MULLINS provided a reprint captioned "The New Man In Our Image" by EUSTACE MULLINS and stated thereon it was a speech given on October 14, 1958 before the Student Forum for Dissent at the University of Illinois at Urbana. The item stated that it was reprinted from "The Truth Seeker" described as a journal for Reasoners and Racists, 33 Park Row, New York 8, New York. Pertinent portions of the above reprint are set out below:

"At the present time humanity stands above all other animate beings because of its response to the challenges of existence. And of all human groups, Western man is the most diversified in his response. He has become pre-eminent in the generation of energy - what might indeed be called the creation of energy, now that it is being produced from hitherto unsuspected sources.

". . . retrogressive types wish freedom just as avidly as does Western man, but for them freedom means the right to exist in barbarism, the liberty to continue the practice of cannibalism, voodoo and suttee while Western man wants freedom to advance science and promote the welfare of his race.

"Differences of groups . . . must now be settled for all time. We must choose between a world jungle and a world civilization. The only way Western man could aid the retrogressive type to improve themselves, since they have failed to work out their evolutionary destiny, would be to intermarry with them and give them his genes. These genes would of course be swallowed and have virtually no effect in the vast mass of the colored world.

"We hear much about the rights of the several races, without any regard for the place which each occupies on the evolutionary scale. Nothing can be done for those groups which continue to exist in stagnation. The animal-like existence of the colored world is a mockery of human potentialities. Western man will either terminate that existence or he himself will be swallowed up by it.

". . . Cannot Western man continue to develop his physical sciences and leave the colored masses to welter in their misery? The modern world cannot tolerate this condition. It cannot go on half ape and half man. Western man's skill is harnessed to build huge apartment dwellings for Negroes which deteriorate into slums within a period of weeks. His gifts of medicine provide new impetus for the teeming colored masses who formerly depended on the selective process of contaminated water and disease carrying insects to keep their numbers within their means of support. Our leaders tell us that we are working to save life, but life cannot be saved . . .

". . . We must make the most determined effort to improve the race throughout the entire world. A pioneering crusade to clear the continents of vast areas of decaying life will create the atmosphere in which we can continue to grow. The leadership for this crusade is endemic in

"the nature of Western man. The predatory instincts of his masses on the plains of the United States, the Russian steppes and the west European nations await only the word to be unleashed against their historic enemies. Because human groups can no longer be isolated from each other during their development, the struggle for supremacy, now inevitable, must be a battle to the death."

Page 40 of the March, 1959 issue of "The Truth Seeker" described thereon as a journal for Reasoners and Racists published monthly by The Truth Seeker Company, Inc., 38 Park Row, New York, New York, contained an item captioned "Marxist Lecture at a Baptist College" by EUSTACE MULLINS. That lecture according to this item, was given by EUSTACE MULLINS and MATTHIAS KOEHL at Shimer College, a small seminary located at Mt. Carroll, Illinois.

Pertinent portions of that item are set forth below:

". . . we were surprised when we stepped out on the stage of the auditorium to see several Negroes in the audience and several orientals . . . We realized we had been tricked and that the school was violently left wing. . . however we were quite used to being heckled so we proceeded with our talks which dealt entirely with the massive threat which the rapidly reproducing colored masses presented to the white race.

"A tape recording was made of the Shimer talks by the students and flash photographs were taken of us while we were speaking. It is more than possible that the entire episode was arranged by the Anti-Defamation League, B'nai B'rith in hopes that we might say something which could be used against us. . . so the material would probably go to swell the files of the ADL in preparation for the day when they can attempt . . . to railroad defendants just as they did. . . five defendants in Atlanta who were held incommunicado for two months before being released after being accused of bombing a synagogue. The Jews raised nearly one million dollars in contributions through this incident, to build a new David Marx School addition to the synagogue."

The membership application for the National States Rights Party (NSRP) reflected as of August, 1958, that MATTHIAS KOEHL was the National Organizer of that organization.

The NSRP is a group of persons composed of former members of the Ku Klux Klan with strong states rights feelings and, in general, persons with strong hatred for Jews and Negroes.

(CG T-3, 9/4/58)

The NSRP was founded in Knoxville, Tennessee on November 10, 1957 when it was known as the United White Party. On August 30 and 31, 1958, the organization held a forming convention at Louisville, Kentucky and at that time was known as the NSRP.

(CG T-4, 9/4/58)

EUSTACE MULLINS is the author of a book entitled "The Federal Reserve Conspiracy." In this book MULLINS blamed financial depressions on the "Jewish run" Federal Reserve System which system MULLINS describes as treasonable. The book, while anti-Semitic in nature is not as violently anti-Semitic as previous writings of MULLINS.

that normally the owner of an automobile brought into Illinois from another state is required to obtain Illinois license plates within 30 days. BUDELL stated, however, that enforcement of the Illinois law in that regard depends primarily on reciprocity with other states; for example, where another state would require a 90 day period of grace where an Illinois licensed car was involved, Illinois would allow that 90 day provision in instances where a car from that state was brought into Illinois. BUDELL further stated that the fact a car registered out of state to someone residing in Illinois would not necessarily make the car liable for registration. In that regard, he pointed out that obviously where persons travel around somewhat or maintain two or more residences that they could not be required, as a practical matter, to obtain several different state license tags.

On May 8, 1959, Mr. MAURICE HOCHMAN, City Motor Vehicle Tax Department, City Hall, Chicago, advised SA SHUPE that any person owning or operating an automobile on the streets of Chicago and maintaining a residence in Chicago is required by city ordinance to purchase a city vehicle sticker for that automobile. HOCHMAN added that despite the fact that an automobile bears an out of state license tag the operator would still be required to pay the vehicle tax in Chicago. HOCHMAN stated that it would be up to the Illinois State authorities to act regarding the out of state license tags on such a vehicle. Concerning MULLINS' 1950 Plymouth automobile being registered in Kentucky, the following information is submitted:

The Chicago Office will disseminate through liaison with the Chicago Police Department the information concerning MULLINS' residence in Chicago and the fact that his automobile bears Kentucky license plates and does not contain a 1959 City of Chicago Motor Vehicle Sticker, which is a possible violation of Chicago City Ordinance. It is noted that MULLINS' car was observed parked in the vicinity of 2239 North Lincoln Avenue, Chicago, on several occasions during the period April 1 through April 15, 1959.

