# Jewelry *to Crochet*™

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# Tri-Color

# Metallic

## SKILL LEVEL



EASY

## FINISHED SIZES

**Necklace:** ½ inch wide x 18 inches long, not including clasp

**Bracelet:** 1 inch wide x 8¼ inches long, not including clasp

**Earrings:** 1¼ inches in diameter, not including earring wire

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Fashion Crochet Metallics size 5 crochet cotton (100 yds per ball):
  - 20 yds each #12s black/silver (A), #90g gold/gold (B) and #410s silver/silver (C)
- Size D/3/3.25mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Necklace barrel clasp
- 2 snaps
- 1 pair earring wires
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Black sewing thread



LACE

## GAUGE

6 sts = 1 inch

Gauge is not important for these projects.

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in ends as work progresses.

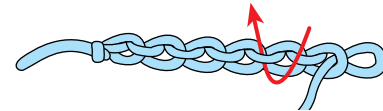
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## NECKLACE

### STRAND

#### MAKE 1 WITH EACH COLOR.

Ch 130, sl st in back bar (see illustration) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. (129 sl sts)

## FINISHING

Sew one end of all 3 Strands together. Carefully braid Strands so bottom ends come out even. Sew other end of Strands together. Sew ends of braid to necklace barrel clasp.

## BRACELET

### STRAND

#### MAKE 2 WITH EACH COLOR.

Ch 55, sl st in back bar (see illustration) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. (54 sl sts)

## EDGING

**Row 1 (RS):** Join A with sc in end of 1 A Strand, sc in end of 1 B Strand, sc in end of each of 2 C Strands, sc in end of 2nd B Strand, sc in end of 2nd A Strand, turn. (6 sc)

**Rows 2 & 3:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

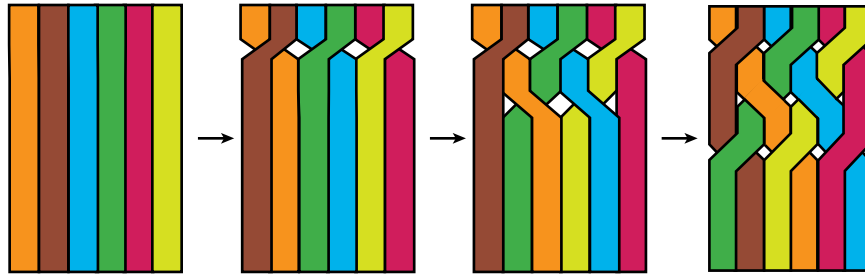
## FINISHING

Referring to diagram, carefully braid Strands so bottom ends come out even. Using A, rep edging at other end of Strands in whatever color order braided Strands end up. Sew snaps to Edging on either end of braid.

6-Strand Braiding Diagram



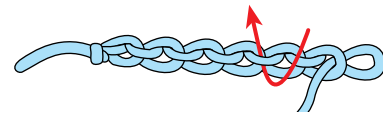
### EARRING

**MAKE 2.**

**STRAND**

**MAKE 1 WITH EACH COLOR.**

Ch 20, sl st in back bar (see illustration) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. (19 sl sts)

### FINISHING

Tie tails of all 3 Strands together. Carefully braid Strands so bottom ends come out even. Sew ends of strands together into a circle. Sew edge of braided circle seam to bottom loop of earring wire. ■

# Beaded Copper Compass

## SKILL LEVEL



## FINISHED SIZE

**Necklace:** ¾ inch wide x 17½ inches long, not including clasp

**Bracelet:** ¾ inch wide x 6½ inches long, not including clasp

**Earrings:** 1¼ inches wide x 2¼ inches long, not including earring wire

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet, size 10 crochet cotton (350 yds per ball): 50 yds #12 black
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 6 #G16221 Mill Hill glass beads: 2 beads for necklace, 2 beads for earrings
- Size 8 #G18221 Mill Hill glass beads: 20 beads for necklace, 11 beads for bracelet
- Necklace barrel clasp
- Bracelet toggle clasp
- 1 pair earring wires
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

3 shells = 2½ inches; rows 1 & 2 = ¾ inch

## PATTERN NOTE

Weave in ends as work progresses.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Picot:** Ch 3, sl st in top of last st made.

