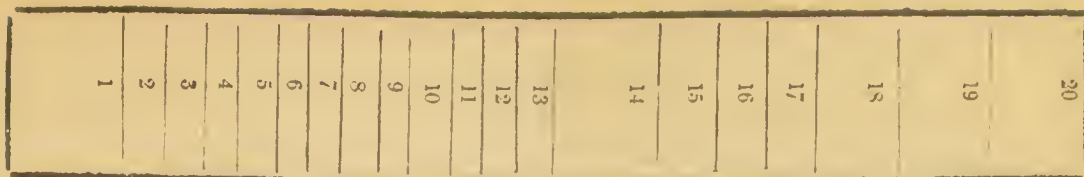
CONDITIONS OF SALE.

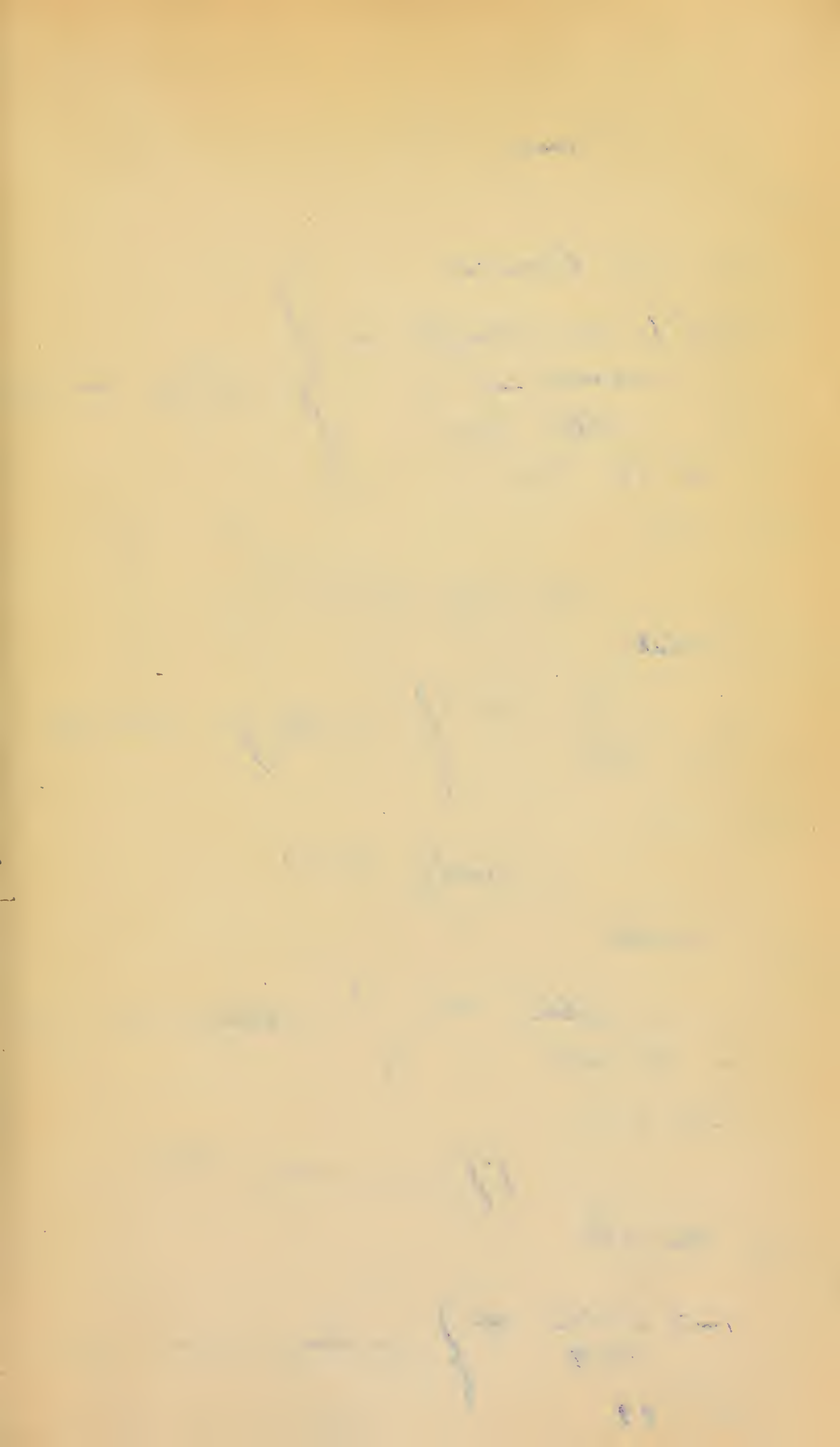

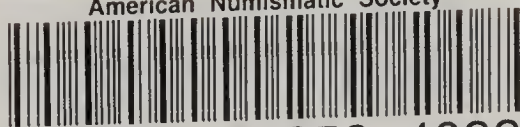