In connection with MULLINS' automobile being registered in his name at 1617 Bardstown Road, Louisville, Kentucky, it is noted that in referenced ^{letter} dated April 27, 1959, Louisville was advised that MULLINS continued to reside at 2239 North Lincoln Avenue in Chicago.

MULLINS, 1617 Bardstown Road, Louisville, Kentucky, on a 1950 two-door Plymouth sedan. The records further reflect that the above car was registered in the State of Kentucky on January 23, 1959.

The entire residence area, containing two apartments, at 1617 Bardstown Road, Louisville, Kentucky, as of April 15, 1959, was rented to EDWARD R. FIELDS. FIELDS, who occupies the first floor apartment at that address, subleases the apartment on the second floor, which was occupied during the first three months of 1959 by individuals other than EUSTACE C. MULLINS. As of April 15, 1959, the second floor apartment at that address was unoccupied.

The NSRP was founded in Knoxville, Tennessee, on November 10, 1957, when it was known as the United White Party. On August 30 and 31, 1958, the organization held a forming convention at Louisville, Kentucky, and at that time was known as the NSRP.

The Ku Klux Klan has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

HERTAGE MULLINS SWEARS AT THE WORLD.

Mullins and one of his boy friends are spending a long weekend at the ~~Weiss~~ farm. Weiss this last week put up a large sign, painted by Donner, at the entrance to his place entitled "Weiss' Wild Life Sanctuary." Mullins fits the description. The Mullins pair came unannounced. Weiss had not planned to be out at the farm. But, on a hurry call from Marie, he dashed out. Weiss is fearful that Marie might have one of her outbursts and get another heart attack. Also, Weiss is fearful that Mullins might rifle his files. At the same time, Weiss likes the contact with Mullins as perhaps the best channel to get dirt on others. Also, Weiss is getting back into writing activities and has in the back of his mind that he might call on Mullins to help with his editing. Weiss to Mullins also is a repository of dirt, and, now that Mullins is returning to New York to live, has the idea that Weiss can be useful to him. This is particularly true now that Weiss enjoys full income from the apartment at White Plains and is having fun flashing a bankroll. Weiss also wants to keep within limits with the FBI and regards Mullins as best informed on police hazards. Mullins is driving a broken down sedan. Weiss proposes to accompany them May 10 back to New York to make sure that they leave the premises. Weiss applauds almost anything anti-social, but hides badly his distaste for homoec.

A devotee of Ezra ~~Pound~~, Mullins lounges about the farm in a dirty turtle-neck sweater, though he has a change to a trim tweed when he finds it more appropriate. As always, he is convinced of his own intellectual superiority over about everyone he meets. Ezra Pound is still the one great hero of his life, and he boasts that during Pound's years in the institution he was closest to him and still is close to him today. For example, he claims that his book on the Federal Reserve was inspired by Pound, and when it was published Pound took great pride in having inspired it. Pound is happy in Italy, is busy writing, and leads a quiet very retired life, says Mullins. Another vanity of Mullins is his service to fellow anti-Semites in doing their thinking for them. Mullins claims that he did this for the boys in the Atlanta

jail, and that he was just down in Arlington performing the same service for Rockwell at his trial. He also claims to have close contacts with Klan leaders in various parts of the South. In this activity Mullins works closest with Matt Koehl. They work together as a team in Chicago, with Fields, with Crommalin and with others. Koehl is constantly on the move, doing more traveling while Mullins does more writing. Mullins is literate, has a smooth line, and tells his story with supreme self assurance - making it difficult to distinguish between fact and fancy. Said Mullins:

"I get along well with Lawrence Dennis. He felt with me that he was throwing ideas away on dumb clucks such as Hooker, Joe Kamp, and some of the others. Dennis knows that I know about his color, but still shies away from the subject with obvious embarrassment when color questions come up."

Mullins boasted that many of the southern younger generation have had military experience and are handy mechanics. He mentioned one in particular who, when needed, can turn out any type of explosive. "These boys can play it rough and will." In this comment Mullins showed the kind of enthusiasm that many desk fascists show for the direct-action boys whose minds they poison.

Mullins likes to picture himself in the role of the intellectual giant who disinterestedly lends his talents to leaders of causes he believes in. He donates his time generously but is disappointed in what he regards as their lack of comprehension. He also finds them greedy and unwilling to give him the modest compensation they promise him. He hates Jews and expects dirty dealings. He also hates Catholics. "They, too, rob you, especially bigoted Catholics like McGinley. Insist on having their money on the table before you do anything for them." He even distrusts his fellow Nationalists. "One of their characteristics is that they will chisel on you if they get the chance. McGinley is both, so I was doubly screwed." This is how Mullins reports his McGinley experience:

He hates McGinley. "McGinley got nearly two years of my services. In addition, I gave him the publication of my Federal Reserve book. He gave me a small advance,

and then pretended that we had agreed that this would be the total payment for the book. I checked with the printer in Texas and found that he had sold over 30,000 copies." Mullins still has in the back of his mind getting even with McGinley in one way or another. "That seemingly dumb guy who can neither write nor talk, is pretty smart when it comes to business. He helped his son get a \$35,000 farm, today worth much more, and he has other funds salted away for himself. He is still able to milk others than Freedman. And Freedman of course is a joke. I always got along OK with ~~Charlie Smith~~ and intend to look him up early this week. That old Russian McGinley keeps to answer the door and the phone gives the place a wierd atmosphere. In calling up on the phone it is like hearing a voice from the Kremlin." "I arranged with a German publisher to bring out a German edition. The book was out, and I received an original ten copies. But before it was offered the public, Bonn intervyened and forbade distribution. But the publisher did not destroy the copies. I recently received an offer from a lawyer named ~~Strauss~~ in Munich to try to get the books cleared if I would pay him an initial fee of \$300. But I replied that I did not care that much now whether the book appeared in Germany or not. What I write about the Warburgs would interest the Germans less now because of the fact that there is no Warburg of genius alive now. Certainly not ~~Jimmie Warburg~~." No 1. e.