**Shell:** (Tr, ch 2, tr, picot, ch 2, tr) in indicated st.

**Large shell:** (Tr, picot, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, picot, ch 2, tr, ch 2, tr, picot) in indicated st.

**Small shell:** (Dc, ch 1, dc, picot, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

## NECKLACE

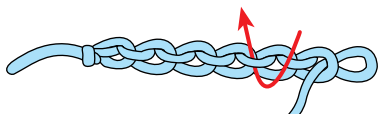
**Row 1 (RS):** Leaving 9-inch tail, ch 178, working in **back bar** (see illustration on page 6) of chs, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 8 chs, **picot** (see *Special Stitches*), [sc in each of next 8 chs, picot] 9 times, sc in each of next 6 chs, **sc dec** (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 3 chs, sc in each







of next 7 chs, [picot, sc in each of next 8 chs] 10 times, ch 1, working in unused lps on opposite side of foundation ch, sl st in each of first 5 chs, \*ch 2, sk next 3 chs, **shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next ch, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, sl st in next ch, rep from \* 9 times, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, **large shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next ch, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, sl st in next ch, \*\*ch 2, sk next 3 chs, shell in next ch, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, sl st in next ch, rep from \*\* 9 times, sl st in each of last 5 chs. Fasten off, leaving a 24-inch tail. (1 large shell, 20 shells)

## PENDANT

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 10, sc in back bar of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across, ch 1, working in unused lps on opposite side of foundation ch, sl st in first ch, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, shell in next ch, ch 2, sk next 3 chs, sl st in last ch, sc in sk ch at beg of row 1, picot. Do not turn. (1 shell)

**Row 2:** Working in sc at beg of row 1, sl st in first sc, ch 2, sk next 3 sc, shell in next sc, ch 2, sk next 3 sc, sl st in last sc, ch 1, remove lp from hook, insert hook from front to back in center picot on large shell of Necklace and pull dropped lp through picot, sl st in next sl st. Fasten off, leaving a 9-inch tail. (1 shell)

## FINISHING

On WS of Necklace, weave tail through sc of row 1, adding a small bead to RS at center of each shell and larger bead to RS at center of large shell. Secure end. Sew ends of Necklace to necklace barrel clasp.

On WS of Pendant, weave tail to center and add a large bead to RS.

Wash and block if desired.

## BRACELET

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 68, working in **back bar** (see *illustration*) of chs, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, ch 1, working in unused lps on opposite side of foundation ch, sl st in first ch, \*ch 1, sk next 2 chs, **small shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next ch, ch 1, sk next 2 chs, sl st in next ch, rep from \* across. Do not turn. (11 small shells)

**Row 2:** Ch 1, working in sc at beg of row 1, sl st in first sc, \*ch 1, sk next 2 sc, small shell in next sc, ch 1, sk next 2 sc, sl st in next sc, rep from \* across, ch 1, sl st in next sl st. Fasten off, leaving an 18-inch tail. (11 small shells)

## FINISHING

On WS of Bracelet, weave tail through center, adding a small bead to RS at center of each shell. Sew ends of Bracelet to bracelet toggle clasp. Wash and block if desired.

## EARRING

### MAKE 2.

**Row 1:** Rep row 1 of Pendant.

**Row 2:** Working in sc at beg of row 1, sl st in first sc, ch 2, sk next 3 sc, shell in next sc, ch 2, sk next 3 sc, sl st in last sc, sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 9, remove lp from hook, insert lp in bottom loop of earring wire, insert hook in lp, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 7 chs, sl st in next sl st. Fasten off, leaving a 6-inch tail.

## FINISHING

On WS, weave tails to center of Earrings and add a large bead to RS of each.

Wash and block if desired. ■



# Vintage Chic

## SKILL LEVEL



INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZE

**Necklace:** 1¼ inches wide x 18 inches long, not including clasp

**Bracelet:** 1¾ inches wide x 7½ inches long, not including clasp

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Fashion Crochet size 3 crochet cotton (150 yds per ball):  
30 yds #12 black (A)
- Aunt Lydia's Fashion Crochet Metallics size 5 crochet cotton (100 yds per ball):  
10 yds #90g gold/gold (B)
- Size D/3/3.25mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Mill Hill #G05557 glass pebble beads:  
13 beads
- Necklace barrel clasp
- Bracelet toggle clasp
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

4 dc and ch-1 sp = ¾ inch; 6 dc rows = 2 inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Chain-2 at beginning of row counts as a double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

**Front bead single crochet (fbsc):** Slide bead up to hook, pull up a lp in indicated st or sp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook.