Mullins and the FBI

Said Mullins: "My activities seem to be of interest to the FBI but they almost never bother me. When I came out with the German blond girl and Negro troops item, Military Intelligence got after me several times, but not the FBI. I found that the first informer against me was ~~von Leers~~, that Nazi bastard, then still in Buenos Aires. He ran with the item to the American Ambassador, hoping to ingratiate himself with him. Von Leers was always an overstuffed, stupid German intellectual. ~~Nasser~~ probably gave him a job because of his prestige as a German professor, but he was no bargain. I still correspond with him out of curiosity to see how that Kraut transforms himself into a Moslem. The German people got what was coming to them. They

were not deserving of a man of Hitler's talents.

"The FBI molest my family and friends, although actually they have only tackled me directly once or twice. A few weeks ago in Chicago a couple of their agents called on me. I spotted one of them as a Nigger, passing as white. I thought of denouncing him to his face but decided that it wouldn't do any good. I did better, and wrote Hoover a personal letter. In this I exposed what he knew that I know anyway - that he is a Negro. This is not just hearsay. Several newspaper reporters and myself interviewed an old woman in Virginia, who had known his mother intimately and knew that she was a Negro. Hoover knows that I can produce three or four witnesses who will confirm this. I put all this in the letter. Then on the score of his private life, I have seen letters from him - Surine has them - that disclose his peculiar associations. Do you mean homo-sexual, Mullins was asked. Mullins said yes.

"Hoover does not know that I may not have some photostats of these myself. You can be sure that he will not bother ~~Surine~~. He is a slick customer and would get a top informer post if the Russians or anybody else came into power in this country. In the same letter I protested to Hoover that he had sent a couple of his men to intimidate my aged father and mother and my crippled sister in their home.

"Of course, Hoover did not reply to my letter. I know, however, that I am not going to be really bothered by the FBI."

Uses Mrs. van Hyning

"My relations with Mrs. van Hyning have continued good. I have a funny time with those three doddering old ladies in her office (making a gesture of trembling hands). She has made a good thing out of my Rabbi Rabinowitz sheet. Ever since 1953, when it came out, she has been selling those sheets at the rate of 2,000 a month or better for a dollar a hundred. These cost her perhaps six cents. She has sold over a million copies. This item looks good for years to come.

"Mrs. ~~Dilling~~ peddled a lot of them too. She is still making a good living

out of reprints of some of her old stuff. Mrs. van Hyning helps her. She also has an understanding with book stores that she will pay a dollar for old copies of "The Red Network." She then turns around and sells them as collector items for \$5 or more. But they also chisel on each other. Mrs. van Hyning got Dilling, the husband, to defend her in a suit. He charged her \$2,000. for his services.

"Hooker at one time offered to buy 'Womans Voice'. She hesitated and the deal did not come off. It is a good paying proposition for anyone who pushes it."

Mullins rather likes his new role as a clergyman. He gets a lot of letters addressed Reverend from people in the South who really fall for it. He had a laugh over a letter from Monk who called him Reverend and talked about his being blessed by the Lord with a rich congregation.

Mullins dislikes Germans

Although Mullins is ready to accept their hospitality, Mullins has not much use for Germans generally. He sneers at Mrs. Weiss on whom he is now sponging. He sneers at Weiss' neighbors, the Haechtles, saying "he is like a lot of Kraut Chicago millionaires, makes millions, but is dumb about everything else. Mrs. Haechtle, however, should be excepted because she makes wonderful meat rolls." Mullins has now written off ~~Wernecke~~ after getting money out of him for a long time. He says that Wernecke is in serious trouble for offering somebody \$2,000 to murder a local real estate man who was lover of his wife. Wernecke seems to have another reason to get rid of him, because of some shady check-kiting transactions they were both involved in.

~~Old~~ Koegal as an editorial writer is a joke. He is just a walking mummy. He really died about 20 years ago."

Mullins for the moment treats Weiss gently. Now that he has money he can be useful. Perhaps Weiss would put money into a publication where Mullins can write. Mullins thought of joining up with "The TruthSeeker". Old Smith invited him to join when they met at Fields' Louisville meeting last year. But, said Mullins, "There

are too many Jews like Kuttner connected with that paper. Also, I am not interested in the old Ingersoll atheist line. Some old fossils still write for it. But who wants to read about that sort of thing today?" What Mullins did say is that if Weiss were to put some money in it, Mullins might work himself into an editor's place where he could influence policy without appearing publicly. Mullins likes to picture himself in the role of an idea-maker behind the young leaders who will come to the fore if and when a big depression and upheaval hits this country.

Mullins and West Hooker

Said Mullins: "West and I were very close for a couple of years. At first I thought that he could be made into a national figure and into a leader. I did a lot of his writing for him. I went on trips to Washington with him and I introduced him to lots of people in the movement. But I discovered that he was an egomaniac and politically too stupid to do anything with. Lawrence Dennis made the same discovery. But we liked to stay out at his home. We often shared a twin bed guest room. The wife was friendly and the children charming. The food was good. We liked the atmosphere and continued going long after we had written off West as a political nonentity. To his wife, West was her man, no matter what idiotic things he did. As she had more children, she gave less and less attention to him. West, on his side, had long since turned his attentions elsewhere. He was sleeping with his assistant. She was determined to pry him away from his wife and marry him. But she had no money and could hardly compete with wife-children-luxury complex that held Hooker at home. Also, West was playing the field. His office afternoons served more as a place for rendezvous with visiting models than to transact political business. Then West drank like a fish. History shows that you can go in for politics or can specialize on dames and liquor, but you cannot mix both and get far in politics.

"West had everything: family name, wealth, personality. He could also have continued to get Hunt's backing if he had not made such a fool of himself. I accompanied him twice to call on Hunt. The old man liked West. But West, instead of talking

nationalist politics, ranted in a loud voice about the Jews. Hunt didn't go for that. In short, West read himself out of the Hunt picture.

"West had a particular hatred for you. He would talk about you, work himself into a hate, and then wanted to beat somebody up. I went along with him over to your office on W. 40 St. He boasted that he was going to knock your block off. I thought it might be a good show. When he failed to find you he got into a fight with a taxi driver and dared him to come out of his car and fight. West had a way with him. He was always wanting to punch somebody's nose.

"West nearly messed up relations with both of their families (his own and his wife's). His wife's father, who had a big business and with many Jewish customers, was distressed by West's anti-Semitism. Finally, he cut his daughter and West off in his will, only leaving a trust fund for the children. Hooker's wife sued her brother and after about a year got a private settlement of about a million. Hooker's father put up the money for the "7 Up" concession to West, one of the conditions being that Hooker leave the country. This business seems to be profitable because Hooker has set up seven bottling agencies in Italy, lives in a castle, and travels about with the family in grand style. ~~Rockwell~~ still keeps in close touch with Hooker, still admires him, and still uses his mannerisms. They are very similar characters."

Mullins on Racism in the South

Mullins looks forward to greater race tensions between Blacks and Whites with violence both in northern industrial centers like Chicago and in the South. "There is a lull right now in the South. Some of the older Klan people are intimidated by the police and by the FBI. But the younger ones are taking over and are not chicken like the old ones. Take the boys in Atlanta. The Jews instigated those arrests. But the Mayor and police of Atlanta stupidly fell for their line and jailed the boys on the gamble that they could then get evidence against them. The Jews were too smart to identify themselves with the succession of errors that followed. I was close

to the boys throughout. They were not upset about being in jail and took the whole business in a matter-of-fact kind of way. Many of the younger crowd are working into the Citizens Councils.

"We have been smart about shifting blame for Nigger uppitness to the Jews. With Spingarn head of the NAACP, and prominent Jews identified with Negro defense organizations generally, our job was an easy one. Our people in the South never thought much about Jews one way or the other. The Southern Jews lived and thought very much like everybody else. But with the church bombings they were suddenly and violently reminded that they are different. It was a laugh to see them wriggle. There are going to be a lot of race riots, and the young Southern Whites are the ones who will be leading them."

But isn't it a fact that the young Whites have much less race prejudice than their elders, he was asked. He replied:

"That is true. For example, they think nothing about going out and laying a Nigger gal. But they aren't afraid of violence. They don't propose to be pushed around by Niggers, and now they talk about Jews as enemies too. Blaming it on the Jews has gone over swell. But what will really get the white kids aroused will be their loss of a lot of their privileges in a depression. They have heard talk about the good old days of 1840 and thereabouts and really believe much of the magnolia old plantation hooey. Actually their parents never had it so good as right now. These kids get easy money and have all the freedom in the world. Wait until next year or the year after when depression hits the country. When those kids find their jobs gone and their Buicks taken away from them, they will get violent. They will look around for somebody to blame and will then focus on the Niggers and the Jews.

"We figure that race troubles will start in Chicago sometime within the next year. Here you have terrific Negro housing congestion. They are pushing out into other neighborhoods. The Germans and some of the others simply pack up and move. But the Polacks refuse to budge from their little homes. It will be easy to work them into a fighting mood. I have been talking over how we can provoke such a situation with

Max Nelson. We figured that we might get riots started this last year, but general business has been too good. It would be better to wait for a depression when firing will begin on a large scale. I think that a big reverse may come at latest as early as next year. Then things in Chicago will be violent. In a lot of centers in the South things will blow up. Then you will see what these young Klan kids can do. But for the moment they are playing it safe."

And are the younger crowd in the Klan in touch with one another throughout the South? Replied Mullins:

"Not too well. There is not a single publication which really keeps them informed about the national scene. I am doing more work for "Right." Matt Koehl has been down helping Fields get "The Thunderbolt" in better shape, less misspellings and more English. The handicap of boys like Fields is that while their hearts are in the right place, they never got very far in high school and have a hard time expressing themselves. Fields is a real guy and will continue to be heard from. He has a couple of hundred of the younger crowd who swear by him, and when the time comes for action they will be with him in the middle of it."

Don't ignore Rockwell and Arrowsmith

"Don't write Rockwell off as a crank. He really has talent. He has about 25 boys who will stick to him through thick and thin. He welcomes litigation as a way to get publicity. The same for the swastikas. He proved to the judge last week that he could do a good job as his own lawyer. In the trial last week he made the prosecuting attorney look like a monkey.

"I write ~~Crommelin~~ off as a positive factor in the future. He is already old hat, has a reputation for losing all of his political fights, and has no gratitude for those who help him. All of us, Koehl, Emory, ~~Burke~~, who have helped him, except Kasper, have had the same unpleasant experience with him. I worked over six weeks with him. Matt Koehl worked even longer. But Crommelin never as much as said thank you. He likes Kasper, however, that bargain-counter playboy, because Kasper bootlicked

and went along with Grosselin in all of his crazy political whims.

The Director has inquired, "Who is Mullins? If he really exists we should make him put up or shut up."

B'nai B'rith, Chicago, has furnished the Chicago Office with the report of an unknown New York informant of the Anti-Defamation League dated May 9, 1959. This report sets forth statements allegedly made by Eustace Mullins. Page 4 of the report contains vicious and fantastic lies concerning the Director and attributes this material, in part, to "Surine" who apparently is Don Surine, former Bureau Agent and former associate of the late Senator McCarthy. Eustace Mullins is identical with Eustace Clarence Mullins, Jr., subject of a current Racial Matters investigation. He is an alleged homosexual and he is known to be a prolific writer of extremely vicious anti-Semitic propaganda. He has associated with the principal suspects in the Atlanta bombing case. Mullins has previously been critical of the Bureau in his writings, and letters he has written to the Bureau in the past have not been acknowledged.