## NECKLACE

**Row 1 (WS):** With A, ch 4, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in 4th ch from hook (*beg 3 sk chs count as a dc*), turn. (4 dc, 1 ch-1 sp)

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 5, dc in each of first 2 dc, ch 1, dc in each of last 2 dc, turn. (4 dc, 1 ch-5 sp, 1 ch-1 sp)

**Row 3:** Ch 2 (*see Pattern Notes*), dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in each of last 2 dc, turn.

**Rows 4–49:** [Rep rows 2 and 3 alternately] 23 times.

**Row 50:** Rep row 2.

**Row 51:** Ch 2, dc dec (*see Stitch Guide*) in next 3 sts. Fasten off. (2 dc)

## EDGING

*Note:* String gold beads on A.

With RS facing, **join** (*see Pattern Notes*) A in right-hand end of row 1, ch 1, working across long side in ends of rows, [6 sc in next ch-5 sp, sc in next row] 10 times, 7 sc in next ch-5 sp, \*sc in next row, 3 sc in next ch-5 sp, turn.

*Note:* Remainder of Edging is worked in steps.

**A.** Ch 6, sk first 7 sc, sl st in next sc, turn;

**B.** [sc, fbsc (*see Special Stitch*), 2 sc, fbsc, 2 sc, fbsc, sc) in ch-6 sp, 4 sc in same ch-5 sp as beg 3 sc made\*;

**C.** sc in next row, 7 sc in next ch-5 sp, sc in next row, 3 sc in next ch-5 sp, turn;

**D.** ch 3, sk first 5 sc, tr in next sc, [ch 3, sk next sc, tr in next sc] twice, ch 3, sk next 5 sc, sl st in next sc, turn;

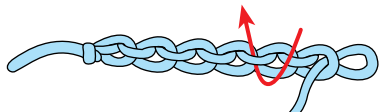




- E. [(2 sc, fb, 2 sc) in next ch-3 sp, fb in next tr] 3 times, (2 sc, fb, 2 sc) in next ch-3 sp, 4 sc in same ch-5 sp as 3 sc made, rep from \* to \* once;
- F. [sc in next row, 6 sc in next ch-5 sp] 10 times, ch 1, sl st in edge of last row.  
Fasten off.

### CHAIN

With B, make a loose chain approx 20–22 inches long, sl st in **back bar** (see illustration) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

With RS facing, weave Chain through ch-1 sps in center of Necklace and secure ends. Sew ends of Necklace to necklace barrel clasp.

### BRACELET

**Row 1 (WS):** With A, ch 10, dc in 6th ch from hook (beg 5 sk chs count as a ch-5 sp), dc in next ch, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in each of last 2 chs, turn. (4 dc, 1 ch-5 sp, 1 ch-1 sp)

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 5, dc in each of first 2 dc, ch 1, dc in each of last 2 dc, turn.

**Rows 3–18:** Rep row 2. At end of last row, do not turn.

### EDGING

Ch 1, working across long side in ends of rows, sc in top of last dc on row 18, sc in last row, 6 sc in next ch-5 sp, \*sc in next row, 6 sc in next ch-5 sp, rep from \* across, working across next side in unused lps of foundation ch, sc in each of next 4 chs, 3 sc in last ch, working across next side in ends of rows, sc in first row, 6 sc in next

ch-5 sp, \*\*sc in next row, 6 sc in next ch-5 sp, rep from \*\* across, working across row 18, sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in next ch, sc in next dc, 2 sc in last dc, **join** (see Pattern Notes) in first sc. Fasten off.

### CHAIN

With B, make loose chain approx 8½ inches long, sl st in **back bar** (see illustration) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

With RS facing, weave Chain through ch-1 sps in center of Bracelet and secure ends. Sew ends of Bracelet to bracelet clasp. ■



# Stained Glass

## SKILL LEVEL



INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZES

**Necklace:** 5/8 inch wide x 18½ inches long, not including clasp

**Bracelet:** 7/8 inches wide x 6¼ inches long, not including clasp

**Earrings:** 1 inch in diameter x 7/8 inch long, not including earring wire

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet, size 10 crochet cotton (solids: 350 yds; shaded: 300 yds per ball):
  - 35 yds #12 black (A)
  - 25 yds #995 ocean (B)
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Necklace barrel clasp
- Bracelet hook clasp
- 1 pair earring wires
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

Necklace medallion = 1¾ inches from point to point; 11 dc = 1 inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Join with sl st as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Ch 3 at beg of round counts as first dc.

## SPECIAL STITCH

**Treble/single crochet (tr/sc):** Yo twice, insert hook in indicated st on indicated row below and draw up a lp, [yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice, insert hook in next st on working row and draw up a lp, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

## NECKLACE

### MEDALLION

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first sc. Fasten off. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2:** With RS facing and working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), join B in any sc, **ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), 2 dc in same sc as joining, 3 dc in each of next 5 sc, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (18 dc)

**Rnd 3:** With RS facing, join A with sc in back lp of 2nd dc of first 3-dc group, tr in **front lp** (see *Stitch Guide*) of first sc on rnd 1, sc in back lp of same dc as joining, \*sc in back lp of each of next 3 dc, tr in front lp of next sc on rnd 1, sc in back lp of same dc as last sc made, rep from \* 4 times, sc in back lp of each of next 2 dc, join in first sc. Fasten off. (24 sc, 6 tr)

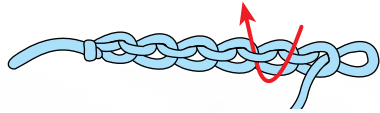
**Rnd 4:** With RS facing and working in back lps, join B in any tr, ch 3, 2 dc in same tr as joining, \*dc in each of next 4 sc, 3 dc in next tr, rep from \* 4 times, dc in each of last 4 sc, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (42 dc)

**Rnd 5:** With RS facing, join A with sc in back lp of 2nd dc of any 3-dc group, tr in front lp of next tr on rnd 3, sc in back lp of same dc as joining, \*sc in back lp of each of next 7 dc, tr in front lp of next tr on rnd 3, sc in back lp of same dc as last sc made, rep from \* 4 more times, sc in back lp of each of next 6 dc, join in first sc. Fasten off. (48 sc, 6 tr)

## CHAIN MAKE 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, ch 92 loosely, sc in **back bar** (see *illustration on page 12*) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off. (91 sc)





Back Bar of Chain

**Row 2:** With RS facing, join B with dc in first sc, dc in back lp of each rem sc across to last sc, dc through both lps of last sc. Fasten off. (91 dc)

**Row 3:** With RS facing, join A with sc in first dc, sc in back lp of each of next 3 dc, tr/sc (see *Special Stitch*) in front lp of 3rd sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row, \*sc in back lp of next dc, sk next 5 sc on row 1, tr/sc in front lp of next sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row\*\*, sc in back lp of each of next 5 dc, sk next sc on row 1, tr/sc in front

lp of next sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in back lp of each of next 3 dc, sc through both lps of last dc. Fasten off.

### EDGING

Hold piece with RS facing and foundation ch at top, join A in unused lps of foundation ch at base of first sc on row 1, ch 1, working across short end, hdc in edge of first sc on row 1, 2 hdc around post (see *Stitch Guide*) of first dc on row 2, hdc in top of same dc, ch 1, sl st in back lp of each sc across row 3, ch 1, working across short end, hdc in edge of last sc on row 3, 2 hdc around post of last dc on row 2, hdc in edge of last sc on row 1, ch 1, sl st in unused lp of foundation ch at base of last sc on row 1. Fasten off.



## FINISHING

Referring to photo for placement, sew one end of each Chain to Medallion. Sew necklace barrel clasp to opposite ends of Chain.

## BRACELET

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, ch 60 loosely, sc in back bar (see illustration on page 12) of 2nd ch from hook and in back bar of each rem ch across. Fasten off. (S9 sc)

**Row 2:** With RS facing, join B with dc in first sc, dc in back lp (see *Stitch Guide*) of each st across to last sc, dc through both lps of last sc. Fasten off. (S9 dc)

**Row 3:** With RS facing, join A with sc in first dc, sc in back lp of next dc, tr/sc (see *Special Stitch*) in front lp (see *Stitch Guide*) of 5th sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row, \*sc in back lp of each of next 5 dc, sk next sc on row 1, tr/sc in front lp of next sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row, sc in back lp of next dc\*\*, sk next 5 sc on row 1, tr/sc in front lp of next sc on row 1 and in back lp of next dc on working row, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc through both lps of last dc. Fasten off.