In February, 1959, Mullins wrote three letters to the Director, criticizing the investigation of his activities and engaging in a tirade against the Director and the Bureau. The vicious material, which page 4 of the informant's report indicates was included in these letters, does not appear in them and the letters were not acknowledged.

Mullins is a warped, degenerate and depraved individual. His anti-Semitic writings show a complete disregard for the truth and he has authored propaganda which he apparently knows to be absolutely false.

ACTION TAKEN

The Chicago Office has been instructed to immediately interview Mullins to demand that he put up or shut up. Mullins will be forcefully admonished to refrain from making such reckless and baseless charges in the future. Chicago was also instructed to determine whether there is any basis upon which the local authorities could arrange for the commitment of Mullins to an institution.

Mullins has been interviewed by Agents of the Detroit Office. He vehemently denied that he had attacked the personal life of the Director or any member of the Director's family and suggested that the Anti-Defamation League might be responsible for any allegation that Mullins had made such an attack. *7-1*

Mullins admitted authoring articles which were critical of the Bureau's investigation of the Atlanta bombing case and also admitted criticizing parts of "Masters of Deceit," but denied any personal criticism of the Director.

It is noted that this interview was predicated upon the report of an unknown informant of the Anti-Defamation League who alleged that in May, 1959, Mullins stated vicious and fantastic lies concerning the Director.

ACTION:

The Chicago Office has explored the possibility of having Mullins committed to a mental institution. Although local authorities are fully cooperative, it appears that the only practical possibility of achieving his commitment is through an indirect approach. It has been alleged that Mullins' "girl friend" is a [redacted] who resides in Melrose Park, a suburb of Chicago. Arrangements have been made for the [redacted] Officer to interview [redacted] and if this interview develops a sexual relationship between [redacted] and Mullins, it may be possible for Chicago authorities to have Mullins committed. This will be closely followed.

EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, JR., was interviewed at 8:00 AM this date at the cottage owned by RUSSELL KIRK, another writer, located at Lake Mecosta, Mecosta, Mich. The Agents identified themselves at the door and made inquiry for MULLINS, who at first denied his identity and refused access to premises. Conversation was held through a storm door, and thereafter MULLINS admitted his identity and agreed to be interviewed outside the cottage. Essentially, he was highly reticent to converse with Agents.

MULLINS stated he is engaged in writing a book and that all of his papers were loose in the cottage.

MULLINS advised that EMORY BURKE of Decatur, Ga., had told him that the FBI had seized personal letters and papers, including letters written by MULLINS to BURKE. These letters were seized in connection with the bombing of the synagogue in Atlanta, and were never returned to BURKE, according to MULLINS.

MULLINS stated that he had covered the trial of GEORGE BRIGHT, et al, in Atlanta, Ga., in about Oct. of 1958, in which BRIGHT was accused of participating in the bombing of the synagogue. He said that it was his opinion BRIGHT and the others were falsely accused, and suffered injury to their reputation.

MULLINS stated shortly after this trial he was approached by FBI Agents at his home, located at 2239 Lincoln Ave., Chicago, Ill., apparently as a source of information for the case.

He stated that in view of his observation of the trial, he wrote a personal typewritten letter to Director HOOVER of the FBI which was critical of the activities of the Bureau and their treatment of persons suspected of involvement in the bombing case. He advised that in connection with the letter he sent to Mr. HOOVER, he could not recall specific statements he did make, but he eminently denied that his letter contained any scurrilous or libelous language regarding Director HOOVER, his family, or the FBI. He said he knew the language contained in the letter was such that it could be published without fear of libel.

He stated that he has written certain articles in the past which contained some criticism of the operations of the FBI. He also said these articles included an "open letter" circulated in Atlanta, Ga., during the trial of BRIGET, an article appearing in the publication "Woman's Voice" in March of 1959, an article on Mr. HOOVER's book "Masters of Deceit", and some articles in the past containing his viewpoint on coping with the Communist situation. He again denied that these articles contained scurrilous or libelous comments regarding the Director.

He stated there is only one occasion when he had written a personal letter to the Director, and this was about Feb. of 1959.

He again strongly denied that he used any language that was scurrilous regarding Director HOOVER. He stated he did and could not write anything regarding the personal life or background of Director HOOVER or his family inasmuch as he has no personal knowledge regarding it.

He stated that he had been severely attacked by the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith. He said he knew he had been fired by his employers at Chicago Motor Corp., Chicago, Ill., and the American Petroleum Institution, N.Y., as a direct result of pressure concerted by the Anti-Defamation League. He stated that he had instituted a suit against these people in Chicago and N.Y. for \$250,000 and \$50,000 respectively. He stated that he had A. FLECKENSTEIN, Attorney, represent him in the N.Y. matter. He advised he was not satisfied with the manner in which FLECKENSTEIN handled the case.

He stated it was entirely possible that his enemies may have written a letter over his signature to Mr. HOOVER in an effort to discredit or embarrass him. He stated he would be willing to examine and acknowledge the letter that he had directed to Mr. HOOVER. He stated he had not written a carbon copy of this letter and would have to see the original to recall specific language he had used.

It was made known to Mr. MULLINS the deep concern of the Director and the FBI in any unjust or scurrilous attack, and such will never be tolerated.

The interview with Mr. MULLINS was concluded at this point. He advised that he was on vacation and would be returning to his home in Chicago in the next few days.

On 6/16/59 Sgt. FRED JACKSON, Juvenile Officer, Melrose Park, Illinois, Police Department, interviewed WILLIAM SUTHER. SUTHER emphatically denied ever having any sexual relations with MULLINS and stated MULLINS had never approached him for this purpose. He admitted however that he had heard that MULLINS might be homosexual. Sgt. JACKSON described SUTHER as being somewhat mentally unbalanced and effeminate in manner and speech, and feels interview of SUTHER's mother would serve no purpose.