**Row 4:** Rep row 2.

**Row 5:** With RS facing, join A with sc in first dc, sc in back lp of each of next 3 dc, tr/sc in front lp of first tr/sc on row 3 and in back lp of next dc on working row, \*sc in back lp of next dc, tr/sc in front lp of next tr/sc on row 3 and in back lp of next dc on working row\*\*, sc in back lp of each of next 5 dc, tr/sc in front lp of next tr/sc on row 3 and in back lp of next dc on working row, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, sc in back lp of each of next 3 dc, sc through both lps of last dc. Fasten off.

## EDGING

Hold piece with RS facing and foundation ch at top, join (see *Pattern Notes*) A in unused lps of foundation ch at base of first sc on row 1, ch 1, working across short end, hdc in edge of first sc on row 1, 2 hdc around post (see *Stitch Guide*) of first dc on row 2, hdc in edge of first sc on row 3, 2 hdc around post of first dc on row 4, hdc in top of same dc, ch 1, sl st in back lp of

each sc across row 5, ch 1, hdc in edge of last sc on row 5, 2 hdc around post of last dc on row 4, hdc in edge of last sc on row 3, 2 hdc around post of last dc on row 2, sc in edge of last sc on row 1, ch 1, sl st in unused lp of foundation ch at base of last sc on row 1. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew bracelet hook clasp to ends of Bracelet.

## EARRING

### MAKE 2.

### BACK

**Rnds 1–3:** Rep rnds 1–3 of Medallion. At end of last rnd, fasten off, leaving a 12-inch tail.

### FRONT

**Rnds 1–3:** Rep rnds 1–3 of Medallion. At end of last rnd, do not fasten off.

### CHAIN

Sl st in next tr, ch 8. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With WS facing each other, sew Fronts and Backs together. Sew end of each Chain to bottom loop of each earring wire. ■





## Lariat

## Necklace

**SKILL LEVEL**

BEGINNER

**FINISHED SIZE****Necklace:** 68 inches long**Earrings:** 1¾ inches long, not including earring wire**MATERIALS**

- Kreinik Metallic Thread tapestry #12 braid (11 yds per spool):  
2 spools #001HL silver high lustre
- Size 4/2.0mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 14/.75mm steel crochet hook (optional)
- Turquoise crackled glass beads:  
18 large (7/16-inch), 17 small (5/16-inch)
- 1 pair silver earring wires
- Beading pliers
- Tapestry needle

**GAUGE**

Gauge is not important for these projects.

**SPECIAL TECHNIQUE**

**Place bead:** Remove hook, pull lp up to 1 inch, slide bead on lp, insert hook in lp and tighten lp on hook, ch 1 to secure bead. If needed, use smaller hook to help slide beads on lp.

**NECKLACE**

With larger hook, make slip knot on hook, \***place large bead** (see *Special Technique*), ch 8, dc in 3rd ch from hook, ch 6, place small bead, ch 8, dc in 3rd ch from hook, ch 6, rep from \* 14 times, place large bead. Fasten off and weave in ends.

**EARRING****MAKE 2.**

With larger hook, make slip knot on hook, **place large bead** (see *Special Technique*), ch 20, place small bead. Fasten off and weave in ends.

**ASSEMBLY**

Using beading pliers, attach earring wire to each ch-20, approx 1 inch from small bead end.

**FINISHING**

Wash pieces in cold water and block.