In view of the foregoing and since previous efforts along these lines have been unsuccessful, this phase of investigation regarding MULLINS is being discontinued.

EUSTACE CLARENCE MULLINS, Jr.
RACIAL MATTERS

The following information, except where otherwise noted, was provided by CG T-1 on May 27, 1959.

EUSTACE MULLINS has stated that EZRA POUND is the one great hero in his life and that MULLINS' book on the federal reserve was inspired by POUND, who now leads a quiet retired life in Italy.

CG T-2 on September 3, 1958, advised that EUSTACE MULLINS is the author of the book entitled "The Federal Reserve Conspiracy."

MULLINS claims he does the thinking for fellow anti-Semites and has acted in this capacity in connection with persons involved in the Atlanta jail, as well as for one ROCKWELL in his recent Arlington trial.

CG T-3 advised on August 26, 1958, that LINCOLN ROCKWELL was among the galaxy of the anti-Semitic constellation who were to attend the National States Rights Party (NSRP) convention in Louisville, Kentucky, on August 30,31, 1958.

CG T-4 advised on September 4, 1958, that the NSRP is composed of former Ku Klux Klan members, persons with strong states rights feelings and in general persons with strong hatred for Jews and Negroes. The unofficial head of the NSRP is EDWARD R. FIELDS.

The Ku Klux Klan has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

MULLINS claims to be closely associated with Klan leaders in the southern states where the younger element has been taking over inasmuch as some of the older Klan people are

being intimidated by the police and the FBI. MULLINS has said he anticipates greater race tensions between Negro and white with violence in northern industrial centers such as Chicago as well as in the South. Many of the younger crowd in the South are working into "Citizens Councils", according to MULLINS.

MULLINS has also said that the younger element in the Klan are not too well in touch with each other in the South as there are no publications which can keep them informed on the national scene. MULLINS has stated he has been doing some work for "Right" magazine and that MATT KOEHL and one FIELDS, supra, are getting "The Thunderbolt" in better shape. FIELDS, according to MULLINS, has a couple hundred of the "younger crowd" who swear by him and when the time comes for action they will be in the middle of it with FIELDS.

The membership application forms for the NSRP reflected as of August, 1958, that MATTHIAS KOEHL was National Organizer for the NSRP.

The masthead of "The Thunderbolt" states that it is the official Racial Nationalist organ of the NSRP.

MULLINS has stated that many of the young southern generation who have had military experience and are handy mechanics can and will play it tough. One individual in that regard can, if needed, turn out any type of explosives, according to MULLINS.

MULLINS has stated that the Jews instigated the arrests of individuals involved in the Atlanta case and that the mayor and police of Atlanta who fell for their line jailed "the boys" on the chance that they might obtain evidence against them.

On October 12, 1958, a Jewish synagogue in Atlanta, Georgia, was bombed.

MULLINS has said that the shifting of blame for "nigger uppitness" on the Jews was a smart move. In that regard he stated that the job has been an easy one in that prominent Jews have been identified with various Negro defense organizations.

The people in the South, according to MULLINS, never thought too much about the Jews one way or another until after the church bombings, at which time they suddenly realized that they, the Jews, are different. There will be many more riots and the young southern whites will be leading them, according to MULLINS.

MULLINS has also said that the young southern whites have much less race prejudice than their elders but that they are not afraid of violence. They do not propose to be pushed around by "niggers," according to MULLINS, and now they talk about Jews as enemies too. MULLINS has said that next year or the year after when a depression hits the country and the young southern whites find their jobs gone they will get violent and the blame will then be focussed on the "niggers" and the Jews.

MULLINS has remarked that he anticipates racial troubles will start in Chicago, Illinois, where there is a tremendous Negro housing congestion, some time within the next year. He has said that Negro housing in Chicago is expanding into neighborhoods whereupon residents then pack up and move. Polish families, according to MULLINS, refuse to budge and therefore it would be a simple matter to work them into a fighting mood.

MULLINS has stated that in discussions between him and MAX NELSON they had considered how such a situation might be provoked. They also, according to MULLINS, had discussed the possibility of getting riots started last year but decided that business conditions had been too good for such a venture. MULLINS also said that NELSON and himself had decided that it would be better to wait for a depression when firing will begin on a large scale and that when a reversal does come things in Chicago will become violent.

MULLINS has also stated that the South would also be affected in that regard, at which time it could be determined what the young Klan boys who are presently playing it safe should then do.

MULLINS has stated that he visits the office of a Mrs. VAN HYNING on occasion. According to MULLINS, Mrs. VAN HYNING has made a good thing out of MULLINS' article on Rabbi RABINOWITZ sheet and has sold these sheets at the rate of 2,000 or better a month since 1953. MULLINS has said that the RABINOWITZ item looks good for years to come and that a Mrs. DILLING also has peddled a lot of those sheets.

Jewish propaganda in using the issue of anti-Semitism to pit the United States against Germany in World War II and which again would be used to promote a war of mutual self-destruction between the United States and Russia at the conclusion of which a neutral Israel would emerge as the dominating power of the world.. The Rabbi then prophesized, according to the leaflet, "an era of 10,000 years of peace and plenty" during which the "Jew race" would rule indisputably over the earth as its superior intelligence would enable it to obtain mastery of the world of dark peoples.

On September 9, 1958, CG T-5 advised that the "Abominable But True" pamphlet written by EUSTACE MULLINS concerning Rabbi RABINOVICH's speech in Budapest, Hungary, on January 12, 1952, was a figment of MULLINS' imagination.