To wear necklace as a lariat, fold necklace in half. Place folded necklace around neck and insert ends into fold. ■







# Tie-Dyed

# Oval

## SKILL LEVEL



INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZES

**Pendant:** 1¼ inches wide x 1½ inches long, not including hanging loop

**Chain:** 18 inches stretched, or desired length

**Earrings:** 1 inch wide x 1¼ inches long, not including hanging loop

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet, size 10 crochet cotton (solids: 350 yds; shaded colors: 300 yds per ball):
  - 20 yds #486 navy (B)
  - 10 yds #495 wood violet (A)
  - 15 yds #995 ocean (C)
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Necklace barrel clasp
- 1 pair earring wires
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

Pendant rnds 1 and 2 = ½ inch x ¾ inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as a double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Adjustable ring:** Wrap thread in ring around index finger, ending thread tail behind working thread. Remove from finger and grip the ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, with

working thread, yo, draw up lp, work sts of first rnd in ring. After the first rnd of sts has been completed, pull gently, but firmly, on thread tail to close ring.

### Beginning 3-double crochet cluster (beg 3-dc cl):

Make a slip knot and place on hook, [yo, pull up a lp in indicated st, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook.

**3-double crochet cluster (3-dc cl):** [Yo, pull up a lp in indicated st, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook.

**2-double crochet cluster (2-dc cl):** [Yo, pull up a lp in indicated st, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

## NECKLACE

### PENDANT

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, make an adjustable ring (see *Special Stitches*), ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join (see *Pattern Notes*) in first sc. (8 sc)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, \*(sc, hdc) in next st, 5 dc in next st, (hdc, sc) in next st\*\*, sc in next st, rep from \* once, ending rep at \*\*, join in first sc. Fasten off. (20 sts)

**Rnd 3:** With RS facing, join B with sc in first sc, sc in each st around, join in first sc. Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** With RS facing and working in back lps (see *Stitch Guide*), join C with beg 3-dc cl (see *Special Stitches*) in first sc, ch 1, sk next sc, [3-dc cl (see *Special Stitches*) in next sc, ch 1] 7 times, sk next sc, 3-dc cl in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, [3-dc cl in next sc, ch 1] 7 times, sk last sc, join in top of beg 3-dc cl. Fasten off. (16 3-dc cls, 16 ch-1 sps)



**Rnd 5:** With RS facing, join B with sc in ch-1 sp after 4th 3-dc cl of 7 3-dc cl group on either side of pendant, 2 sc in same ch-1 sp as joining, 3 sc in each rem ch-1 sp around, join in first sc. (48 sc)

### HANGING LOOP

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (see *Pattern Notes*), 2 dc in first sc, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (3 dc)

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, dc dec (see *Stitch Guide*) in next 2 dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. (1 dc)

### CHAIN

With B and leaving a long tail, \*ch 18, 2-dc cl (see *Special Stitches*) in 3rd ch from hook, rep from \* 7 times or to desired length, ending with ch 15. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

### FINISHING

With RS facing, fold Hanging Loop in half. Sew top of row 3 to top of Pendant. Sew Chain to necklace clasp. Insert Chain through Hanging Loop.

### EARRING

#### MAKE 2.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, make an **adjustable ring** (see *Special Stitches*), ch 1, (2 sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, 3 sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc) in ring, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first sc. Fasten off. (16 sts)

**Rnd 2:** With RS facing, join B with sc in first sc, sc in each st around, join in first st. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** With RS facing and working in **back lps** (see *Stitch Guide*), join C with **beg 3-dc cl** (see *Special Stitches*) in first sc, ch 1, sk next sc, [3-dc cl (see *Special Stitches*) in next sc, ch 1] 5 times, sk next sc, 3-dc cl in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, [3-dc cl in next sc, ch 1] 5 times, sk last sc, join in top of beg 3-dc cl. Fasten off. (12 3-dc cls, 12 ch-1 sps)

**Rnd 4:** With RS facing, join B with sc in ch-1 sp after 3rd cl of 5 3-dc cl group on either end of piece, 2 sc in same ch-1 sp as joining, 3 sc in each rem ch-1 sp around, join in first sc, ch 10. Fasten off. (36 sc)

### FINISHING

Insert ch-10 in bottom loop of earring wire. Sew end to outer edge of Earring at base of ch-10. ■

**Necklace:** 1/2 inch wide x 19 inches long, not including clasp

**Bracelet:** 3/4 inches wide x 6 1/2 inches long, not including clasp

**Earrings:** 1 inch wide x 1 1/2 inches long, not including earring wire

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton (white: 400 yds; solids: 350 yds per ball):
  - 30 yds #1 white (A)
  - 50 yds #397 wasabi (C)
  - 15 yds #422 golden yellow (B)
- Size 7/1.65mm steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Necklace barrel clasp
- Bracelet hook clasp
- 1 pair earring wires
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

6 dc and 3 ch-1 sps = 1 inch

Daisy = 1 1/8 inches at widest diameter

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

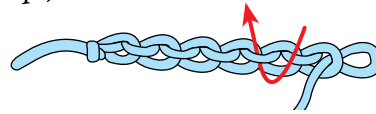
Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as a double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

**Picot:** Ch 2, sl st in top of last st made.

## NECKLACE

**Row 1 (RS):** With C, ch 181, working in back bar (see illustration), dc in 4th ch from hook (beg 3 sk chs count as a dc), \*ch 1, sk next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs, ch 2, sk next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs, rep from \* across to last 3 chs, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in each of last 2 chs. (120 dc and 59 ch sps)

## EDGING

Ch 1, working across edge, 2 sc around post (see *Stitch Guide*) of last dc made, working in unused lps on opposite side of foundation ch and in sps formed by sk chs, 2 sc in ch at base of same dc, **picot** (see *Special Stitch*), \*sc in next ch, sc in next ch sp, sc in next ch, picot, rep from \* across, 2 sc in last ch, sc around post of beg 3 sk chs of row 1, working across row 1, 2 sc in first ch of 3 sk chs at beg of row 1, picot, \*\*sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, picot, sc in next dc\*\*\*, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next dc, picot, rep from \*\* across, ending last rep at \*\*\*, join in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. (120 picots)

## PETALS

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 4, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in first ch to form ring, ch 1, [sc in ring, ch 6, working in back bar of chs, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch (*petal made*)] 6 times, join in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. (6 petals)





**CENTER**

With B, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

**ASSEMBLY**

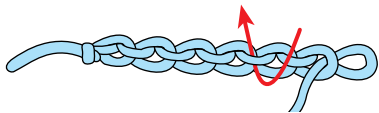
Sew WS of Center to center of Petals.

**FINISHING**

Sew one Daisy to center 2-dc group of Necklace and sew 1 Daisy to 4th and 10th groups on either side of center. Sew necklace barrel clasp to ends of Necklace.

**BRACELET**

**Row 1 (RS):** With C, ch 64, working in back bar (see illustration), dc in 4th ch from hook (beg 3 sk chs count as a dc), \*ch 1, sk next ch, dc in each of next 2 chs, rep from \* across, turn. (42 dc, 20 ch-1 sps)

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* across to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg 3 sk chs, turn.

**EDGING**

Ch 1, sc in first dc, picot (see Special Stitch), \*sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, picot, rep from \* across to beg ch-3, 2 sc in next ch, sc in sp formed by beg ch, sc in top of edge dc of row 1, sc around post (see Stitch Guide) of same

dc, working across next side in unused lps of foundation ch, 2 sc in first ch, picot, \*\*sc in next ch, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next ch, picot, rep from \*\* across to beg 3 sk chs, 2 sc in ch at base of beg 3 sk chs, sc in sp formed by sk chs, sc in last sk ch, sc around post of last dc on row 2, sc in top of last dc, join (see Pattern Notes) in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

**DAISY****MAKE 3.**

Work same as Daisy for Necklace.

**FINISHING**

Sew one Daisy to center 2-dc group of Bracelet and one Daisy to 4th group on either side of center. Sew bracelet hook clasp to ends of Bracelet.

**EARRING****MAKE 2.****DAISY  
MAKE 2.**

Work same as Daisy for Necklace, leaving an 18-inch tail on one petal for joining.

**CHAIN**

With C, ch 10. Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

With WS together, sew outer edges of 2 Daisies together.

Insert Chain in bottom loop of earring wire and sew ends of Chain to tip of any petal on Daisy. Repeat with remaining Daisies, Chain and earring wire. ■

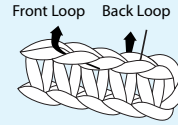

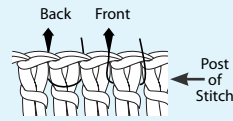

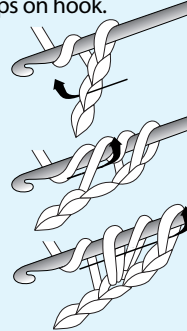