MULLINS has advised that he and WEST HOOKER were closely associated for a couple of years and that he, MULLINS, had thought HOOKER could be made into a national figure and leader. MULLINS stated that he had done a lot of writing for HOOKER and also accompanied HOOKER to Washington on trips where he introduced him to a number of people in the movement. MULLINS has stated that he later discovered that HOOKER was an egomaniac and politically too stupid to do anything with.

MULLINS has stated however that he enjoyed staying at HOOKER's residence where he often shared a guest room with one LAWRENCE DENNIS. According to MULLINS, HOOKER drank like a fish and also had engaged in an affair with a female assistant. MULLINS has stated in that regard that a person can go in for politics or can specialize in dames and liquor, but cannot mix both and get far in politics.

MULLINS, who referred to HOOKER as a man who has everything, stated that in HOOKER's associations with an individual by the name of HUNT, instead of talking nationalist politics HOOKER would rant in a loud voice about the Jews. HOOKER, according to MULLINS, is presently in Italy where he has set up several agencies for the Seven-Up Bottling Company. HOOKER, according to MULLINS, has a particular hatred at times for various individuals and is always wanting to punch someone's nose.

CG T-6 advised on December 13, 1954, that WEST HOOKER of Larchmont, New York, as of December, 1954, was a notorious anti-Semite who had been active in many nationalist organizations in New York City in the past.

MULLINS has described one ROCKWELL, supra, as an individual with talent who has approximately 25 followers who will stand by him. ROCKWELL, according to MULLINS, is an individual who welcomes litigation as a means of obtaining publicity for himself.

MULLINS has also said that one CROMMELIN has a reputation for losing all his political fights and that he also exhibits no gratitude for those who assist him. MULLINS said that he, KOEHL, supra, and one EMORY BURKE, all of whom have assisted CROMMELIN in the past, have had the same unpleasant experience with him. CROMMELIN, according to MULLINS, is fond of one KASPAR, however, MULLINS has stated that he is not impressed with KASPAR.

CG T-7 advised on September 6, 1958, that Retired Admiral JOHN CROMMELIN was nominated at the NSRP convention held in Louisville, Kentucky, on August 30-31, 1958, to be the NSRP candidate for President of the United States.

CG T-1 advised on October 7, 1958, that JOHN KASPAR, in a blatant attack against the Jews, was one of the principal speakers at the NSRP convention held in Louisville, Kentucky, on August 30-31, 1958. KASPAR, recently released from the federal penitentiary at Tallahassee, Florida, had been convicted following his involvement in the Clinton, Tennessee, school disorders and received a one year prison sentence for contempt of court.

Mullins has stated that one Mc Ginley, who published Mullins' book on the Federal Reserve System, is in disfavor with Mullins over a dispute in connection with the proceeds for the sale of that book. Mullins described Mc Ginley as a bigoted Catholic.

Mullins has considered joining up with the "Truthseeker" magazine, however, he has stated that there are too many Jews connected with that publication. He has said, however, that in the event he could work himself into an editor's position, whereby he could influence policy without appearing publicly, he might do so if the proper person puts some money into the paper.

Comments by Mullins concerning possible future violence in Chicago, Illinois, as set forth above, has been brought to the attention of the appropriate local authorities.

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MULLINS has openly stated that the FBI has molested his family and friends but that he had been contacted by them only once or twice. He has remarked that two FBI Agents had called on him in Chicago around February, 1959, one of whom he spotted as a "nigger" passing as white. MULLINS said he had considered denouncing that Agent to his face but then decided he would write HOOVER a personal letter instead. In that letter, MULLINS stated he exposed HOOVER as a Negro, adding that HOOVER was already aware that MULLINS knew that. In that regard MULLINS also has remarked that several newspaper reporters and himself had interviewed an elderly woman in Virginia who had known his, HOOVER's, mother intimately and knew that she was a Negro, and that HOOVER was aware that MULLINS could produce three or four witnesses who could confirm that. MULLINS has also stated that HOOVER was a homosexual and also said that HOOVER does not know but what he, MULLINS, has photostats of letters possessed by one SURINE, disclosing his peculiar associations. MULLINS has said.

that HOOVER will not bother SURINE as he is a slick customer and would get a top informer post if the Russians or anyone else come into power in this country.

DON SURINE is a former Special Agent of the FBI. He has also served on the staff of the Mc Carthy Committee of the United States Senate.

MULLINS also stated that he had protested by letter to HOOVER that he had sent a couple of his men to intimidate MULLINS' aged father and crippled sister but that of course HOOVER had not replied to that letter.

Re Bureau radiogram 6/9/59 and Chicago teletype 6/9/59.

In line with Bureau instructions to explore the possibility of having MULLINS committed to a mental institution, on 6/4/59 AUSA D. ARTHUR CONNELLY was contacted by SA AUGUST C. KEMPF. CONNELLY advised as follows:

The federal government does not have any facilities for committing someone for mental reasons, this being a state power. The federal government can and will examine someone who has been brought to the attention of the federal court for other reason and if found mentally deficient this person will be turned over to state authorities for committment purposes. AUSA CONNELLY advised that the States Attorney's Office in Chicago should be contacted regarding the possibility of having MULLINS committed through that office. He pointed out that the States Attorney's Office through the cooperation of the local police can bring MULLINS before a county judge who has the power to commit MULLINS if he is found mentally deficient.

The Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 91 $\frac{1}{2}$, captioned "Mental Health", is summarized as follows:

A person alleged to be mentally ill, mentally deficient or in need of mental treatment to a degree which

warrants hospital care may be admitted to and confined in a hospital by compliance with any of the following admission procedures:

1. By voluntary application
2. By court commitment
3. By emergency admission

Item 1 is self-explanatory. Item 2 requires that a reputable citizen must file a petition with the court alleging the person is mentally ill, mentally deficient or in need of mental treatment. This petition, among other things, must be accompanied by the names of witnesses by which the facts alleged may be proven, one of which must be a qualified physician or psychiatrist. If the person has not been examined by a qualified physician, then the court shall order such examination. The States Attorney's Office has the responsibility of presenting the petition and the accompanying evidence to the court. Item 3 is a procedure which is used only in exceptional cases where immediate restraint is necessary for the protection of the person or of others.

On 6/9/59 Mr. ELROY SANDQUIST, head of the Civil Division, States Attorney's Office, and Mr. JOSEPH W. MIODUSKI, Assistant States Attorney who specializes in commitment cases, were contacted by SA CHARLES T. FLETCHER. Mr. MIODUSKI was of the opinion that of the three procedures of commitment, items 1 and 3 would definitely be out inasmuch as it did not appear that subject would present himself voluntarily and since there were no exceptional circumstances which would require immediate restraint. Regarding the second procedure, MIODUSKI pointed out that the filing of the petition by a reputable citizen accompanied by a certificate executed by an examining physician is almost impossible unless the complainant is a relative of the person and in a position to persuade or otherwise arrange for the person to be examined by a physician

or a psychiatrist. He pointed out that only in the most unusual circumstances would the court accept a petition without this certificate from the physician and thereafter order a mental examination by a physician or a psychiatrist appointed by the court. He said this might be done in the event there is overwhelming evidence that commitment is necessary or in the event some official such as a Bureau agent were to appear as a witness before the court. It was pointed out to MIODUSKI that this latter procedure would be impossible. MIODUSKI suggested as another alternative the possibility of having subject arrested by the local police on a disorderly conduct charge or morals charge on the basis of subject's association with his "girlfriend", the 16 year old boy. He pointed out that after a person is in custody on some legitimate charge and if it appears that mental treatment is necessary he can be presented to the Office of the City Psychiatrist for mental evaluation. He said this is done on the basis of a court order and usually this order is based on a request made by the States Attorney's Office. He said this procedure is not at all uncommon and that persons in custody are afforded such psychiatric examinations quite frequently. If the examining psychiatrist feels further treatment is warranted a petition is executed and signed by one of the Assistant States Attorneys and the person is thereafter brought before the Psychopathic Court for a determination to be made as to whether he should be committed or not. Both SANDQUIST and MIODUSKI expressed a willingness to cooperate in any way possible in this matter.

On 6/10/59 Lt. JOHN B. KIRSTNER (NA), in charge of the Sex Bureau, Chicago Police Department, was contacted by SAs THOMAS W. PARRISH and CHARLES T. FLETCHER relative to whether there is any basis upon which action could be taken against MULLINS as the result of his relationship with [redacted] KIRSTNER pointed out that unless some definite complaint or allegation had been received from a citizen, a relative or from [redacted] himself, that MULLINS had committed some sexual act with [redacted] in the city of Chicago, there would be no basis for any action

being taken against MULLINS. He said mere suspicion would not be sufficient grounds for picking up MULLINS and he indicated that since [] lived in Melrose Park, Illinois, a suburb of Chicago, this further restricted the actions of his department because [] would be outside of their jurisdiction, even for interviewing purposes. KIRSTNER suggested a contact be made with the Melrose Park PD relative to having [] interviewed and that the interview be directed toward determining his exact relationship with MULLINS and whether any sexual acts had occurred between them. KIRSTNER said if this interview developed any possible information of sex acts between these two, then his department could pick up MULLINS for at least investigative purposes. He also pointed out that should [] and MULLINS be seen together frequently in Chicago or be seen entering or leaving MULLINS' apartment, even though no sex acts are alleged, this would also be sufficient grounds for his department to pick up both [] and MULLINS for questioning. Regarding the possibility of having MULLINS processed for commitment as a mental case after being picked up, KIRSTNER stated once a person is picked up and mental treatment is indicated the States Attorney's Office can request through the court that the person be examined by the City Psychiatrist's Office and a mental evaluation report made. If further action is then warranted the person would be taken before the Psychopathic Court on a basis of a petition filed by the States Attorney's Office. KIRSTNER expressed a willingness to cooperate in any way possible.

It is noted that GLENN JEWEL, when interviewed under pretext in Chicago, on June 12, 1959, stated that MULLINS was planning to be at JEWEL's cottage near Mecosta, Michigan, until the last of June, 1959.

On June 5, 1959, an anonymous source provided information indicating that MULLINS had attended New York University, Ohio State University and the University of North Dakota, dates not noted. This was in addition to information also furnished regarding his attendance at schools at which MULLINS' attendance has previously been verified.

He has associated with the principle suspects in the Atlanta bombing case and his writings show a complete disregard for the truth.

Mullins has related vicious and fantastic lies concerning the Director and the Director instructed that he be made to put up or shut up and that this matter receive top priority. He was interviewed and vehemently denied he had attacked the personal life of the Director. Admitted authoring articles critical of the Bureau.

Chicago has requested that Mullins' 1958 Federal income tax return be checked to determine whether he may have had income other than unemployment compensation during last six months of 1958.

ACTION:

It is recommended that Liaison Section be requested to make appropriate contact with Internal Revenue Service in order to obtain copy of Mullins' 1958 income tax return. A memorandum is attached for Liaison Section containing necessary information.

Enclosed is one copy of Mullins's Federal Income Tax Return for 1958. It is noted that Mullins is violently anti-Semitic and anti-integration. The contributions claimed on the income tax return reflects that he has claimed a donation of \$125 to United Jewish Appeal and \$75 to the Urban League. It is further noted that Mullins has claimed \$60 as a "bad debt, Mr. Leslie Richards, F.B.I." For your information, there is no record of a Leslie Richards ever having been employed by the Bureau.

Advise local IRS of the nature of the contributions claimed by Mullins and specifically point out to local IRS in connection with the claimed bad debt that there is no record of any Leslie Richards having ever been employed by the FBI. The Bureau should be advised as to whether IRS contemplates taking any action with regard to the contributions and bad debt listed by Mullins.

NOTE: Mullins writes anti-Semitic, anti-Negro propaganda. He has associated with notorious hate mongers and bombing suspects and has made derogatory comments concerning the Bureau and the Director. He is the subject of a pending racial matters investigation.
